



Viz.ai Launches Covid-19 Patient Triage Tool for Hospitals

Boca Raton Regional Hospital Becomes the First Florida Hospital to Use as Growing Numbers of Patients Present with COVID-19 Symptoms

San Francisco, CA (April 30th) – Viz.ai, the leader in synchronized stroke-care software, announces the release of Viz COVID-19, the company’s COVID-19 patient triage software currently being used in Boca Raton Regional Hospital to improve patient management and allow for a safer hospital workplace during the pandemic.

An increasing number of reports show coronavirus patients need specialist treatment. This patient triage software can improve communication around a specific COVID-19 patient and help get the right patient to the right doctor safely and efficiently. Aside from chest CTs and X-rays, the Viz-COVID-19 triage software can also assist with two major issues at the core of addressing the coronavirus: resource management and limiting patient exposure.

“Treating patients with coronavirus can be a challenge for any hospital given how the patients come into the emergency room highly contagious and frequently needing immediate intervention from multiple specialists,” said Samer Fahmy, M.D., vice president of quality and informatics at Boca Raton Regional Hospital. “We have identified COVID-19 care teams and are using the triage software in a way that will allow us to both care for coronavirus patients and minimize the risk of transmission to other patients and employees in the hospital.”

Viz.ai released the patient triage tool at no charge for any hospital in the US dealing with COVID-19. The software can be downloaded on any smartphone or tablet and fits within the standard pandemic protocols of all hospitals. Boca Raton Regional Hospital currently has triage capabilities for coronavirus patients without disruption to normal care activities.

The Viz-COVID-19 software allows health care professionals to view chest CTs and X-rays remotely on their smartphone. Providers can then decide if the patient should be escalated, isolated, or sent home. Viz COVID-19 integrates seamlessly within the standard workflow in the existing clinical care setting for care of COVID-19 patients at Boca Regional Hospital. When the patient undergoes expedited COVID-19 testing, results can be shared with the entire care team through HIPAA-compliant chat that enables health care professionals to discuss patient details and make treatment decisions safely and securely.

“Our goal is to put patients first and help leaders in the medical community like Boca Raton Regional Hospital do the same. If our software can help in some way during this time of national emergency, we want to ensure its availability and utility for all health care professionals,” said Chris Mansi, CEO of Viz.ai.
