A private island of this scale — 15 acres — doesn't come up for sale every day. So in-the-know buyers have to be ready to jump at the chance to beat other offers.

In this case, there were three bidders, all of whom already own on the lake. "They're people who recognized how special it is," says listing agent Sandy Waldie.

She says in the last decade only a few islands this size have been available on any of the lakes (Joseph, Rosseau and Muskoka) in the area. And this one offers 4,200 feet of water frontage, two one-bedroom, one-bathroom cottages and a large five-bedroom boathouse.

With wood-lined interiors and fieldstone fireplaces, the properties on the island bring to mind an old-fashioned lodge, says Waldie, and make for an ideal family compound.

"The main cottage is for cooking and dining," a space to gather, she says. "The boathouse is the main sleeping house" — a space to retreat. All "have been meticulously cared for over the years," she adds.

For young children at the cottage, there is also a beach with shallow water and a grassy area perfect for a game of croquet or a garden party.

Located in the heart of Beaumaris, a coveted historical area, the island was put up for sale by a community foundation. It decided the funds from selling the land would do more for the community than keeping it. Meanwhile, the new owners are in it for the long term, planning to enjoy their island for 50 or 60 years.

Buyers in cottage country are usually shopping for something that, well, looks like a cottage — so a year-round waterfront home can linger on the market.

The owners, Jim and Sue Halliday, say they have enjoyed the property year-round for 23 years and have many wonderful memories.

As for other buyers looking for a property match, "the real estate market has seen a good increase over the last three seasons," says co-listing agent Ashley Barker, "and I feel the fall market will be very strong until the snow flies."
