Transport needed

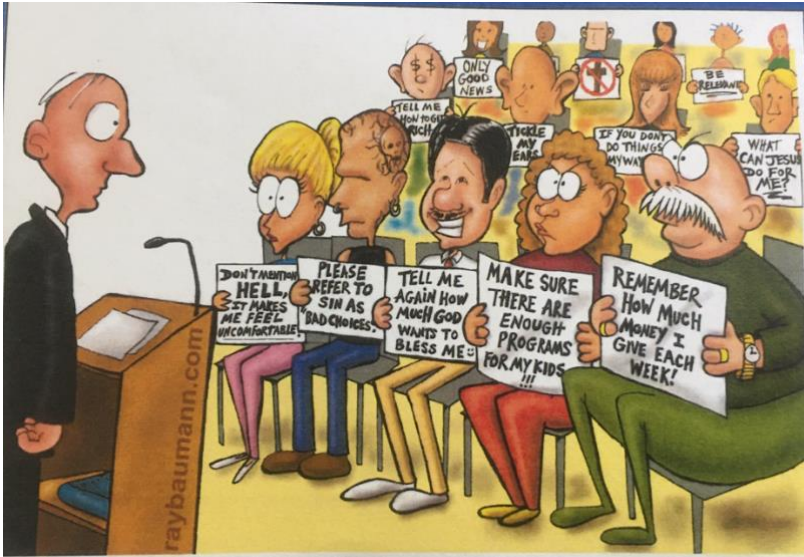
