Governor's Orders April 22nd

You likely have heard that Governor Stitt laid out formal plans yesterday to begin reopening businesses in Oklahoma. As of May 1st, restaurants, movie theaters, gyms, sporting venues and churches in Oklahoma will be opening with certain precautions. We are waiting to hear Mayor Bynum's orders for Tulsa in his press conference on Friday April 24th. The reopening of these businesses on May 1st is part of Phase 1 of a 3-phase approach that the President established late last week. Visitation of long-term care communities does not occur until Phase 3, which is – at a minimum – 45 days from now if Oklahoma continues to show a decline in COVID-positive testing.

Therefore, as the community outside of Monterey begins to reengage, our community here at Monterey needs to adhere to different standards in order to keep everyone safe. Our COVID-19 Task Force, Unidine team and wellness staff are working hard behind the scenes on a plan to reengage residents in the community. One of the first areas in which we will begin to offer services is the Spa. This will most likely occur with a limited number of residents accommodated in the spa area at one time, by appointment only, and utilizing proper sanitation and a face mask. We will communicate a plan early next week for these services to likely begin after May 1st. In the meantime, please do not call the Spa to schedule appointments as we are not prepared to begin booking those appointments at this time. We will communicate to all of you when the time to schedule appointments has come.
