

### <u>Words</u>

My mother taught me that "words are things," i.e., they have all the power to kill, maim and destroy, or, the power to create, heal and bless. Be careful therefore in what you say.

Remember that God created with His Word; remember that Jesus is the living Word of God (John 1.1,14). We have that God giving nature, being made in His image, to build up or tear down with words.

When we are careless with words, as when we pronounce curses on someone or something, we are doing the devil's work, who "accuses our brethren before our God day and night" (Rev.12.10c). Far better to say nothing, or to pronounce a blessing on someone for their salvation.

Think about yourself too. What are you saying about yourself? Are you typing yourself as sick and inadequate? Are you continuing to identify yourself as a sinner, a loser or worse? It's time to speak words of life to yourself. It's time to believe God in Christ, and pronounce words of life, well-being and blessing. "Give thanks in all things for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus (1 Thess.5.18).

In the words of our prayers, we reveal our mind's territory. Turn away from "stinkin' thinkin', and start praying what God has promised, not what you think can happen.

"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Phil.4.13). Pastor Tom
