



## **NEWS FROM SOUTH KILWORTH SCHOOL**

Amazingly the rain held off for our Halloween party, and the children all had a great time charging around in scary costumes. The great new hall facilities made it much easier to serve lots of food, and it was a really fun and successful evening. All the children brought carved pumpkins - some of them were works of artistic genius! The winner of the best carved pumpkin was Pippa Shearn in year 1.

Our year 5/6 football team took part in the final rounds of the Lutterworth Schools competition. They won their semi-final, and were the only Small School team to get through to the final. They had a tough final against Sherrier, which went to extra time, and despite playing fantastically they were just beaten 3-2 on penalties. Although they were disappointed, it was great to see how well they worked as a team, and how supportive of each other they were.

The year 5/6 athletics team entered a tournament at Lutterworth college. It was a tough competition, and the children did really well, cheering each other on, and coming 8th out of 10 teams.

We had a visit from Mr Thompson from Waitrose, who talked to the older children about what food groups make up a healthy balanced diet, and how different foods affect the body. Staying on the food theme - although possibly slightly less healthy - years 2,3,4 made flapjacks, and sold them in the playground to raise money for some new plants for Sarah's Garden.

We held a special Remembrance Day assembly on November 11th, and raised money for the Royal British Legion selling poppies, wrist bands and key rings.

We also had anti bullying week, and all children wore odd socks to remind us that everyone is different. We achieved our anti bullying award last year, and we are installing a "buddy bench" chosen by the children.

Our Eco Committee talked to the school about energy saving, and we had a "no electricity day" when we tried to use as little electricity as possible!

The children are starting to get excited about Christmas now, and all the fun things that are planned at school in December. ## **GREEN PLAQUE awarded by LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL commemorating the life and work of The Revd. Dr. William Pearson, LLD, FRS**

The Revd. Dr William Pearson, co-founder of the Royal Astronomical Society, was the rector of South Kilworth, Leicestershire, for the last three decades of his life, and built two observatories in the village to allow him to pursue his research interests; he published estimates of the obliquity of the ecliptic, and a catalogue of stars occulted by the Moon, as a result of observations from the village. As the two-hundredth anniversary of the RAS approaches, historians of astronomy in the Midlands are taking the opportunity to honour the memory of one of the RAS's founding fathers.



Jacky Harrison, the current owner of the Rectory, has had a long-standing interest in Pearson's life in South Kilworth. She teamed up with Mike Frost FRAS, director of the British Astronomical Association's historical section, to secure funding to renovate Pearson's grave in the village graveyard. Mike acknowledges with gratitude a grant from the RAS historical committee. This matches funds that Jacky secured from the South Kilworth Parish Council, and the restoration took place earlier this summer.



In parallel, Mike Frost and Carolyn Bedwell, assistant librarian at the Society for the History of Astronomy and secretary of Leicester Astronomical Society, both nominated Pearson for the Green Plaque program run by Leicestershire County Council. Leics CC invites nominations of eminent residents of the county into a popular vote to receive a plaque. Despite being up against stiff competition (including a recipient of the Victoria Cross, and the illustrator of

Thomas the Tank Engine), Pearson placed high in the popular vote and so will be commemorated by the county, with a plaque on the gates of the Rectory, right in the centre of the village.

The dedication of William Pearson's plaque will take place on the afternoon of Jan 16<sup>th</sup> 2020, two hundred years and four days after the first meeting of the society that he did much to found and to nurture. RAS President Mike Cruise has been invited to unveil the plaque and there will be a short dedication ceremony in St Nicholas' church. It is hoped that fellows and friends of the Society will take the opportunity to visit this quiet Leicestershire village and honour their illustrious predecessor.



**Action:** KB to chase up the latest financial statement for the fund, and to discuss a suitable date for Nada to visit the Parish Council


The Village Hall has provided the Council with a 'wish' list with regard to using some of the 106 fund for improvements to the hall.
