



TRAINER LEVEL OSEP Educator Training Programme Overview

The Oceania Sport Education Programme (OSEP) is a joint initiative of the Australian Sports Commission, the Oceania National Olympic Committee and the Organisation of Sports Federations of Oceania to support the development of sport education in the Pacific region.

The OSEP comprises a number of training programmes that have been specifically designed to provide a regional approach to sport education by developing flexible, relevant, modern curricula and training support resources in the areas of coaching, officiating, administration and assessor/presenter training.

The OSEP offers three streams of training programmes plus the Trainer pathway:

1. Community Coach & Official and Sport in Communities Administrator
2. Competition Coach and Management in Sporting Organisations
3. Advanced Sport Management Course
4. Assessor and Presenter, Educator and Master Educator courses.

COURSE FACILITATORS

To support the community and competition level training programme, specially trained and accredited facilitators will help to ensure training is delivered to a high standard and all course participants are competent in the course they are undertaking.

The OSEP Educator Training Programme is designed to equip participants with the necessary skills to present and assess OSEP training programmes for which they possess the relevant technical knowledge and skills.

OSEP EDUCATOR TRAINING PROGRAM

The OSEP Educator Training Programme is three days in duration and is delivered in a face-to-face practical environment by accredited OSEP Master Educators. It consists of three modules:

1. OSEP Trainer pathway
2. Designing Learning
3. Reporting Procedures

Upon successful completion of the OSEP Educator Training Programme, participants will be able to:

- Complete all planning requirements including providing a structured written session plan
- Design the introduction of a session
- Deliver information and instructions in logical sequence
- Use appropriate communication skills to maximize learning
- Use a structured conclusion to sum up session
- Conduct the summative assessment tasks
