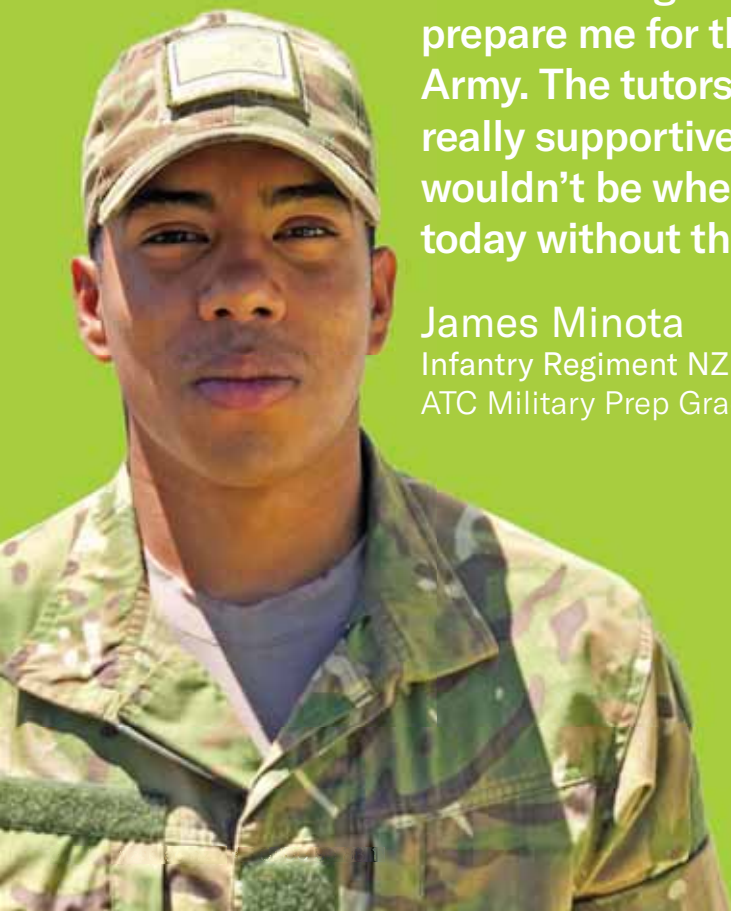
Can I get a job after I graduate?
