

# Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 3

## Gold Coast Highway (Broadbeach to Burleigh Heads)

### Investigation works

August 2020

### About the works

Underground service investigation and identification works are continuing along the Gold Coast Highway from Broadbeach to Burleigh Heads.

On behalf of the Department of Transport and Main Roads and GoldlinQ, sub-contractors will undertake the works at multiple locations along the Gold Coast Highway between Broadbeach and Burleigh Heads.

Works will include site investigations using a combination of ground penetrating radar, vacuum trucks and surveying equipment to locate underground services.

### Timeframes

These works will continue intermittently from August through to October 2020 and will be carried out during day shifts from 6am to 6pm where possible.

Some **night works** will be required for two weeks from Monday 17 August between 6pm and 6am due to access and safety requirements in certain locations including works in the median of the Gold Coast Highway.

Workers may arrive onsite prior to 6pm to prepare for the night's activities. For the safety of workers this work is done at night when traffic volumes are at the lowest.

### Expected impacts

Short term lane closures may be required, and you may notice some changes around your local area such as construction vehicles, traffic management signs and personnel.

Pedestrian access will be maintained, however some short-term changes to pedestrian routes may occur.

Some impacts can be expected including:

- Possible light spill from mobile lighting towers used to light the work zones
- Construction vehicles and workers in the area
- Noise from:
  - Vacuum truck and cutting equipment if required
  - reversing alarms used on all machinery and vehicles for safety
- The works have been programmed to be undertaken progressively at each site possibly over several hours
- Should day works may be required, traffic management will be in place to support the activities.

While every effort will be taken to minimise impacts, some minor disturbance is unavoidable. We thank you for your patience and understanding.

*It is important to note that wet weather or unforeseen circumstances may impact or delay the work schedule.*
