### LEVEL 4

#### Public Emergency

Severe exposure and spread. Only leave home for supplies and services. Follow all current health orders.

- Same guidelines as Levels 1-3.
- Stay at home/necessary travel only.

### LEVEL 4

Masks always required in the building  
Symptom monitoring in effect  
Log-in/log-out for building use

#### Building Use and Staffing

- Staff work remotely except for tasks requiring physical presence in the building (custodial, financial, copying, etc.)
- Building use requests not available
- Scouts requested not to meet

#### Worship

- Virtual only (10 am Zoom, YouTube video, at-home liturgy/sermon)

#### Committees

- Virtual only (Zoom)

#### Outreach

- DZ@6 Food Pantry distributed at the door only
- DZ@6 Brown Bag Meal Distribution at the door only
- Project Day Team asked not to meet together (individual work is ok)

#### Growth and Discipleship

- Pub Theology, Bible Study, Book Group, etc. on-line only
- Bell ensembles do not meet
- Youth group/confirmation virtual based on family schedules and desires
- Children's programming virtual based on family schedules and desires

#### Social Concerns / Member Care

- Small groups care for members via phone, cards, etc.
- Online fellowship times may be offered
- Bereavement: delayed memorial services recommended; pastor available based on her/his comfort level

## Ohio COVID-19 Risk Level

### LEVEL 3

#### Public Emergency

Very high exposure and spread. Limit activities as much as possible. Follow all current health orders.

- Same guidelines as Levels 1-2.
- Decrease in-person interactions with others.
- Consider necessary travel only.
- Limit attending gatherings of any number.

## Zion Activities and Building Use

### LEVEL 3

Masks always required in the building  
Symptom monitoring in effect  
Log-in/log-out for building use

#### Building Use and Staffing

- Main office may be open, but likely with shorter hours (Administrative Assistant in for mail/messages); staff asked to work remotely if possible or in own spaces in the building if necessary to come in
- Building use requests considered by Re-Entry team; approval for inside space use unlikely
- Scouts meet based on their approved plans

#### Worship

- Virtual only (10 am Zoom, YouTube video, at-home liturgy/sermon)

#### Committees

- Virtual recommended (Zoom); some groups (such as property) meet in-person outside if desired

#### Outreach

- DZ@6 Food Pantry distributed at the door only
- DZ@6 Brown Bag Meal Distribution at the door only
- Project Day Team meets with safety plan in place; recommend limited time in the building and individually, if able.

#### Growth and Discipleship

- Pub Theology, Bible Study, Book Group, etc. on-line only
- Bell ensembles do not meet
- Youth group/confirmation virtual based on family schedules and desires
- Children's programming virtual based on family schedules and desires

#### Social Concerns / Member Care

- Small groups care for members via phone, cards, etc.
- Online fellowship times may be offered
- Bereavement: small graveside services recommended; pastor available based on her/his comfort level

## Ohio COVID-19 Risk Level

### LEVEL 2

#### Public Emergency

Increased exposure and spread. Exercise high degree of caution. Follow all current health orders.

- Same guidelines as Level 1.
- Avoid contact with anyone who is considered high-risk.
- High-risk individuals should take extra care to follow precautions.
- Decrease in-person interactions outside household.
- Seek medical care as needed, but limit or avoid unnecessary visits to hospitals, nursing homes, and residential care facilities to see others as much as possible.

## Zion Activities and Building Use

### LEVEL 2

Masks always required in the building  
Symptom monitoring in effect  
Log-in/log-out for building use

#### Building Use and Staffing

- Offices open; staff still asked to work in own spaces as much as possible
- Building use requests considered by Re-Entry team; use of inside spaces may be approved with detailed safety plan
- Scouts meet based on their approved plans

#### Worship

- Virtual only (10 am Zoom, YouTube video, at-home liturgy/sermon)
- May add outdoor, in-car, or other similar non-Sunday morning options

#### Committees

- Virtual recommended (Zoom); some groups (such as Property) meet in-person outside if desired or inside with detailed safety plan

#### Outreach

- DZ@6 Food Pantry distributed at the door (recommended); entry to warehouse limited to 1 person at a time
- DZ@6 Brown Bag Meal Distribution at the door only
- Project Day Team meets with safety plan in place

#### Growth and Discipleship

- Pub Theology, Bible Study, Book Group, etc. on-line only
- Bell ensembles meet with safety plan in place
- Youth group/confirmation virtual based on family schedules and desires
- Children's programming virtual based on family schedules and desires

#### Social Concerns / Member Care

- Small groups care for members via phone, cards, etc.
- Online fellowship times may be offered; members may also gather outside with safety plan
- Bereavement: medium graveside services recommended; pastor available based on her/his comfort level

## Ohio COVID-19 Risk Level

### LEVEL 1

#### Public Emergency

Active exposure and spread. Follow all current health orders.

- Conduct a daily health/symptom self-evaluation and stay at home if symptomatic.
- Maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet from non-household members.
- Wear face coverings in public, especially when social distancing is difficult to maintain.
- Increase caution when interacting with others not practicing social distancing or wearing face covers.
- Avoid traveling to high-risk areas.
- Follow good hygiene standards, including:
  - Wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
  - Use hand sanitizer frequently.
  - Avoid touching your face.
  - Cover coughs or sneezes (e.g., into a tissue, or elbow).
  - Symptom self-evaluation monitoring.

### LEVEL 1

Masks always required in the building

Symptom monitoring in effect

Log-in/log-out for building use

#### Building Use and Staffing

- Offices open; staff still asked to work in own spaces as much as possible
- Building use requests considered by Re-Entry team; increased use of inside spaces approved with detailed safety plan
- Scouts meet based on their approved plans

#### Worship

- After four weeks at yellow, begin in-person worship with safety plan in place (see attached)
- Virtual opportunities continue in some capacity (YouTube video, at-home liturgy/sermon; midweek option ??)

#### Committees

- Some combination of virtual and in-person with safety plan

#### Outreach

- DZ@6 Food Pantry still limiting the number of people entering the space at one time (2-3 physically distanced)
- DZ@6 Brown Bag Meal Distribution still limiting the number of people entering the space at one time (will re-evaluate at door distribution based on weather, but will still do a carry-out option)
- Project Day Team meets with safety plan in place

#### Growth and Discipleship

- Pub Theology, Bible Study, Book Group, Bell ensembles, etc. – possible combination of virtual and in-person with limited numbers and safety plan
- Youth group/confirmation – possible combination of virtual and in-person with limited numbers and safety plan; based on family schedules and desires
- Children's programming – possible combination of virtual and in-person with limited numbers and safety plan; based on family schedules and desires

#### Social Concerns / Member Care

- Small groups care for members via phone, cards, etc.
- Online fellowship times may be offered; members may also gather outside with safety plan
- Bereavement: graveside services still recommended, but other options may be possible with safety considerations; pastor available based on her/his comfort level
