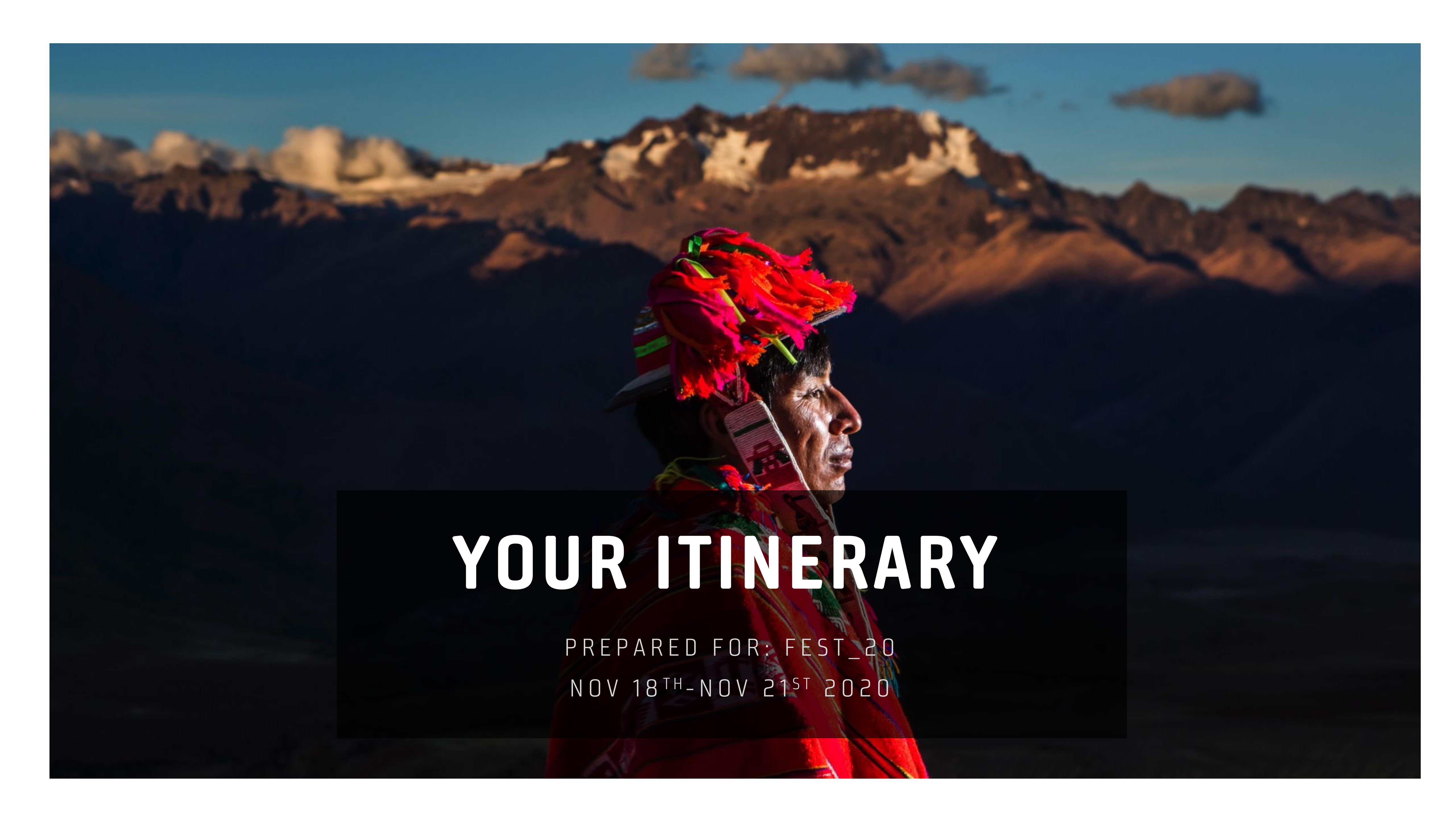

DAY 1, November 18th.

ARRIVE IN CUSCO & LUNCH STOP IN THE CITY, TRANSFER TO THE SACRED VALLEY & VISIT MORAY ARCHEOLOGICAL SITE.

Upon our arrival, our guides will greet us at the airport.

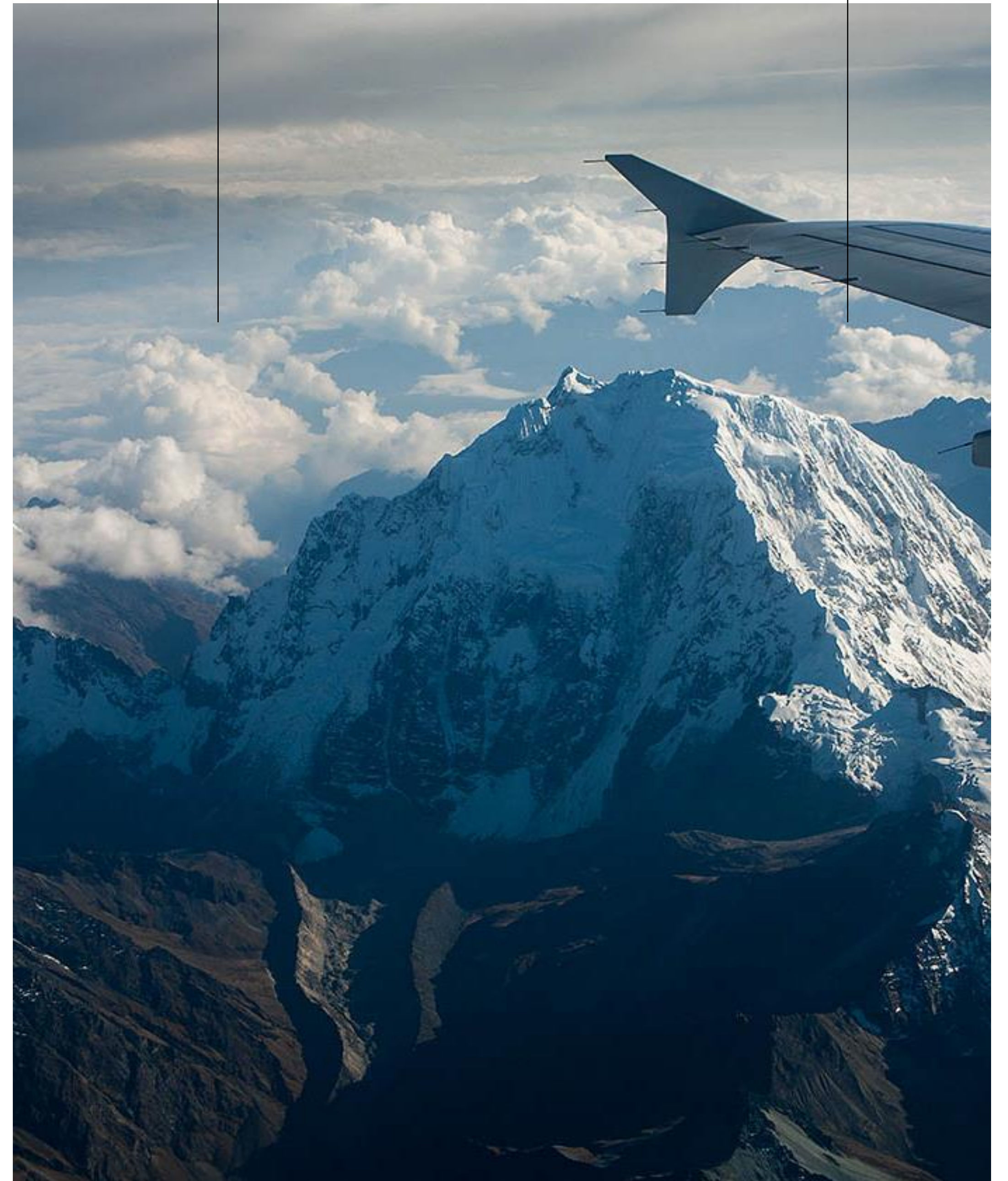
We will then take a short drive to a nice restaurant in the city center, where we will have the chance to get a first glimpse of the Inca capital of South America.

After, we will drive for approximately one hour to Moray, once an important agricultural experimental center consisting of circular terraces located 38 km (24 mi) to the northwest of Cusco. A perfect welcome and introduction to Peru, surrounded by impressive views of the snow-capped peaks of Veronica and Chicon as well as a significant amount of local cultural features, traditional villages, local folks in traditional costumes, etc.

Finally, we will continue to our hotel at the Sacred Valley to rest and acclimate to the altitude.

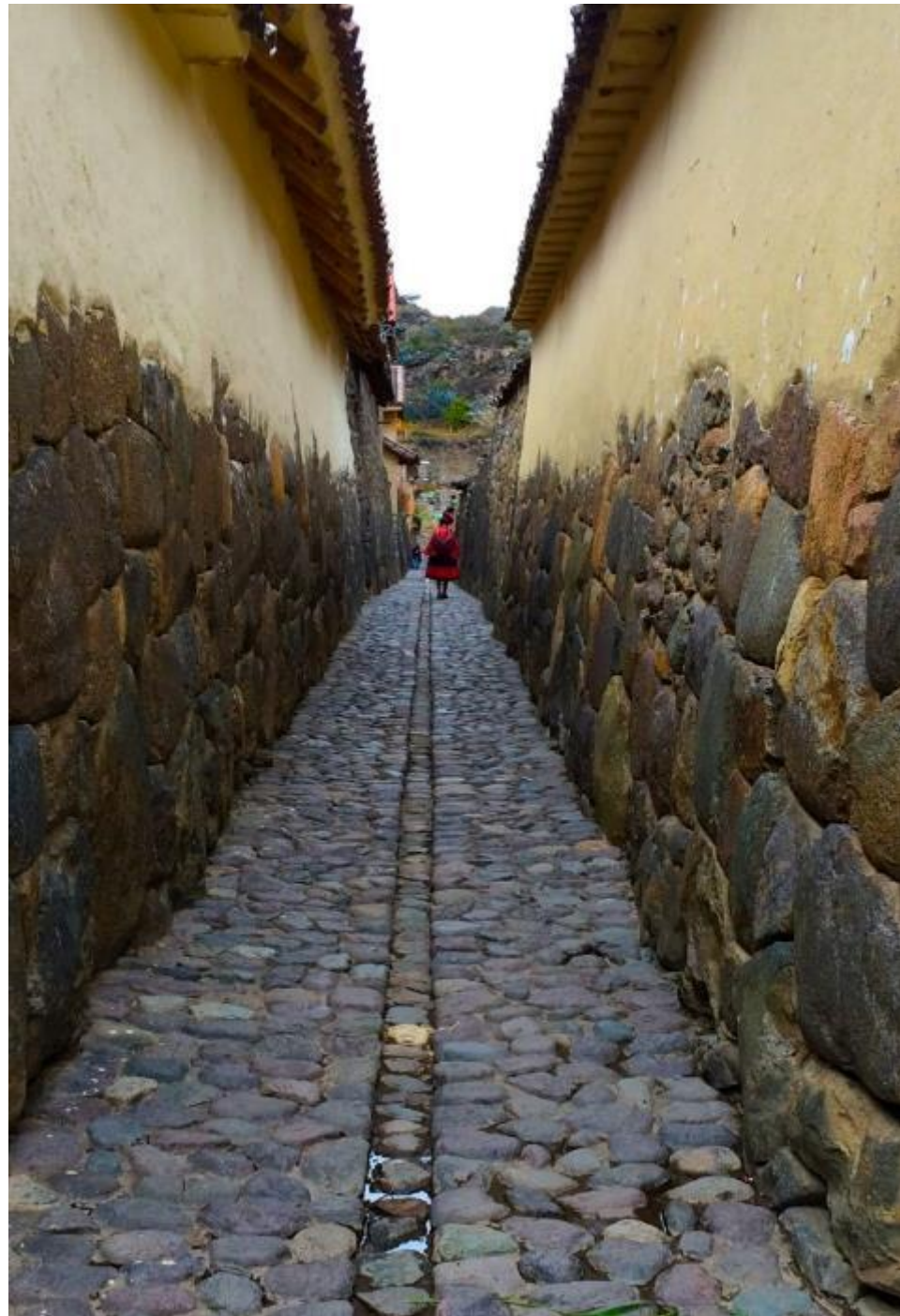

DAY 2, November 19th.

KAYAK AT HUAYPO, OLLANTAYTAMBO VIST AND TRAIN TO AGUAS CALIENTES.

Today our adventure will begin at Huaypo, a gorgeous lagoon perched on the heights of the Andes, providing water to the neighboring communities and their crops. Its deep blue waters reflect a stunning view of the hills, mountains, and nature surrounding it. For about an hour and a half we will paddle around the lagoon in sea kayaks, a graceful ride that will allow us to appreciate the surrounding nature in all its dimensions.

After paddling, we will enjoy delicious and authentic outdoor picnic.

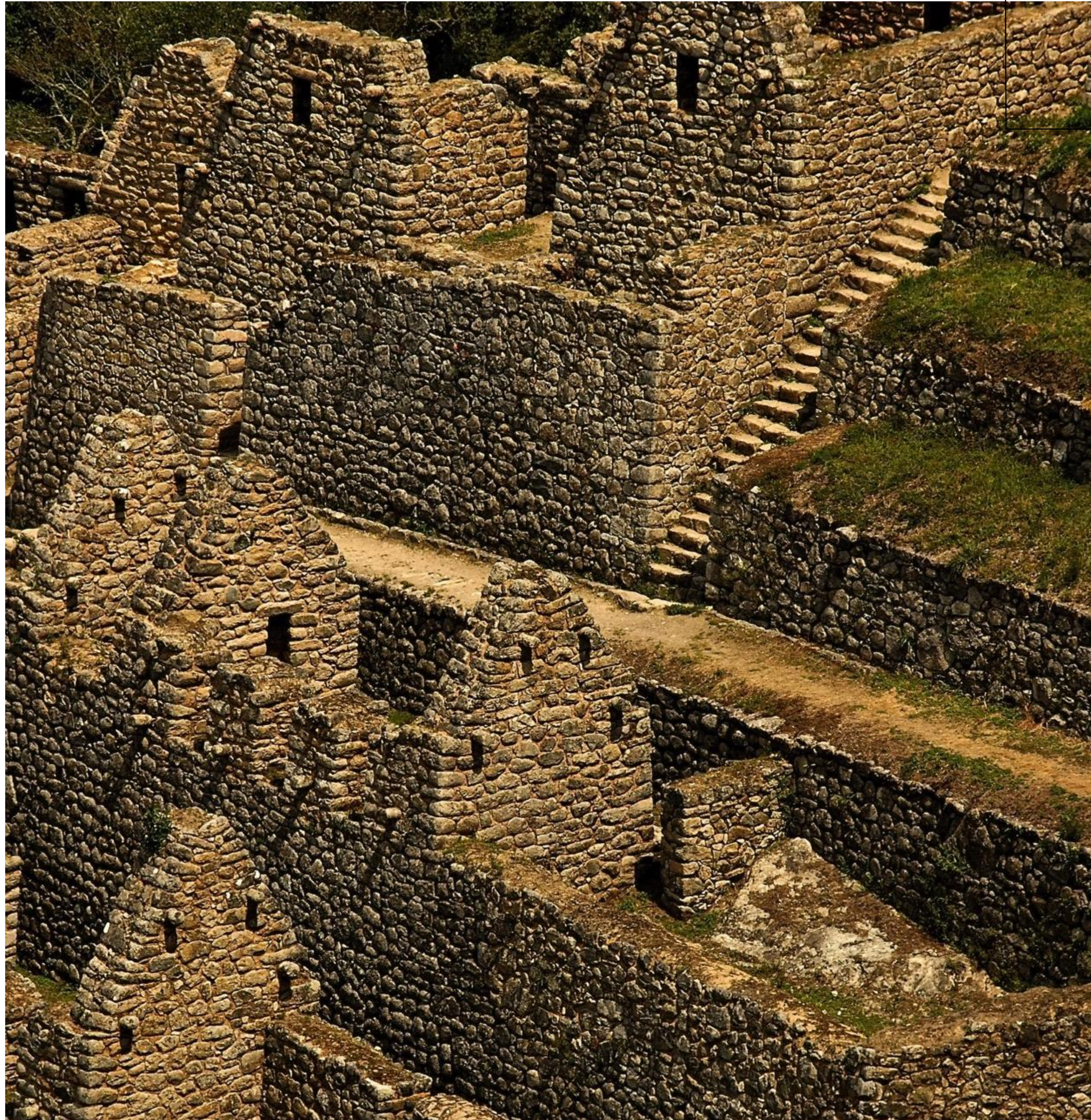
Afterwards, we visit Ollantaytambo, known as the only Inca town still alive, as the local people still maintain their costumes, live at the old stone houses of their ancestors and their water channels keep running, just as they did at the time of the Incas.

After some free time to explore on our own, we take one of the most scenic train rides there exists, a journey crossing the highlands into the deep cloudforest arriving to Machu Picchu town, where we spend the night.

MACHU PICCHU & RETURN TO CUSCO CITY.

Early this morning we take a bus up to the Machu Picchu. Our guides will give us a comprehensive tour around the sanctuary where we will learn about this fascinating and mysterious Inca settlement, built in the fifteenth century as a religious center and a palace for the Inca Pachacutec.

We then head down to the bus station for our train back to Ollantaytambo where a private transportation will take us back to Cusco city.
