

**CITY OF THORP
SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2020 AT 5:30PM
AT THORP CITY HALL**

1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 5:30pm by Mayor Wnek. In attendance were; Alderpersons Abramczak, Korn, Lawcewicz, Rosemeyer, Chief of Police Schneider, Public Works Director Wundrow and Clerk-Treasurer Pogodzinski.

2. Consider moving into a Committee of the Whole to discuss the 2021 General Fund Operating Budget. M/M/S/ (Korn, Abramczak) to move into a Committee of the Whole to discuss the 2021 General Fund Operating Budget. Motion passed 4-0.

The budget was reviewed line by line with the department heads. Alderperson Einhorn arrived at the meeting. A decrease in special assessment revenues was questioned. Clerk-Treasurer noted that some special assessments were paid off in their entirety, which affected the revenue for future years. It was noted that early payoff is an allowable option. A change to health insurance coverage was discussed. More information will be brought to the next meeting and employees will meet to discuss options. The basic change in the budget was due to the debt payment increase. It was noted that the City took on new debt with the new street project, resulting in an increase. Also, current revenues are down due to Covid-19. Room tax, park reservations, and a decrease in pool revenues were some areas affected. Not knowing what the year 2021 will bring, revenues were reviewed cautiously along with expenses.

3. Meeting was adjourned at 6:45pm.
