Gold Coast Highway (Broadbeach to Burleigh Heads)

Investigation works

June 2020

About the works

Underground service investigation and identification works are currently occurring along the Gold Coast Highway from Broadbeach to Burleigh Heads.

On behalf of the Department of Transport and Main Roads and GoldlinQ, Dynamic Excavations will undertake the works at approximately 40 selected sites along the Gold Coast Highway between Broadbeach and Burleigh Heads.

Works will include site investigations using a vacuum truck and surveying equipment to locate underground services.

Timeframes

These works will continue throughout June 2020 and will be carried out during day shifts from 6am to 6pm where possible.

Some **Night works** will be required from Monday 15 June onwards between 6pm and 6am in some locations due to access and safety requirements.

Workers may arrive onsite prior to 6pm to prepare for the night's activities. For the safety of workers this work is done at night when traffic volumes are at the lowest.

Expected impacts

Short term lane closures may be required and you may notice some changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, however some short-term changes to pedestrian routes may occur.

Some impacts should be expected including the following.

- Noise from:
 - Vacuum truck and cutting equipment
 - reversing alarms used on all machinery and vehicles for safety
- Possible light spill from mobile lighting towers used to light the work zones
- Construction vehicles and workers in the area.
- The works have been programmed so that they will be undertaken progressively at each site possibly over several hours.

While every effort will be taken to minimise impacts, some minor disturbance is unavoidable. We thank you for your patience and understanding.

It is important to note that wet weather or unforeseen circumstances may impact or delay the work schedule.
