RESOLUTION NO. 2012- 03

RE: "OPTING IN" TO THE VOLUNTARY STEWARDSHIP PROGRAM (RCW 36.70A.705)

WHEREAS: the Washington State Legislature, through ESHB 1886, created a Voluntary Stewardship Program (VSP) for protection of critical areas in areas of agricultural activities; and

WHEREAS: ESHB 1886, as codified in RCW 36.70A.710, states that "As an alternative to protecting critical areas in areas used for agricultural activities through development regulations adopted under RCW 36.70A.060, the legislative authority of a county may elect to protect such critical areas through the program"; and

WHEREAS: in order to participate in the VSP, the legislative authority of a county must elect to participate by January 22, 2012; and

WHEREAS: prior to electing to participate in the VSP, a county is required to (a) confer with tribes, and environmental and agricultural interests; and (b) provide notice following the public participation and notice provisions of RCW 36.70A.035 to property owners and other affected and interested individuals, tribes, government agencies, businesses, school districts, and organizations; and

WHEREAS: Chelan County provided opportunities for comment and consideration of the Voluntary Stewardship Program as follows:

a. Chelan County Board of Commissioners held an informational meeting regarding the provisions of VSP with the Washington State Association of Counties and Washington Farm Bureau on November 22, 2011. Meeting was advertised on regular Commission agenda. See attached Commission agenda and meeting sign-in sheet.

b. Chelan County Board of Commissioners held a duly advertised Public Meeting on January 9, 2012, regarding the VSP. The public meeting was advertised as follows:

- i. Wenatchee World (local newspaper of record) on December 23, 2011 (see attached).
- ii. Chelan County Natural Resource Department e-mail notification to WRIAs 40A, 45, 46 and 47 watershed planning units.
- iii. Chelan County Community Development Department e-mail notification to agency distribution list.
- iv. Chelan County Commissioners' office Public Service Announcement e-mail distribution to local media.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Chelan County Board of Commissioners hereby:

1. Elects to have all lands within the political boundaries of Chelan County participate in the Voluntary Stewardship Program.

2. Nominates WRIA 40A (Squilchuck/Stemilt), WRIA 45 (Wenatchee), WRIA 46 (Entiat), WRIA 47 (Lake Chelan), all tributaries to the Columbia River, and all remaining properties as priority watersheds.
3. Elects to have Chelan County proceed as required by ESHB 1886, as currently codified in RCW 36.70A, to implement the requirements of the Voluntary Stewardship Program once the Washington State Legislature provides adequate funding for such activity.






