

No-Outs Kickball

- **WHERE TO PLAY:**
 - Outdoors
 - Preferably on a softball field
- **NUMBER OF PLAYERS:**
 - 6-9 players on a team
- **GRADE LEVELS:**
 - 3rd-8th grades
- **EQUIPMENT:**
 - A large playground ball or foam soccer ball

- **HOW TO PLAY:**
 - The game is played very much like softball
 - Form two equal teams
 - Team One lines up to kick
 - Team Two assumes fielding positions.
 - The objective for the kicker is to kick the ball out into fair territory
 - The kicker then runs the bases without stopping before the catcher gains possession of the ball and yells “freeze”
 - The baserunner is to stop running and to stay in that position
 - Even if the runner is not on a base.
 - The baserunner resumes running around the bases when the next kicker kicks the ball
 - The baserunners do not stop after circling all the bases once
 - The base runners continue to run and score until everyone on their team has kicked
 - Teams switch places when everyone has kicked
 - A point is scored each time a baserunner touches home plate.
 - The team with the highest number of points (or " runs") at the end of a designated number of innings wins the game.
