



Course Title: Composition and World Literature

Description:

This course is designed for students in approximately 9th to 11th grades and will include writing and composition against the backdrop of classic literature from various genres. Beginning with a focus on creative writing exercises designed to give students confidence that they CAN write, we'll move forward in learning the basics of academic writing. Strong, classic literature selections will be introduced in genre units throughout the remainder of the school. Students are guided through six to eight-week sessions of Shakespeare, Dark Romanticism & Gothic literature, and Science Fiction & Dystopian literature.

Students will have the opportunity to utilize the creative writing and academic writing principles they learn throughout the year.

This unique option is the equivalent of 1 high school English credit and appropriate for early high school grades.

Students must have daily access to the internet and printer.
