This Trophy commenced in 2001 and is played as a Stableford Event.

Only two members Peter Ferrett (handicap 37) and Mal Cross (19) scored more than 36 stableford points, both scoring 37 points. As it was for a yearly trophy, a maximum handicap of 36 applied, which meant Peter's score dropped to 36 points. Mal won with 37 points for his second win in this event in the past 6 years.
