

# Monitored Access

CDC and CMS guidelines recommend opening up visitation with screening and precautions to protect residents and employees.



## ▶ **Monitored Visitation with Screening and Precautions**

- Check-in required for all campus visitors
- Limited family visitation allowed, advanced notice required
- Volunteers may resume work
- Non-essential healthcare workers and contractors may resume

## ▶ **Mandatory Masking**

- Residents encouraged to wear masks
- Visitors required to wear provided masks
- Other personal protective equipment available for use as required

## ▶ **Social Distancing Required**

- No hugging, kissing or handshaking – and remain 6 feet apart
- Limited communal dining in small groups with 6-feet between tables
- Some common areas available with social distancing
- Group activities limited to number who can safely social distance in location

## ▶ **Monitoring Health & Hygiene**

- Routine signs and symptoms checks on staff and residents
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth
- Screening upon re-entering the community per CDC, state and local guidance
- Handwashing/alcohol gel use required

## ▶ **Careful Movement**

- Limited common areas available with social distancing
- Some amenities may reopen with precautions as COVID-19 conditions allow
- Limit common surfaces touched
- Resume medical appointments/transportation and group outings with mask usage, hand hygiene and social distancing; residents screened upon return

We are in PHASE 3 of reopening our community. Visitation is allowed with screening and precautions, including wearing of medical face masks and other personal protective equipment as deemed necessary. Please consider continuing to communicate with your family members via telephone, video chat, or email as much as possible to keep the risk of COVID-19 infections as low as possible.
