

Navigating Visitation Stages*

PHASE 1
VISITATION RESTRICTED

No County Positivity Rate Needed

(Compassionate care and end of life visits continue on a case-by-case basis.)

- Scheduled visits only – no drop-ins
- Limit 2 visitors per resident
- Check-in and check-out required
- Mandatory safety precautions
- No transmission on campus
- Space available to group residents by status
- No positive cases (staff or residents)
- Outdoor visits preferred – weather permitting

If positive case on campus

PHASE 2
VISITATION LIMITED

<10% County Positivity Rate

(Compassionate care and end of life visits continue on a case-by-case basis.)

Outdoor visits allowed with screening and precautions.

- Scheduled visits only – no drop-ins
- Indoor visits require negative COVID-19 test
- Limit 2 visitors per resident
- Check-in and check-out required
- Mandatory safety precautions
- No transmission on campus
- Space available to group residents by status
- No positive cases (staff or residents)
- Outdoor visits preferred – weather permitting

If positive case on campus

PHASE 3
VISITATION MONITORED

<10% County Positivity Rate

Indoor and outdoor visits allowed with screening and precautions.

- Must be 14 days since last positive case on campus
- Scheduled visits only – no drop-ins
- Limit 2 visitors per resident
- Check-in and check-out required
- Mandatory safety precautions
- No transmission on campus
- Space available to group residents by status
- No positive cases (staff or residents)
- Outdoor visits preferred – weather permitting

Negative COVID-19 test required for indoor visitors when county positivity rate is between 5-10%

If positive case on campus

STOP
VISITATION TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

May resume visitations when cleared by county health officials.
