

Site mobilisation

Broadbeach South

From 25 August 2021, John Holland site offices will be installed at 2600-2610 Gold Coast Highway (in between Broadbeach South station and Pacific Fair Drive).

The site office will be accessed regularly by the project team and construction workforce during early works and throughout the construction period.

What to expect

- Oversized semi-trailers will deliver the modular site offices overnight.
- A small crane will be used to assemble the modular offices.
- Minor excavation works will take place as we install plumbing, communications and electricity to service the site office.
- There will be changed traffic conditions around the work zone during delivery.
- Please follow signage and traffic controller directions.
- Every effort will be made to minimise noise and vibration impacts through a range of at-source mitigation measures, including placing generators and machinery away from residences where possible.
- The site office will be occupied from mid-September 2021, for the duration of light rail construction activities.

While every effort will be taken to minimise impacts, some minor disturbance is unavoidable. We thank you for your patience and understanding.

Timing

- Mobilisation will take place from 25 August.
- Deliveries of site offices on oversized semi-trailers will occur between 6:30pm and 6:30am from 25 August.
- Site office fit out will occur during the day only (Monday to Saturday, 6:30am and 6:30pm).
- Hours of site office operation will generally be Monday to Saturday between 6:30am and 6:30pm. At certain times, the site office will operate on weekends and overnight.
- Workers may arrive to site from 6am and will be required at the site office after hours when overnight works are taking place.
