Message

The party on board the cruise ship was in full swing. Speeches were being made by the captain and officers of the ship and the guests were enjoying their week-long voyage. Sitting at the head table was a 70-year-old man who, somewhat embarrassed by the attention he was given, was doing his best to accept the praise being poured upon him. Earlier that morning a young woman had apparently fallen overboard, and within seconds this elderly gentleman was in the cold dark waters at her side. She was rescued and the elderly man became an instant hero.

When the time eventually came for the brave passenger to speak, the stateroom fell into a hush as he rose from his chair and walked to the microphone. In what was probably the shortest “hero” speech ever offered, he spoke these stirring words:
