The History

Once deemed “one of the most architecturally significant intersections in the United States” by National Geographic magazine, the northwest corner, where 1477 Maine Street is located in Quincy, IL, is now home to the city’s premier inn and eatery. The Gas Lamp Inn and Eatery is housed in an imposing Second Empire brick house featuring selected Italian elements across a main block, topped by a straight mansard roof and copula. While a service wing extends to the rear of the property, a full porch spans the front of this Mansard Italianate residence. The home is featured on the East End National Register Historic District.



Two of the last remaining historic gas lamps in this quaint Quincy neighborhood adorn the south passage just off Maine Street, leading the way to the main house originally built in 1866 and acting as its namesake features. The home was constructed for David W. Miller, a prominent Quincy merchant, who owned the nearby “Quincy House”, a small hotel on Vermont Street just a stone's throw away. When overbooked, Miller would often accommodate guests in his private residence. This spirit of personable hospitality is sparked anew as its current owner at The Gaslamp Inn and Eatery welcomes guests once more to this magnificent property.
