We have developed a 10-week training program to help prepare individuals for mid-term or long-term ministry. This includes six weeks of lectures and four weeks of practical application. Seasoned missionaries speak on specific topics, integrate hands-on ministry training, and immerse participants in cultural experiences. Applications are required for entrance into the training. Trainings occur every spring and fall.

MID-TERM (8 WEEKS–2 YEARS)

Living Hope Residency | Medford, Oregon

Dates: Flexible

As a resident ministry leader, you will have the opportunity to grow as a leader and explore ministry in a team setting to clarify God's calling on your life. As a part of the ministry leadership team, you will learn from experienced NAMB planters and ministry leaders in the Northwest. You will gain experience with children's ministry, youth ministry, community outreach, evangelism, preaching/teaching, partnership development, ministry training, and administration.

Journey Point Church Residency | Denver, Colorado

Dates: Flexible

Develop spiritually and as a leader as you serve as a church planting resident. You will grow in ministry as you engage in community outreach projects, relational evangelism tasks, and church responsibilities.

Awakening Church Residency | Bellevue, Washington

Dates: Flexible

The resident will come alongside Awakening Church in the greater Seattle area. The residents will be exposed to international ministries and church planting.

River City Church Residency | Vancouver, Washington

Dates: Flexible

The intern will help with outreach and reaching those far from God. The intern will be trained to reach those in the post-modern culture and in an urban setting.

Gateway Church Residency | Columbia Falls, Montana

June 1–August 1

The Church Planting Intern is to develop as a leader in Gateway church by developing himself or herself through intentional training. The resident will have opportunities to serve in the church and help develop other leaders. The intern will be exposed to spiritual formation, discipleship opportunities, and other opportunities that line up with the church's vision.

North American Mission Board (NAMB)—GenSend | Various North American Cities

Dates: May–August

Learn to live your life on mission in a specific context. You will serve alongside church planters and compassion ministries to see and experience what it takes to spread Christ's love and message of redemption to that area.

NAMB—Journeyman | Various North American Cities

Dates: Various (two-year term)

Journeyman work with and through NAMB's compassion ministry, Send Relief, where they become a vital part of NAMB missionary teams. Serving as a Journeyman allows young professionals to be employed, serve on mission, and explore the potential for lifelong service as a missionary or church planter.

INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS

SHORT-TERM

Jinotega City | Jinotega Church Planting Network

May 21–28 | Family Friendly

Partner with church plants to engage the city with the Gospel through door-to-door evangelism and community events.

Tegucigalpa, Honduras | Impacto Church

June 11–18 | College Ministry

Serve in Tegucigalpa with Impacto Church. The team will help with construction, VBS, and personal evangelism. The goal is to impact some communities around us and help small churches reach out to their community.

Guadalajara, Mexico | Iglesia Vida

July 16–23 | Family Friendly

Serve with Iglesia Vida through evangelism, VBS, construction, and various ministry opportunities at the church.

San Pedro Sula, Honduras | Impacto Church

September 30–October 7 | Young Adults

Serve with Impacto Church in San Pedro Sula to reach the community through VBS, door-to-door evangelism, school evangelism, and light construction.

Jinotega City | Nicaragua Church Planting Network

October 9–16 | High School

Working with three of our church plants in Jinotega City and surrounding towns, teaching children, reaching teenagers, and service projects in the community.

Kenya, Africa | East Africa Project

January 2023 | Family Friendly

Team will minister in a few orphanages, Church leadership training, Discipleship training, widow's, and orphan's ministry. Partner with IMB personnel in Nairobi as well.

Europe | International Mission Board (IMB)

July 2023

Partner with the IMB to encourage and care for over 360 full-time field personnel and their families through opportunities to serve in the following areas: children's and student ministries, worship, media, security, medical, education, and more.

MID-TERM (8 WEEKS–2 YEARS)

Words of Life Ministry | Phnom Penh, Cambodia

Dates: Flexible

This internship will involve extensive travel in Cambodia. The interns will grow in their understanding of evangelism, discipleship, Buddhism, local language learning, and partnership development.

IMB Opportunities | Nairobi, Kenya

Dates: Various

International School Teacher in Nairobi, Kenya

Roslyn Academy in Nairobi has 650 students representing missionary, diplomatic, and business communities from over 50 nations. A high school teacher is needed for chemistry, biology, English, or industrial arts/pottery/"maker space." Along with teaching, you will evangelize and disciple within the school community and in the city. Open to a certified teacher.

Disciple Maker in Nairobi, Kenya

If you have a passion for sports, business, healthcare, or education and a desire to share the good news of Jesus, you are needed in Nairobi. Whether it is playing sports with Kenyan youth, teaching ESL in a community center, making home visits to the sick, or eating a meal in a student's home, there are many ways to engage followers of Islam here. Open to a couple or a team of two.

IMB—Journeyman

Location: Various

Dates: Various (two-year term)

Description: A Journeyman's primary responsibility is to engage in the missionary task by sharing the Gospel, making disciples, and helping plant churches. They are a vital part of the IMB missionary teams worldwide. Serving as a Journeyman allows young adults to be on mission and explore the possibility of lifelong service as a missionary.

LONG-TERM (2+ YEARS)

IMB Team Member

Location: Various

Dates: Various (3+ years)

The specific role that Team Members play on a missionary team varies from person to person, team to team, and place to place. Responsibilities could include evangelism, discipleship, leadership development and training, volunteer coordination, and various other tasks. Regardless of the specific role, the primary purpose of a team member is to contribute to the missionary task as part of an IMB missionary team.
