Art360 is an innovative collaborative program between Community Support Services, Inc. and Chicago Zoological Society-Brookfield Zoo that brings art, learning, creativity and social inclusion full circle. Art360 staff will engage young adults with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities in hands on, therapeutic, and social activities through the creative arts and the social atmosphere of the zoo. During this 9-week program, individuals will observe various animals in their habitats, while enhancing social skills and discovering new forms of self-expression through art techniques. The program culminates with individuals showcasing their works of art in a final exhibition. Art360 is geared toward teens and young adults with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities (I/DD). There is an activity fee associated with this program.
