Ride SacRT Fixed Route Bus and Light Rail FREE for Sacramento Free Museum Weekend Saturday, March 4 and Sunday, March 5, 2023



SacRT has partnered with Sacramento Area Museums to offer FREE rides on fixed route bus and light rail for the free museum weekend on Saturday, March 4 and Sunday, March 5, 2023. *Please note that light rail will have several service disruptions this weekend. Gold Line Trains

Light rail service on the Gold Line will operate between Power Inn and Historic Folsom stations and between 29th Street and Sacramento Valley stations. A bus bridge (shuttle bus) will be in place between the Power Inn and 29th Street stations. Riders traveling between Power Inn and 29th Street Station will need to board a special service bus that will drop off and pick up riders at every closed station in between.

Blue Line Trains

Light rail service on the Blue Line (north) will operate between the 13th Street and Watt/I-80 stations, and light rail service on the Blue Line (south) will operate between the City College and Cosumnes River College stations. A bus bridge (shuttle bus) will be in place between the 13th Street and City College stations. Riders traveling downtown will need to exit the train at 13th Street or City College Station (depending on direction of travel) and board a special service bus that will drop off and pick up riders at every closed station in between.

To ride free, present this flyer to the bus operator or light rail fare inspection staff upon request. Only one flyer needed per group. Valid Saturday, March 4 and Sunday, March 5, 2023 from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on fixed-route bus and light rail only.
