

Course Title: Psychology

Description:

This 32-week introductory psychology class is designed to give a brief overview of the scientific study of the mind. Over the course of the class, we will cover the history and significance of psychology and how that developed into modern practice. The year-long high school course will include a wide variety of topics like: the brain and perception, genetics, how learning happens, communications, personality theory, and counseling. One or two research writing assignments of two to three pages are planned as part of this class. Taught with technical medical expertise and from a Christian worldview, this class will help prepare students interested in psychology, counseling, medicine, teaching, and other human development related fields.
