When he asked Peter and John for money, they gave him something even better! They gave him the ability to walk. Take time as a family to discuss the importance of helping others. Helping others takes time and is sometimes inconvenient, but helping others is clearly one way that we can follow Jesus. Ask your child to talk about some people who help him or her. Also, discuss some people that you all can help as a family. Make a point to help one person this week with your child, whether it is a neighbor, a friend, or a family member. We can Shine Bright for Jesus just like Peter did!
