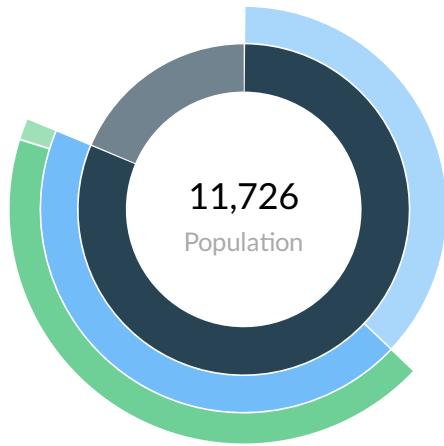
Median household income is \$18.7K below the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- From 2014 to 2019, jobs declined by 3.4% in Barton County, MO from 4,149 to 4,010. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 7.9% by 11.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 57.8% to 54.5% between 2014 and 2019.
- Concerning educational attainment, 10.6% of Barton County, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (8.2% below the national average), and 5.5% hold an Associate's Degree (2.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

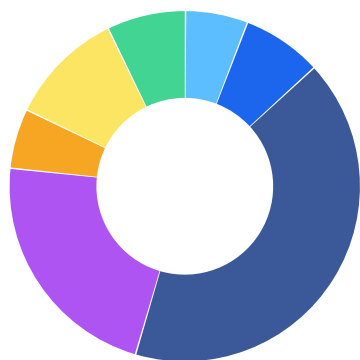

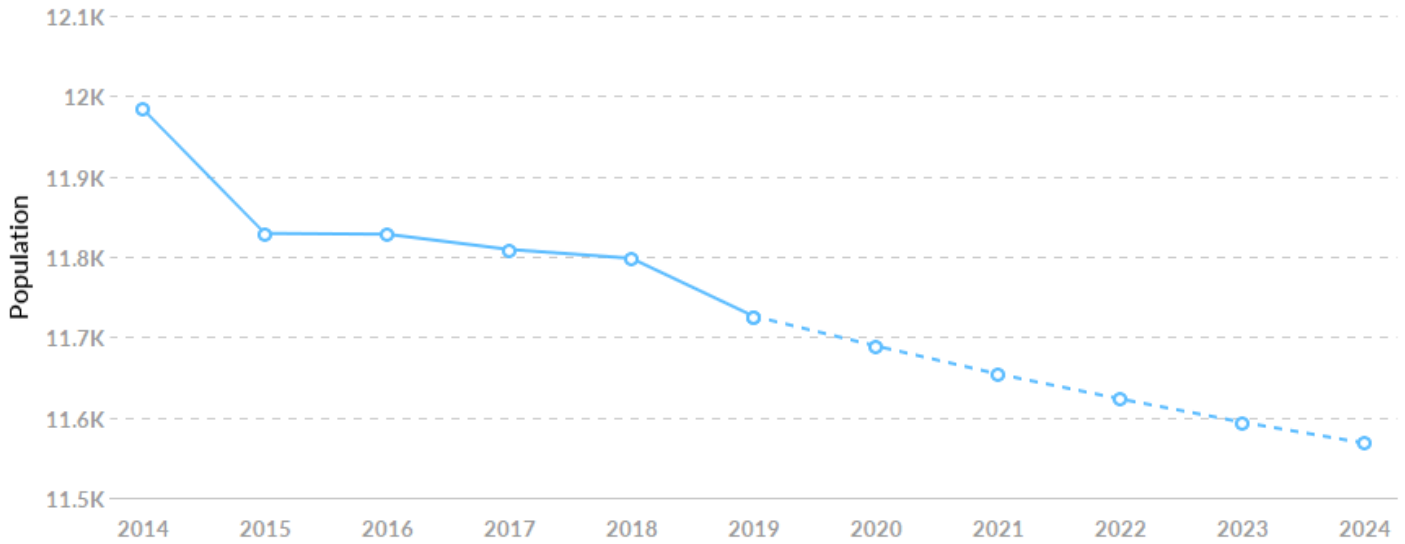

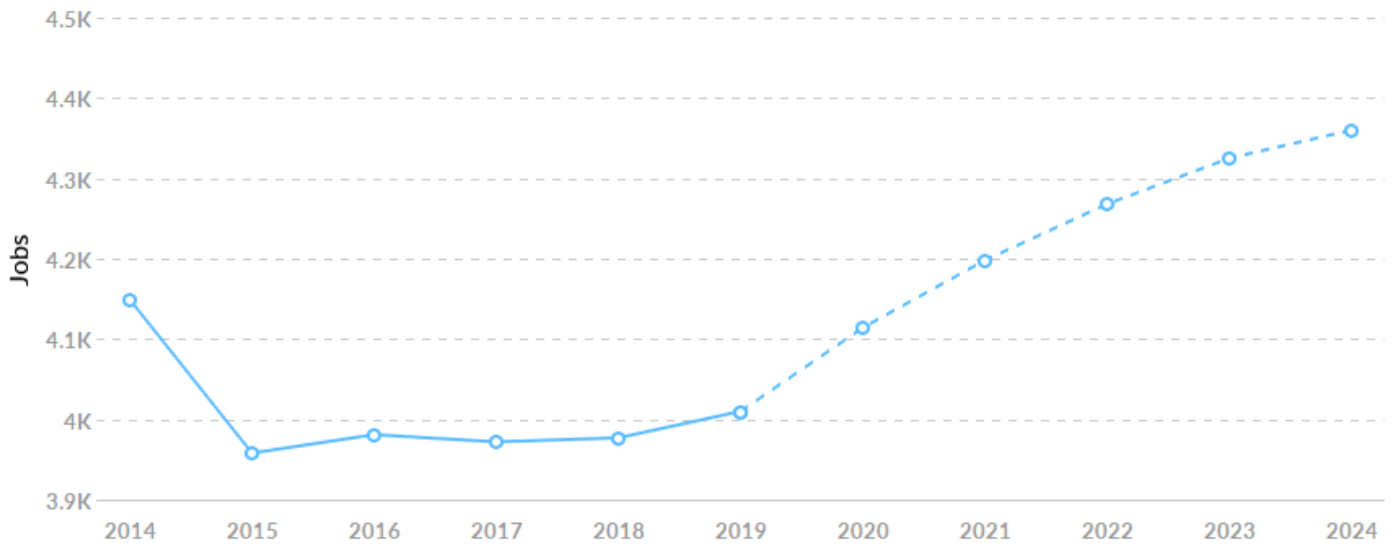

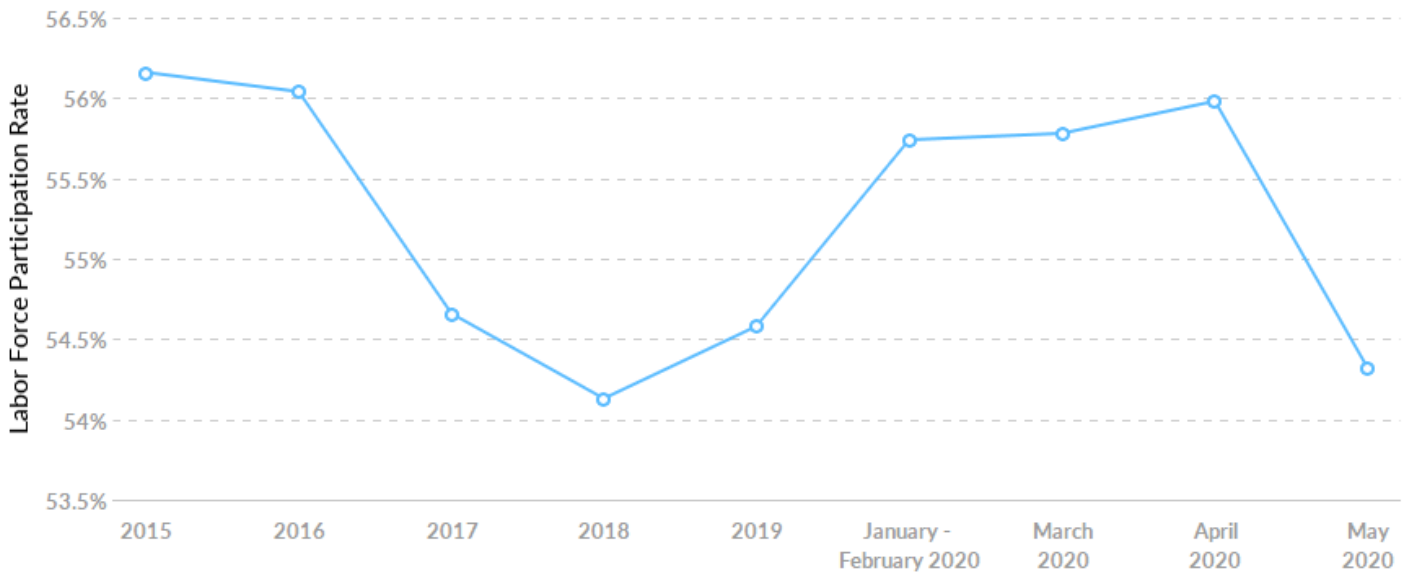
Job Trends

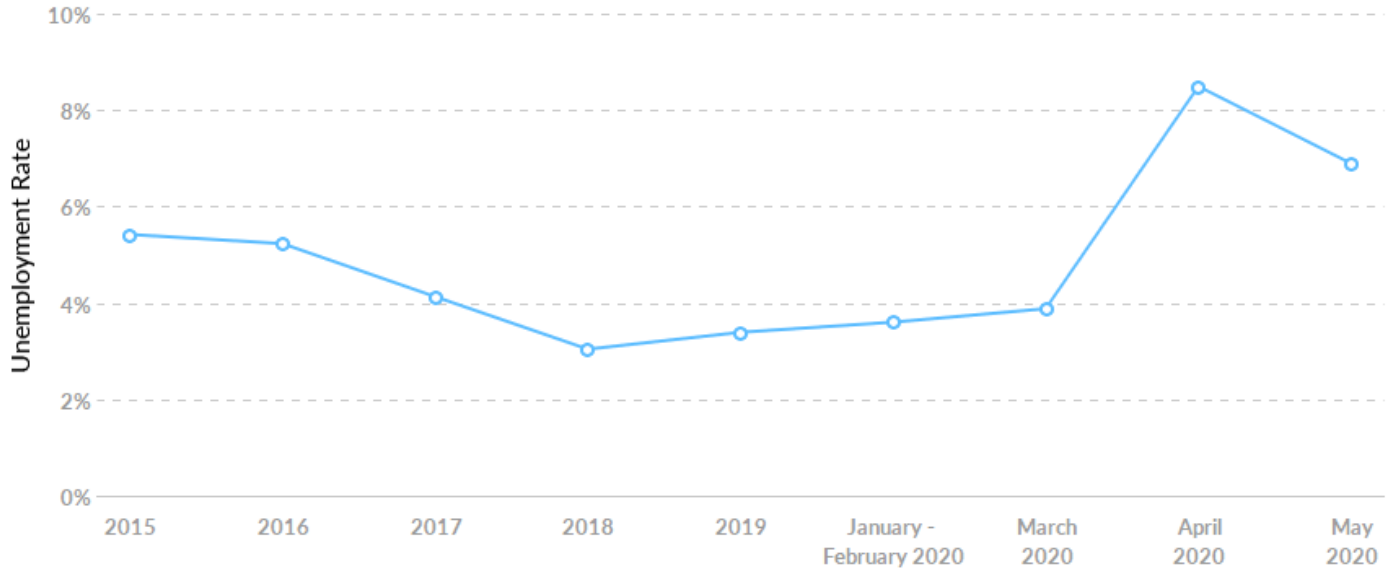

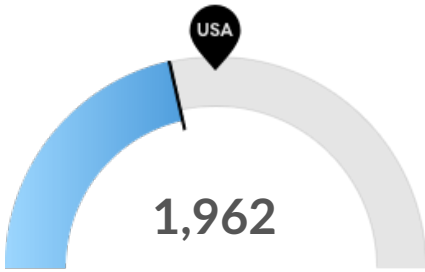
Unemployment Rate Trends

Barton County, MO had a May 2020 unemployment rate of 6.89%, **increasing from 5.42% 5 years before.**



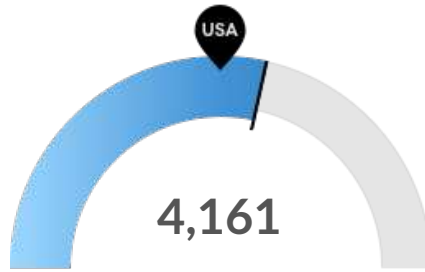

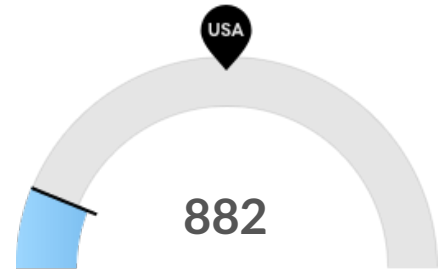
Millennials

Barton County, MO has 1,962 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 2,425.



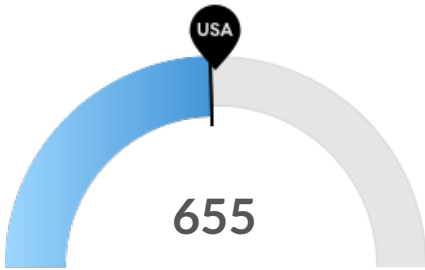
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Barton County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 3,415 people 55 or older, while there are 4,161 here.



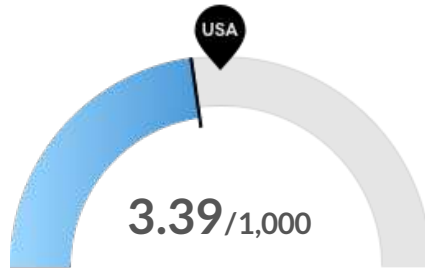
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Barton County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 4,674 racially diverse people, while there are 882 here.



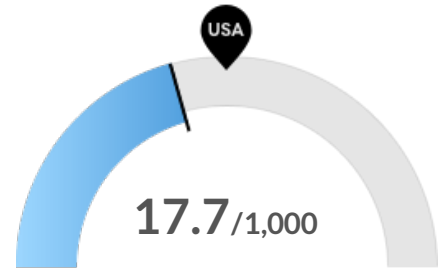
Veterans

Barton County, MO has 3.39 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.87 per 1,000 people.

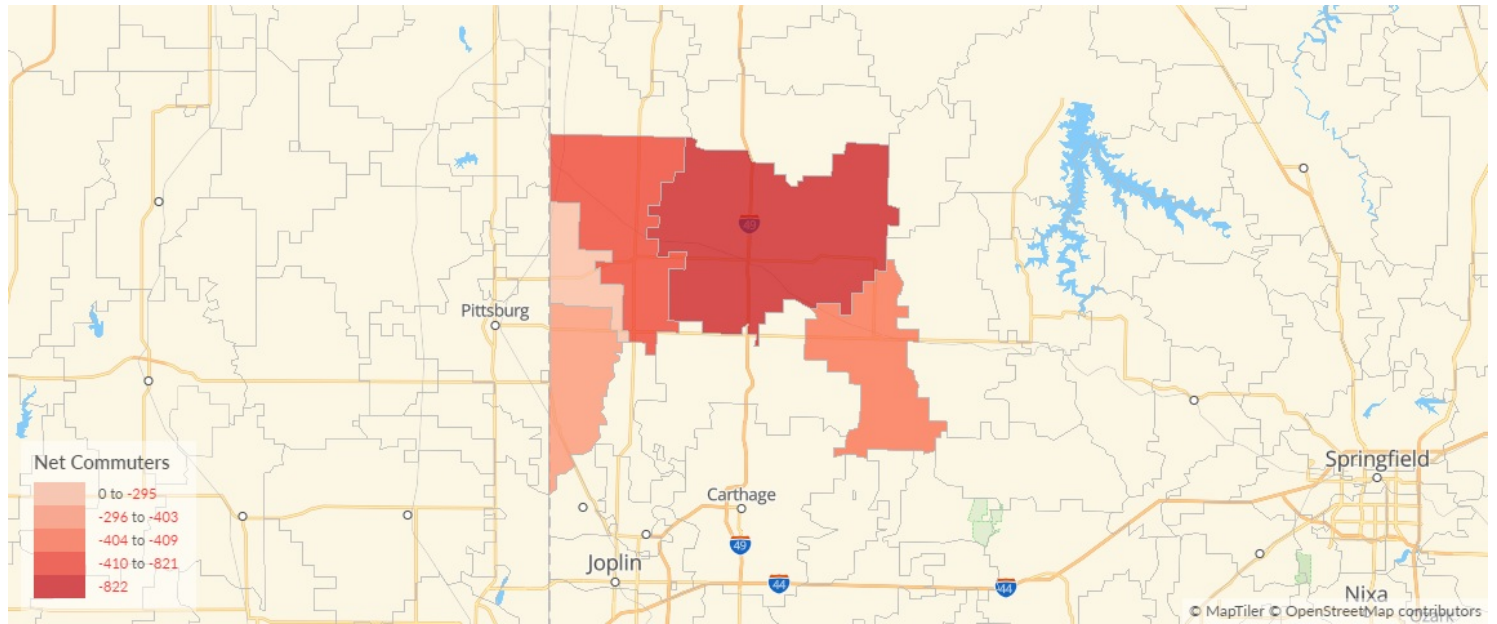


Property Crime

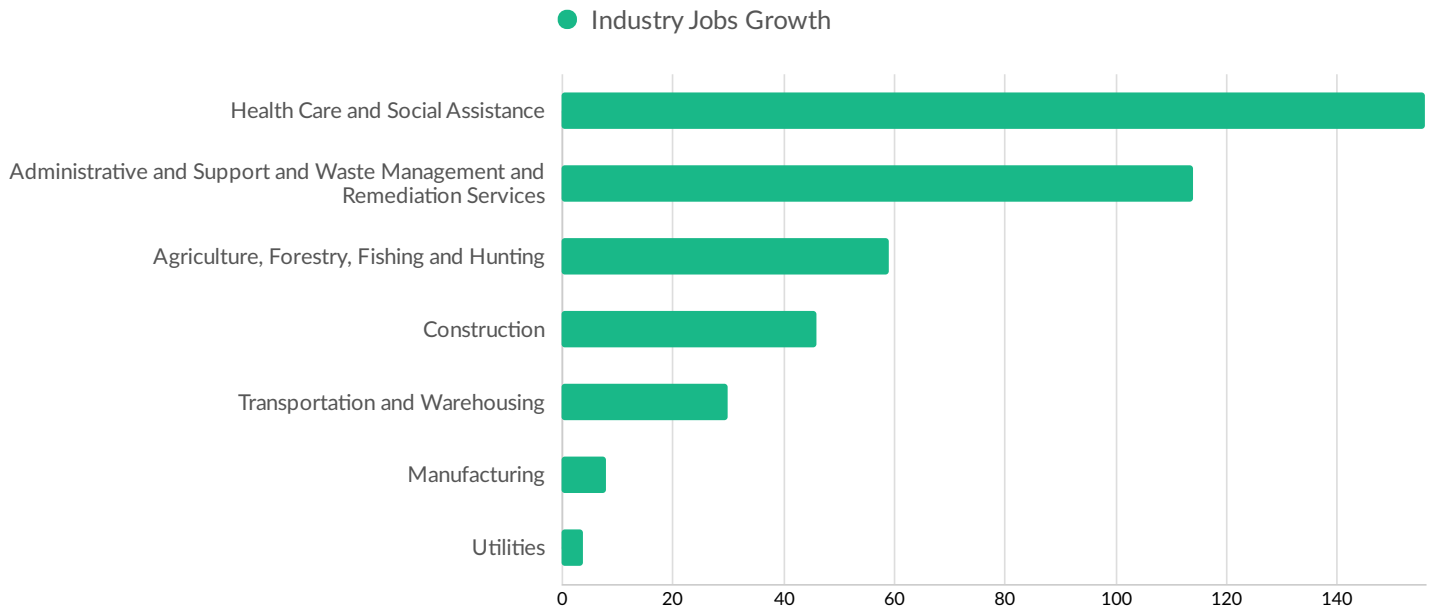

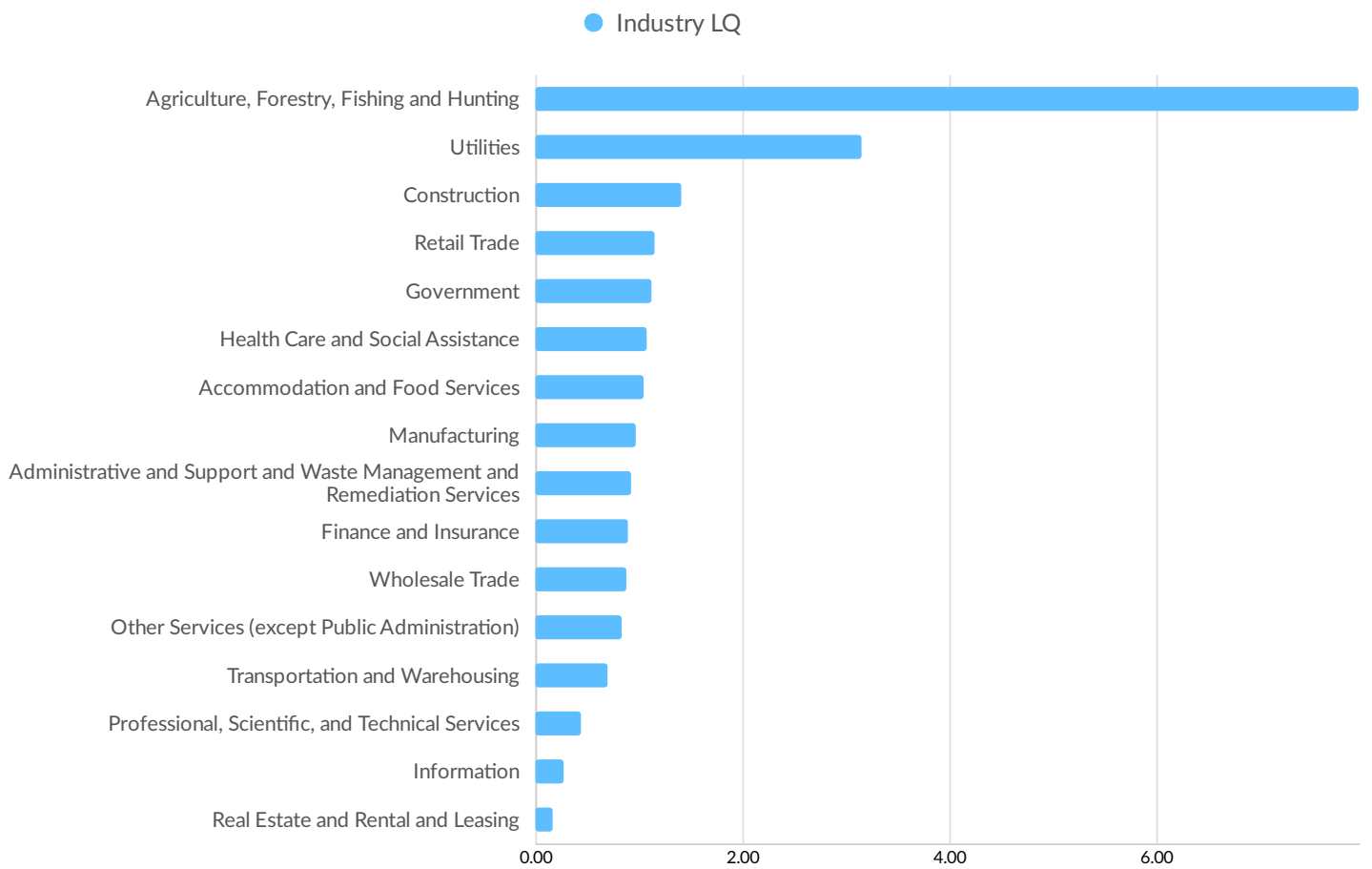

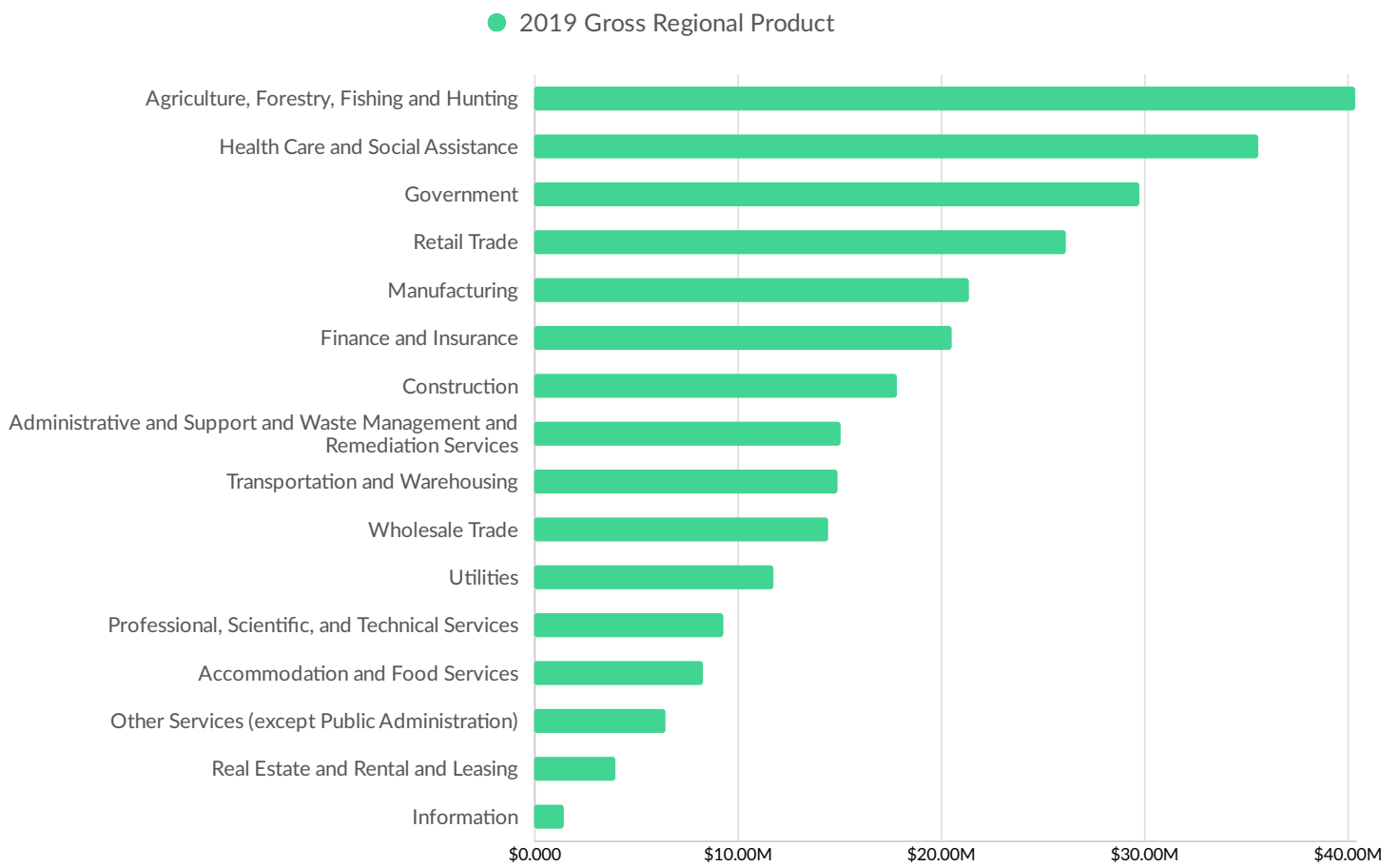

Top Industry LQ



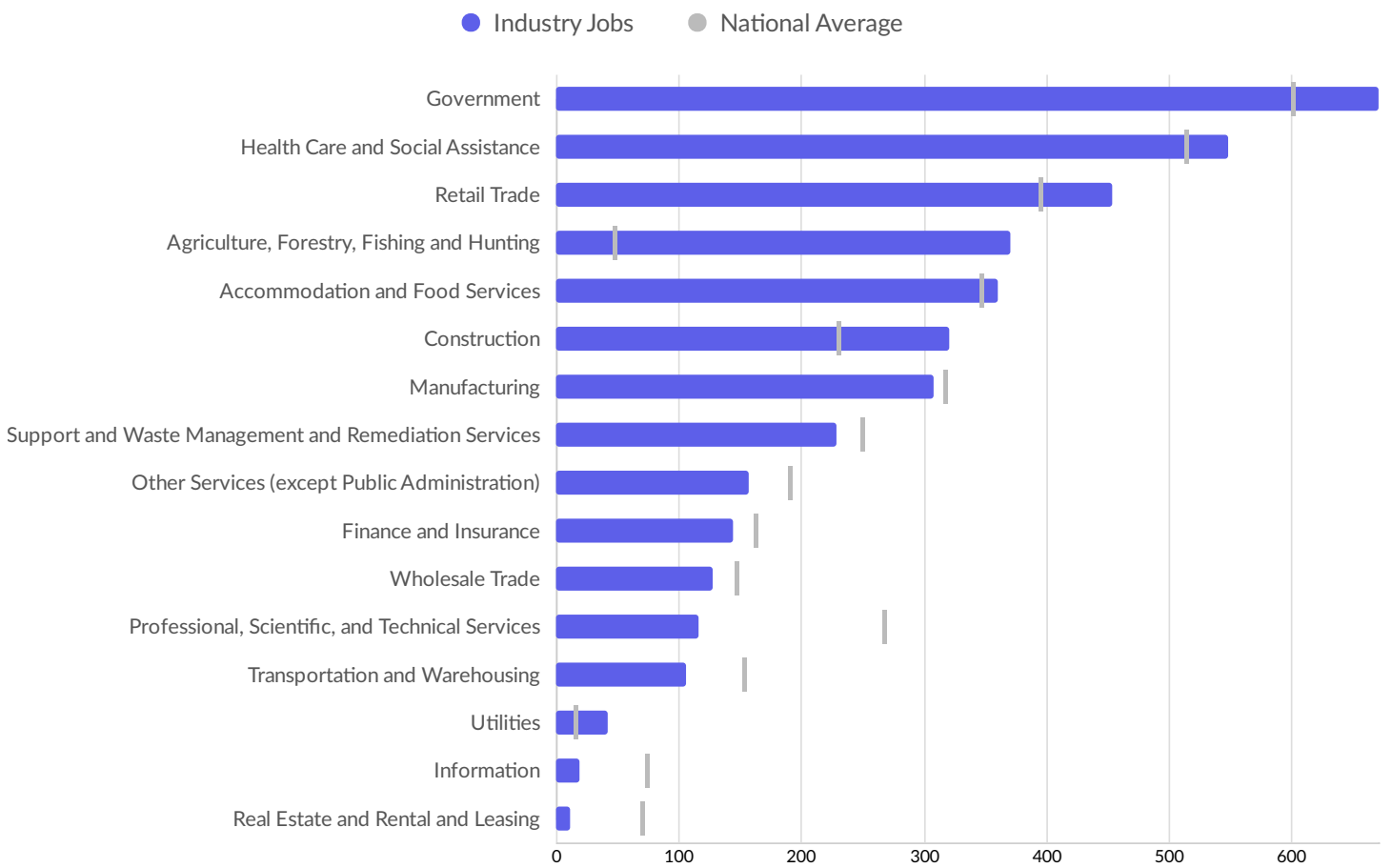

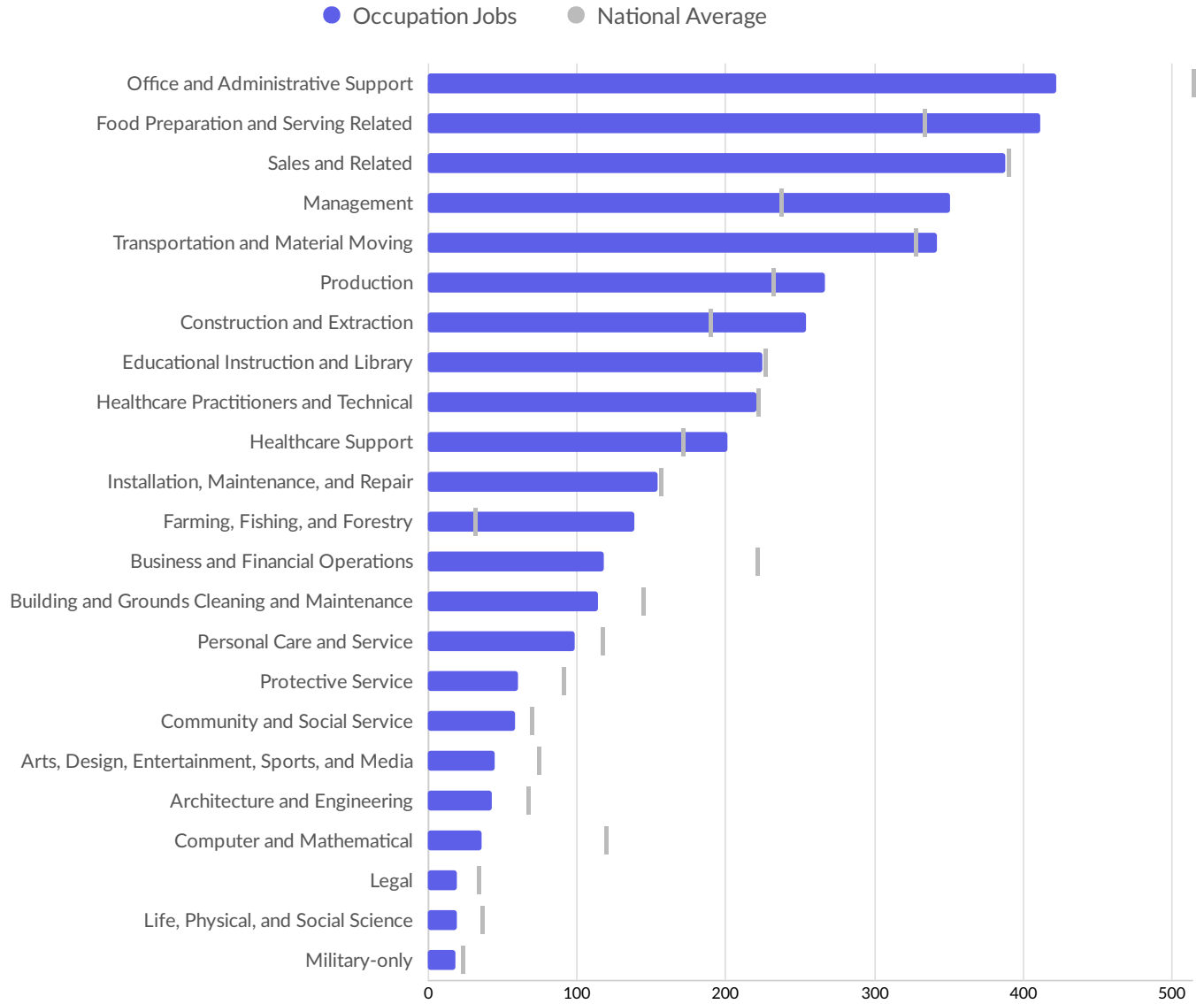

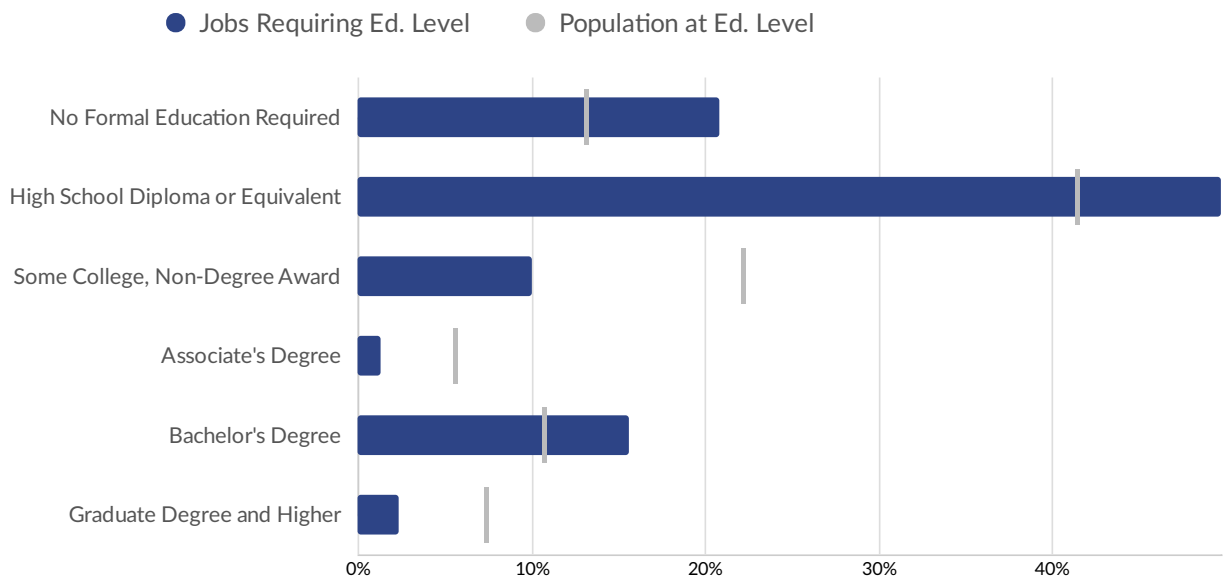

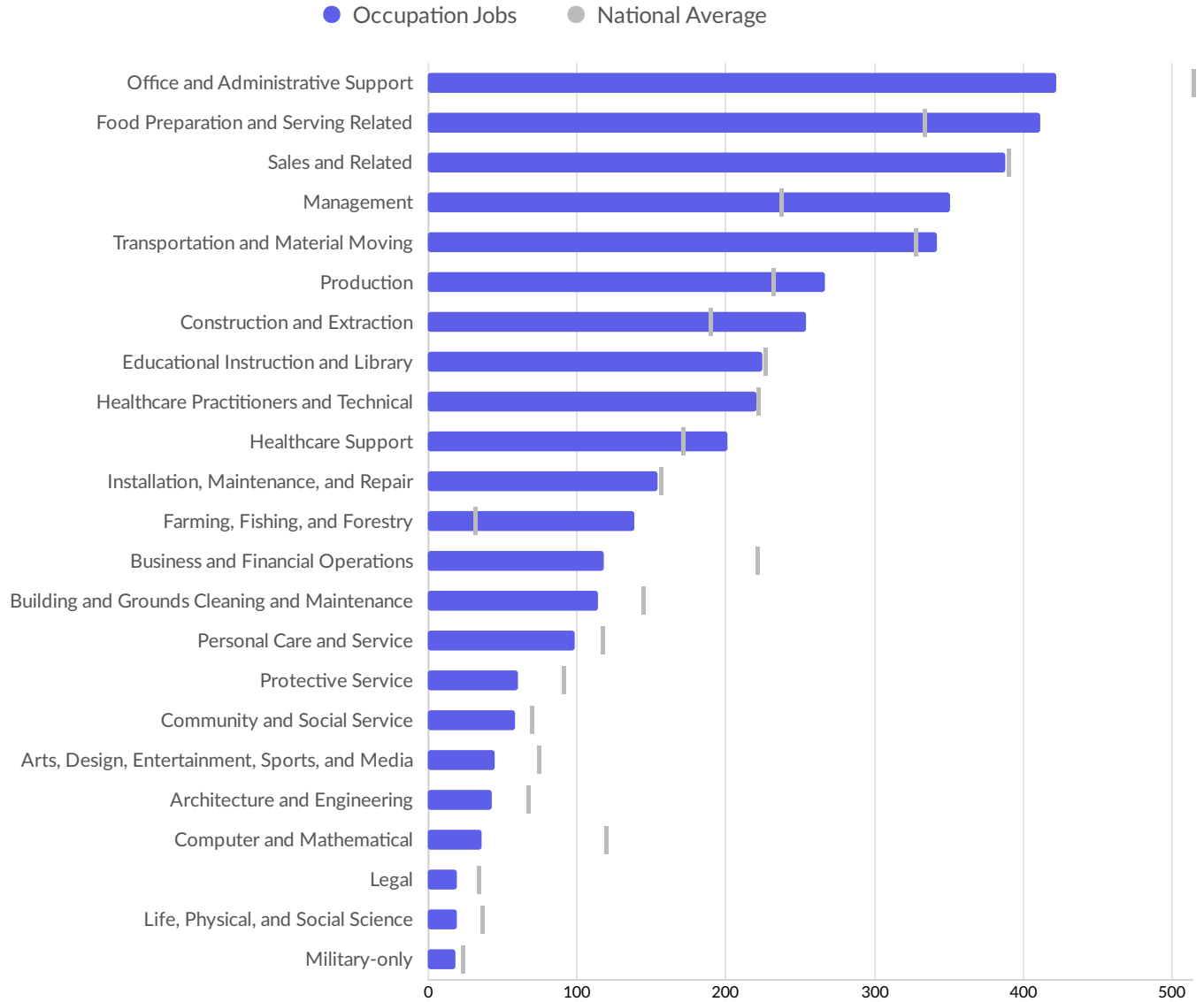
