



Policy 20 – BIS Uniform Policy

Policy

Belmont Intermediate School students are required to wear a common uniform for the following reasons:

- To create in each student positive feelings of 'belonging' and pride in the school
- To enable students to be identified as part of Belmont Intermediate School in and out of the school grounds
- To eliminate peer pressure brought about by comparisons resulting from differing socio-economic backgrounds
- To enhance the image of the school
- To provide suitable clothing for school activities


Therefore, the Principal shall ensure the following: -

- The required uniform is listed on the website – a copy of the uniform regulations follows
- Standards of uniform are maintained throughout the school year
- Students will be required to wear full uniform on all school outings unless an exemption is given by the Principal
- Temporary departures from the uniform code must be supported by a note from home and brought to the Principal, a temporary uniform pass will be issued
- The physical education (PE) uniform will be worn by all students for all physical education, fitness and sporting events
- Uniform requirements are reviewed annually and the Board will conduct a full review of the suitability and appeal of the uniform every five years.

Belmont Intermediate School Uniform

BOYS UNIFORM

SHIRT pale blue, short sleeved with BIS logo, **SHORTS** navy blue drill shorts or **TROUSERS** navy blue, flat-fronted slim fit trouser, **JERSEY** navy blue with BIS logo, **SOCKS** short or long school socks with blue and red stripe. **NB:** Socks to be worn with school shoes, **NOT** sandals, **CAP** or **BUCKET HAT** navy blue with BIS logo – compulsory in Terms 1 and 4 for all outdoor activities including morning tea and lunchtime

GIRLS UNIFORM

SHIRT pale blue, short sleeved with BIS logo, **SKIRT** navy blue check or **SKORT** navy blue plain, or **SHORTS** navy blue drill shorts or **TROUSERS** navy blue, flat-fronted slim fit trouser, **JERSEY** navy blue with BIS logo, **SOCKS** short or long school socks with blue and red stripe, or **TIGHTS** dark blue or black. **NB:** Socks/tights to be worn with school shoes, **NOT** sandals, **CAP** or **BUCKET HAT** navy blue with BIS logo – compulsory in Terms 1 and 4 for all outdoor activities including morning tea and lunchtime

SPORTS UNIFORM

PE SHORTS navy blue with BIS logo, **PE SHIRT** reversible red/house colour with BIS logo, Trainers or barefoot



FOOTWEAR

In winter, Terms 2 and 3, students will wear the approved plain black leather, lace-up school-style **SHOES**. For health and safety reasons shoes are required to be sturdy, support the foot and have a heel of approximately 1.5 - 2 cm.

Footwear must be clean and have no embellishments or logos of any kind NB: Leather and canvas Converse, boots, ballet flats, skate shoes and sports shoes are **NOT PERMITTED**

In summer, Terms 1 and 4, students will wear the shoes as defined in the winter uniform, or **SANDALS**. The sandals will be black **ROMAN SANDALS** or black **BIRKENSTOCK LEATHER MILANO SANDALS** only

In all Science and Technology rooms, students will wear the approved plain black leather, lace-up school-style **SHOES** or their **TRAINERS** that are used for PE

OPTIONAL UNIFORM

JACKET navy blue hooded jacket with BIS logo, **SCARF** navy blue with BIS logo, **HOODIE** navy blue hooded sweatshirt with BIS logo **NB:** The hoodie is only permitted to be worn by students when representing the school at a sporting event, school camps or EOTC Week. It does **NOT** replace the school jumper or jacket



PURCHASING UNIFORM

The main school uniform (shirts, shorts, trousers, jersey, jackets, excluding footwear) is purchased from Yarntons Menswear, 77 Victoria Road, Devonport.

The school PE uniform, cap/bucket hats, scarfs and hoodies are purchased from the Uniform Shop at Belmont Intermediate School, using the Online Shop or via EFTPOS in the shop. Details of the items sold from the BIS Uniform Shop are below.

UNIFORM REGULATIONS

- Belmont Intermediate School uniform must be worn to and from school and for all school functions
- Items that are not part of the school uniform may not be worn. Undergarments must not be visible
- Long socks must be worn pulled up
- The sports uniform is to be worn for all physical education lessons and sports events
- Uniforms must be neat and tidy at all times. All items should be clearly named
- A high-visibility vest must be worn when riding a bicycle/ scooter to and from school
- For safety reasons, only the following jewellery may be worn:
 - a wristwatch
 - single set of gold or silver plain studs for pierced ears - no markings, stones or engraving
- The school cap or bucket hat must be worn for all outdoor activities in terms 1 and 4
- Lipstick and eye makeup are not permitted
- Nail polish is permitted as long as it is a transparent (clear). Nails must be kept short and neat. Acrylic/ false nails are not permitted.
- Hair must be well groomed and tidy, hair ties and hair adornments are only permitted in navy blue or black
- Only hair colours in the natural human hair range are acceptable. Purple, orange, lime green, pink etc. are not permitted
- Un-natural coloured hair extensions or any hair extensions/ beading/ extension braids of any kind are not permitted
- In the interest of safety or hygiene, any teacher has the right to request hair is tied back, or jewellery removed

To buy the uniform items in person at the Uniform Shop (**recommended option for the beginning of the school year**):

Please visit the Uniform Shop during the hours listed below. **NB: Payment is via EFTPOS only** (sorry no credit cards or cash). If you are unable to come during these hours, you can order using our Online Shop (see below).

Steps for ordering using the Online Shop (**during the school year**):

1. Select the correct size using our size guide (click on the 'i' icon) on the Online Shop (via our website www.belmontint.school.nz)
2. Order and pay for your child's reversible PE/house shirt (Brett, Cuvier, Tiri or Pencarrow), PE shorts and any optional items.
3. Once ordered, the uniform item(s) will be delivered to your child via their teacher, on the subsequent school day. **(NB: If you use this option, you will not be able to collect the uniform from the Uniform Shop).**
4. Exchanges – unworn uniform items with the size tag still attached (for the PE shirt this is on the side of the house shirt) can be exchanged by yourself or your child via the Resource Room Manager, Jacquie Spillane. Please make contact to arrange an appointment time (details below).
5. At any other times during the school year, the Uniform Shop is open by appointment only. Please make contact to arrange an appointment time with Jacquie Spillane (details below).
