COVID-19 Participant Safety – As of 10-26-20

We suggest each team make their own decision how to best protect yourselves while under your canopy and in your rigs. However, when you or any of your team leave your canopy/trailer the following policies will be strictly enforced.

REFUSAL TO APPROPRIATELY WEAR FACE COVERINGS AND ADHERE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES WHILE IN PUBLIC PLACES WILL RESULT IN BEING ESCORTED OFF THE FACILITY BY TRACK SECURITY.

- This is a “non spectator event”. Only drivers and necessary team and crew members should attend.
- Six feet of space must be kept between individuals for the entirety of the event, except in cases of participants that are part of the same household while in public spaces
- Be mindful of entering other competitors paddock space to keep the social distancing
- Participants are required to wear cloth face coverings or masks that completely cover the nose and mouth when in public spaces including registration, paddock, grid, pit lane, fuel pumps, and impound. Race Control, FRP Series Rig, and Timing and Scoring are “FRP staff only”. Masks or face coverings are optional when within the team’s canopy, garage, or trailer. We encourage team principals to have appropriate social distancing protocols within their own spaces.
- 6’ social distance must be kept while in line at registration. If any participant has not joined SCCA or received their credentials they will be required to do so prior to registration and not at the event registration
- Drivers must have a face covering with them in the race car in the event the driver/car requires to be towed. Drivers can use their balaclava as a face mask and keep the nose and mouth covered when out of the race car and interacting with emergency and towing services
- Teams should remain outside of the scales or impound area until directed by Tech to enter. Only the driver and essential crew (those pushing the car) are allowed in the scales or impound area. Once over the scales and if directed to impound, the driver must remain alongside the race car and not congregate with other drivers or teams. SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE OBSERVED IN IMPOUND. All crew MUST WEAR A MASK OR FACE COVER WHEN PUSHING CAR ACROSS THE SCALES AND WHILE IN IMPOUND.
- Drivers must remain with their cars (stand alongside) and not congregate in Impound
- Remember to, and encourage others to, wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds regularly especially after using the restroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing. Use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if hand washing facilities are not available. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

- Drivers meetings will be held within social distancing protocols. Separate meetings will be held for F1600, F2000, and FA/F1000. Six feet of space must be kept between individuals during the meeting.
- FRP will not have a community beverage coolers or snack/candy tray's. Participants are to bring their own. Shared coolers are discouraged to decrease the spread of the virus
- Use disinfecting wipes or disinfectant spray and disposable towels to wipe down equipment, supplies, shared work areas and surfaces between uses, shift changes and frequently throughout the day
- Clean frequently touched surfaces such as tables, counters, doorknobs, light switches, pens, keyboards, and cones (when used)
- Community food tables are discouraged
