

## Cricket Ball

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- **WHERE TO PLAY:**
  - Outside
- **NUMBER OF PLAYERS:**
  - 4 or more players to a game
    - Multiple games can be played simultaneously
- **GRADE LEVELS:**
  - 2nd-8th grades
- **EQUIPMENT:**
  - One bade
  - One cone
  - One bat
  - One softball
- **HOW TO PLAY:**
  - Set a cone and base in a straight line about 30-40feet apart.
  - Assign four players to each game
    - Pitcher
    - Batter
    - Catcher
    - Fielder
  - The pitcher begins by throwing the ball toward the cone,
    - Which the batter is standing in front of and off to the side.
      - If the pitcher hits the cone
        - It counts as a strike
      - If the batter hits the ball
        - They run to the base and back (without stopping) before the catcher is thrown the ball.
        - If successful
          - The batter scores a run for himself.
        - If unsuccessful
          - The batter is out

- Unlike softball
  - Tagging and catching fly hits do not count as outs
- After each out or run
  - Players are to rotate positions.
  - The batter becomes the next fielder
  - The fielder moves up to pitcher
  - The pitcher goes to catcher
  - Catcher becomes the new batter.
