

Grappling with Life

Living on planet earth extracts a heavy toll. It's not just the daily grind of making a living, but it's the ongoing threat of accidents, ill health, interpersonal conflicts and disappointments.

It's pretty easy to get down, even for the believer. Yet, Jesus taught us to take His joy into ourselves; He wants His joy to be made full in us (John 15.11). This happens not because we will it, but because we receive what He has already provided.

Indeed, "the joy of the LORD is our strength" (Neh.8.10c). That is, when we consider the work that God has done for us; when we consider His redemptive act in Christ; when we remember His good favor to deliver us and prosper us, then we should receive these blessings, especially His forgiveness, and rejoice. "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say, rejoice" (Phil.4.4). Why? Because "Every good thing bestowed and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation, or shifting shadow" (James 1.17).

Nehemiah instructed the people Israel to "not mourn or weep," but to have God's joy (Neh.8.9). They were mourning and weeping when they heard Ezra read from the book of the Law. They were devastated to see their fallenness in the light of God's Word. They forgot His many benefits (Ps.103.1-5).

Finally, to experience "the peace that passes understanding" and to be joyful, we must learn to let go and let God.
