UPS for DownS Theatre Program Request For Proposal

General Information:

UPS for DownS (United Parent Support for Down Syndrome) is a Schaumburg, Illinois based non for profit organization that has provided support, information, and community opportunities for people with Down syndrome and their families for more than 45 years.

UPS for DownS Theatre Company brings together actors of all abilities to perform community theater with the goal to provide an inclusive forum to highlight the talents and contributions of all, specifically youth and adults with Down syndrome.

Background:

Over the past fifteen (15) years, UPS for DownS has collaborated with a community partner to create inclusive community theatre featuring individuals with Down syndrome performing side by side with neurotypical peers. The program has grown since its humble beginnings and our actors, families, and audiences have come to expect that with hard work we can create amazing performing art when given patience, collaboration, cooperation, and high expectations.

Project Goals:

Seeking a community partner to serve as the creative theatrical team in the production of an inclusive community based musical theatre program featuring individuals with Down syndrome and neurotypical peers. In casting, the community partner will use a creative and thoughtful approach to showcase diversity and a wide range of talent.

The community partner selected will emphasize diversity, kindness, inclusion, high expectations, and relentless positivity.

The community partner will hold high expectations for each participant while providing supports for independence as necessary for each participant. All actors hold responsibility and agency for their own roles.

Project Scope:

- The complete production and administration of four (4) in person performances of one production
- The twice weekly rehearsal process from auditions to production would be a minimum of four to six (4-6) months. See Appendix A for example timeline.
 - The rehearsal process has historically included two (2) rehearsals a week for two hours with one evening weekday and one weekend afternoon
 - The technical rehearsals have historically included three to four days of technical rehearsal with cast present at the performance venue.
- It is critical that production value to be high including costuming, sound, microphones, lighting, and set design.
- Create a team of individuals to fulfill production and performance responsibilities
 - Team members will fulfill the tasks of: Director, Assistant Director, Stage Manager, Music Director, Choreographer, Production Manager, Technical Director, Scenic, Lighting, Sound, Costume, and Prop managers
 - Your production team may include paid support staff, volunteers, and interns to support the rehearsal and production process
 - Volunteers must be available consistently through the course of the program
 - All production staff shall have theatrical experience or expertise in a relevant area such as Speech and Language, Special Education, Education, Music, or similar experience with individuals with disabilities.
- The complete administrative oversight of the production including but not limited to the holding
 of auditions, casting, rehearsals, set construction, designer contract management, cast
 management and communication, rehearsal materials (scripts, cast practice materials,
 soundtrack, schedule, etc), transportation of sets to and from the performance site, production
 coordination with performance and rehearsal venues and UPS for DownS Theatre Coordinator.
- Communicate to cast and families with a weekly email with the next week's schedule and call, reviewing activities from the past rehearsal, and any notes
- Support and manage a cast ranging from minimum of thirty-five (35) to maximum of fifty (50) actors. All who register shall be cast within the production. The specific role of each actor is based on their audition at the discretion of the community partner.
- Historically actors have ranged from ages 8 through adulthood.
- Collaborate with UPS for DownS to determine mutually agreed upon show, consideration of options for double casting, timeline for upcoming production, and develop a plan for captioning of the show.
- Community partner is an independent contractor of UPS for DownS and is solely responsible for any staff the community partner hires for the project.

UPS for DownS as Producer

UPS for DownS has been responsible in past productions for the following: ticket sales,
 registration of participants, cast recruitment, payment and licensing of rights for the show and

materials kit, playbill program ads, playbill publishing, fundraising, promotion and marketing of the show, tshirts, concessions, front of house volunteers, cast photos, video recording of the show, procurement of performance venue and rehearsal space.

- UPS for DownS will host a cast party for the cast and staff with the expectation that all will attend if able.
- UPS for DownS has the right to have a representative at any and all rehearsals.
- UPS for DownS will timely pay the agreed upon amount in installments.
- UPS for DownS will provide community partner with 1099 for tax purposes.
- UPS for DownS can assist if necessary in identifying volunteers and production staff from past productions and community to support rehearsal process and backstage during the production.

UPS for DownS anticipates continuing the above responsibilities unless the community partner proposes otherwise.

Note: The performance venue and rehearsal space can be negotiated based on the resources and proposal of the community partner.

UPS for DownS and the selected community partner will enter into a contract specifying the details and length of the agreement. We welcome proposals for a minimum of one (1) and a maximum of three (3) years.

Minimum Proposal Requirements:

Proposals include:

- Current and past experience as relevant to the services requested and connection, if any, to the disability related community and/or UPS for DownS.
- A statement of the individual/organization/company's philosophy regarding the role of the arts and inclusion in the community as a whole.
- A statement as to how the organization or individual would approach the project.
- A description of the ideal team and qualifications of the people you intend to create the project with. We understand that this may be speculative and will likely not include specific names of individuals.
- Proposals must be submitted with an explanation of how the project would be produced with a
 budget not to exceed \$40,000. Please see project scope compared to what UPS for DownS
 provides as producer for what to include within the proposed budget.
- Letter of reference
- Additional relevant information to aid in the selection process.

Selection Process:

- Deadline for submission of proposal is May 1, 2022.

- By May 15, 2022, finalists will be invited for an interview with selection committee.
