

SUPREME COURT WILL REVIEW ACA INDIVIDUAL MANDATE NEXT FALL

The Supreme Court of the United States will review the constitutionality of the Affordable Care Act's (ACA) individual mandate to maintain health insurance coverage during the fall of 2020. Two different petitions related to the litigation challenging the ACA, will be considered by the Court. Oral arguments in Texas v. United States may be scheduled before the presidential election, but based on Court precedence, a final ruling in the case is not expected until some point in 2021.

No matter how long it takes to resolve this matter, all provisions of the ACA remain in force for the time being and all ACA requirements for employers, individuals, and health plans remain unchanged.
