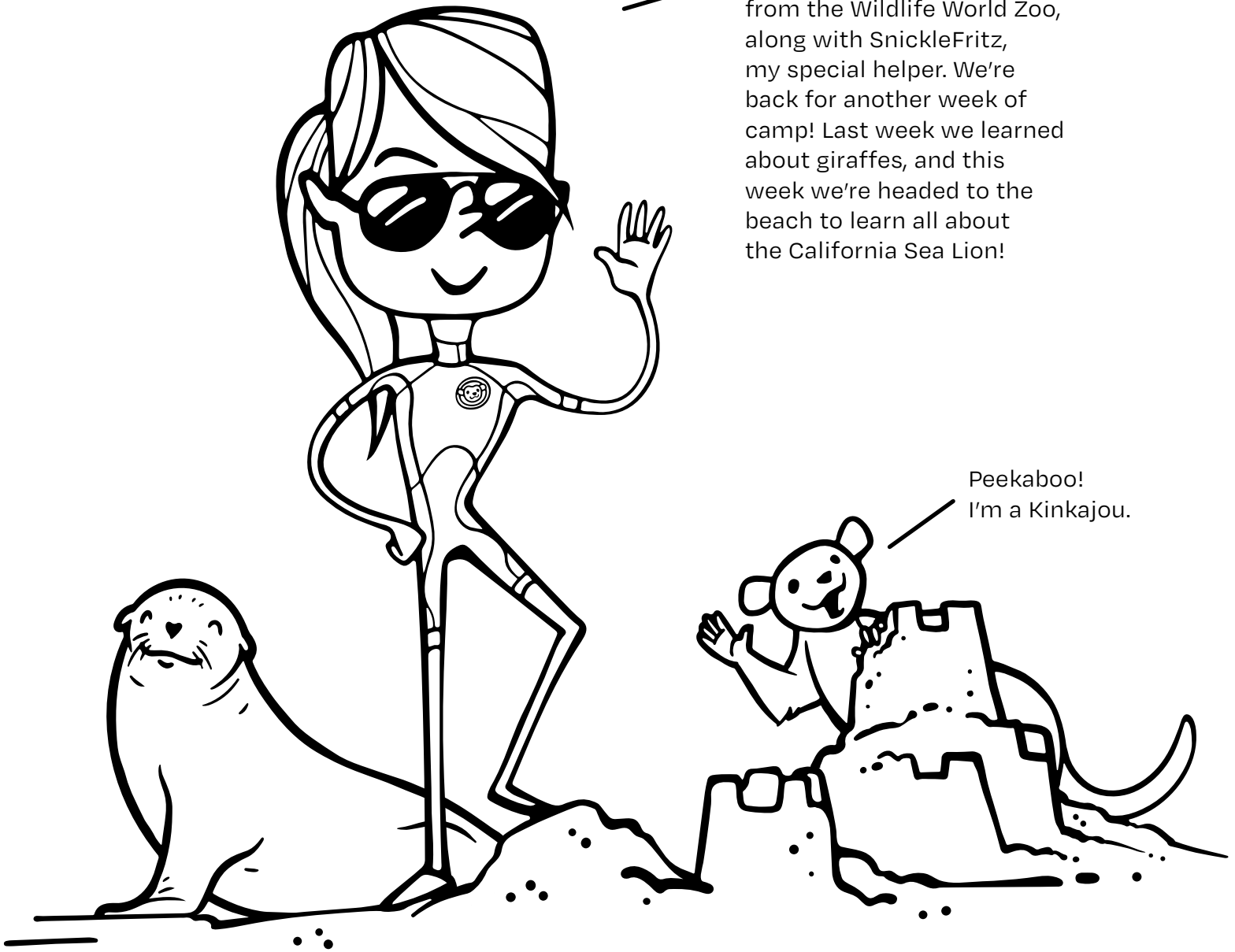


Meet Ranger Kristy and SnickleFritz

Oh no! It looks like the wind and the tide have scattered our beach equipment! Can you help me find them all?

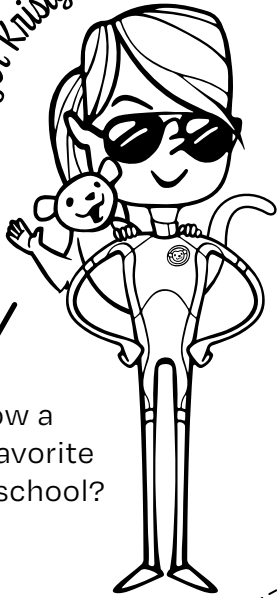

California Sea Lion Mask

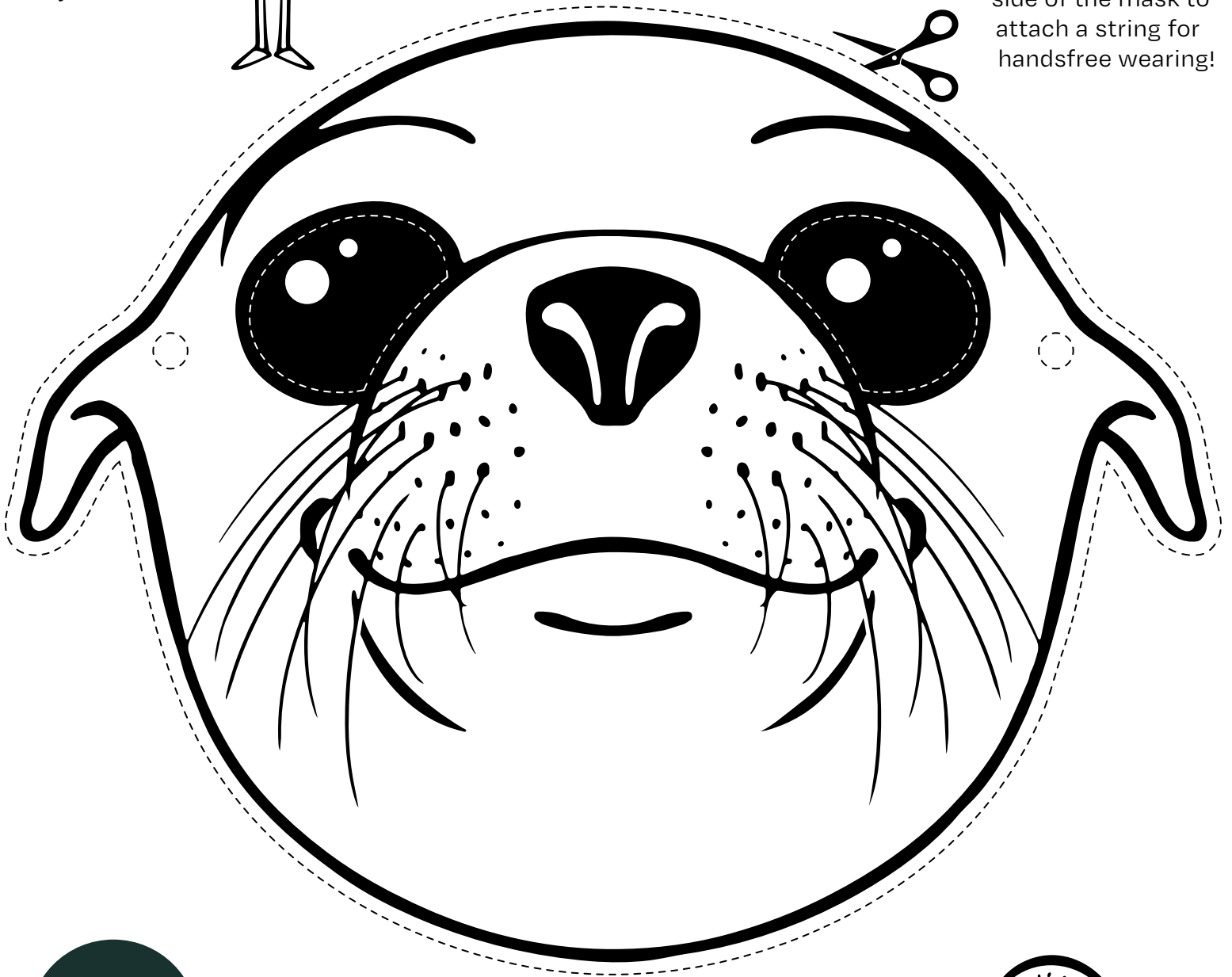
Unlike other seals, the California Sea Lion external ears, and large eyes that help them see very well on land and under the water. California Sea lions, like other mammals, have fur and their long whiskers help them navigate deep dives underwater when it's hard to see. Unlike Snicklefritz,

California Sea Lions don't have to plug their nose when they go underwater, their nostrils close on their own!
