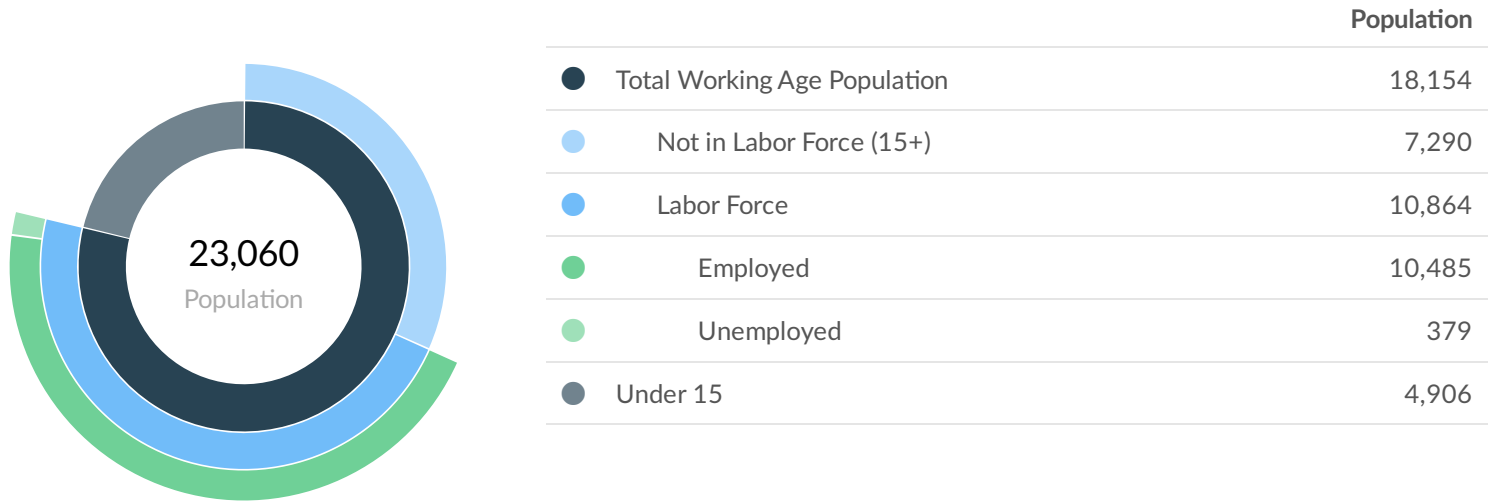
Median household income is **\$18.3K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- From 2014 to 2019, jobs **declined by 1.1%** in McDonald County, MO from 8,277 to **8,186**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 7.9% by 9.0%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate increased from 55.7% to 59.8% between 2014 and 2019**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.4% of McDonald County, MO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.4% below the national average), and **5.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Animal Slaughtering and Processing, Animal Production, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

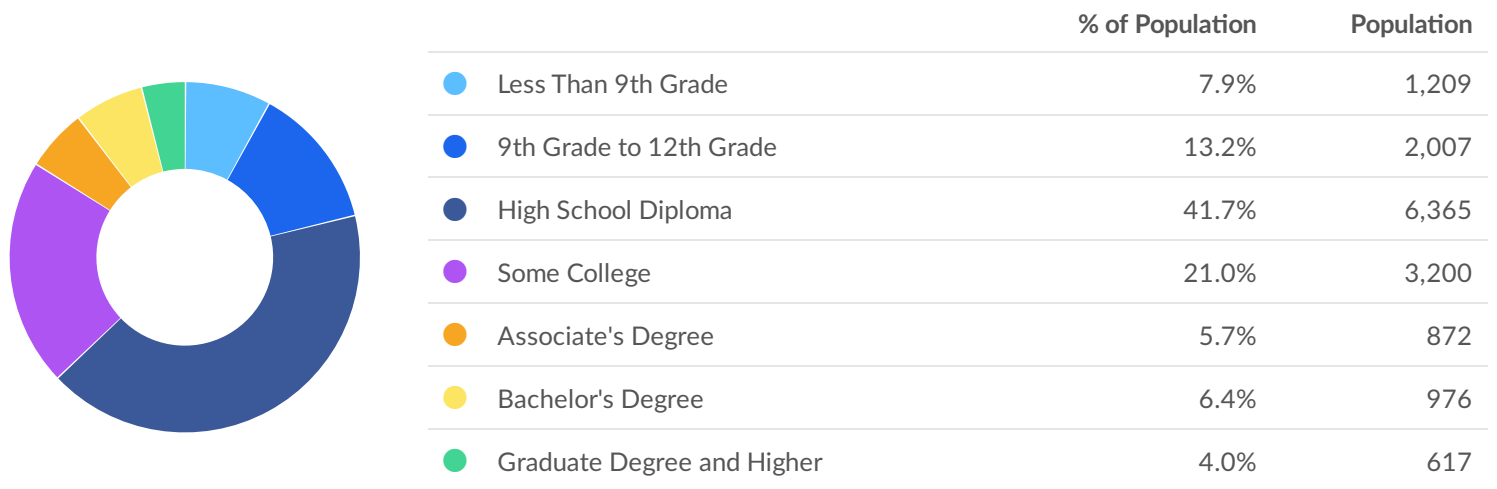

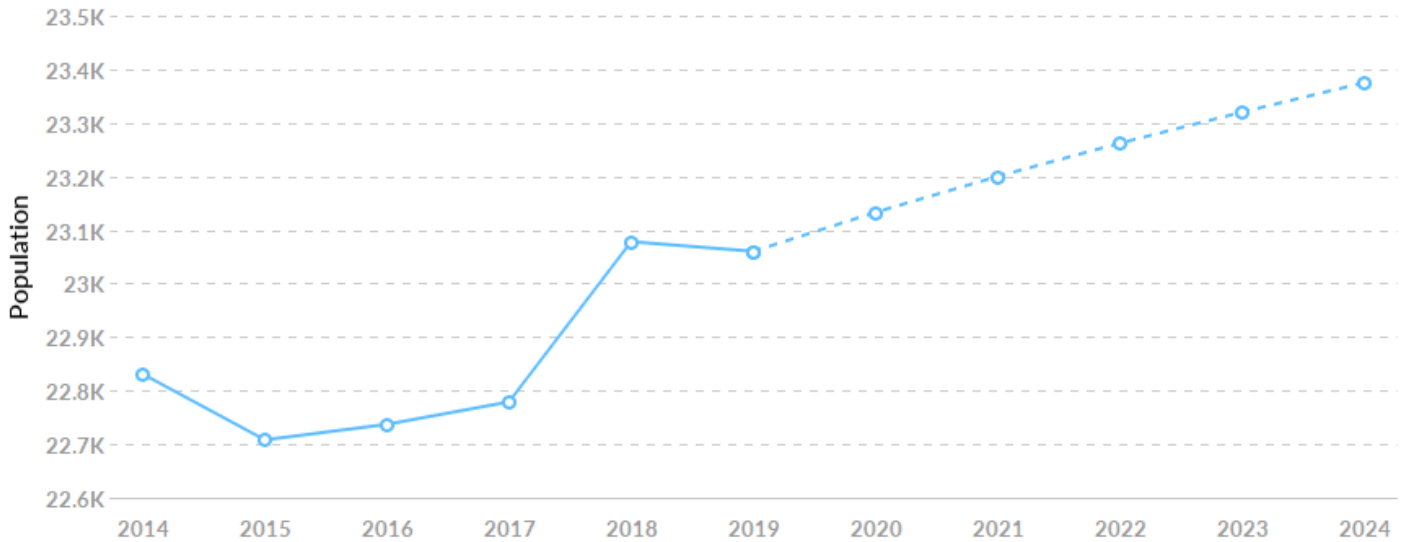

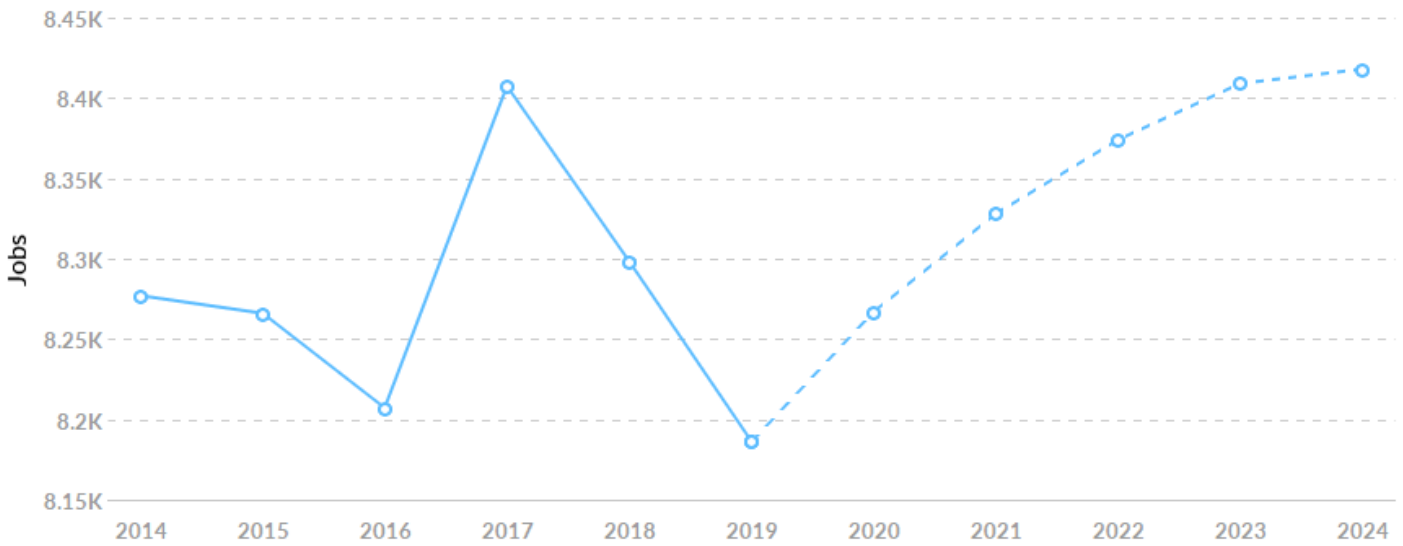

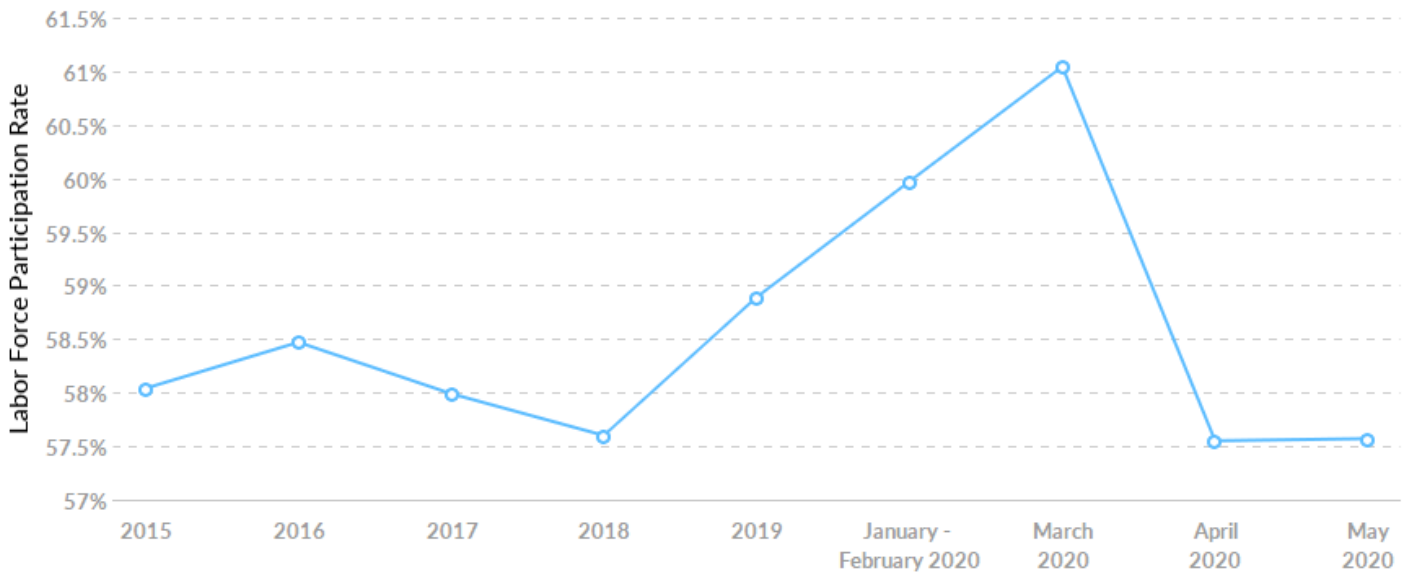
Job Trends

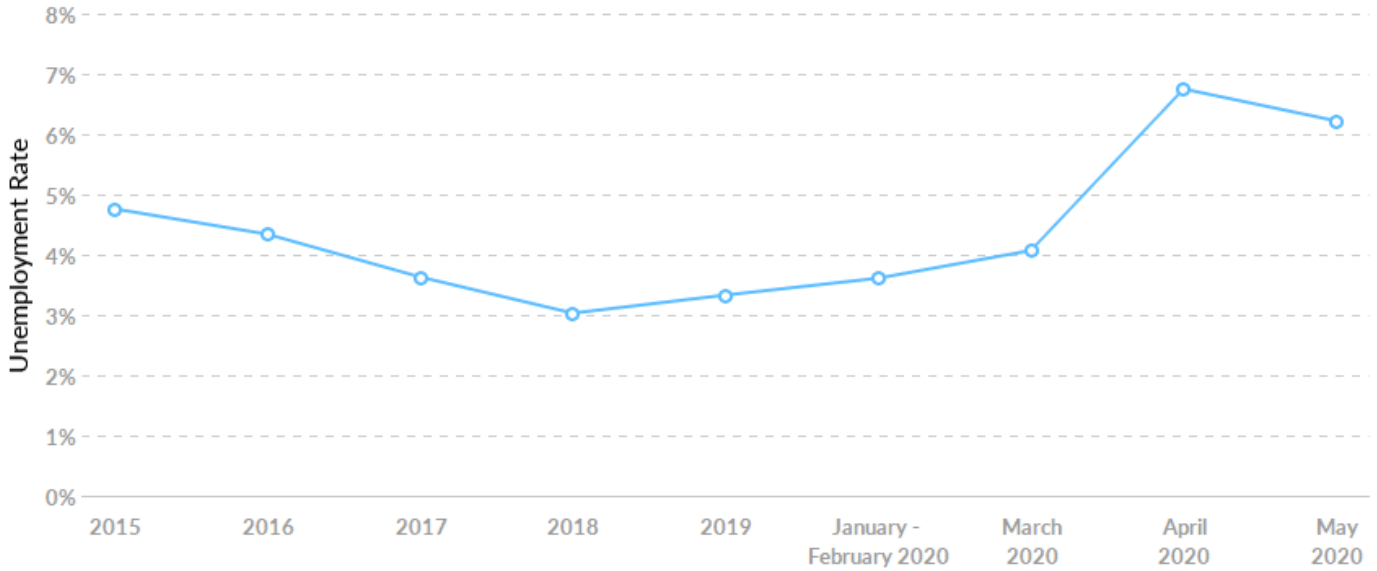

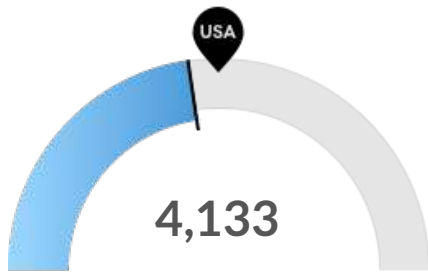
Unemployment Rate Trends

McDonald County, MO had a May 2020 unemployment rate of 6.22%, **increasing from 4.76%** 5 years before.



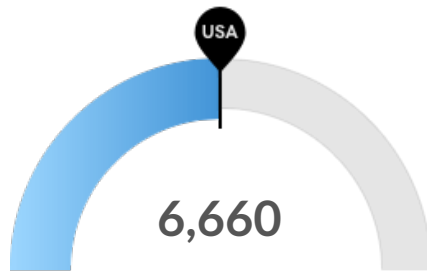

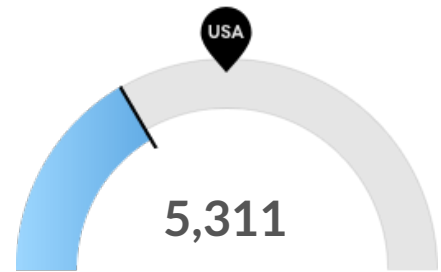
Millennials

McDonald County, MO has 4,133 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,745.



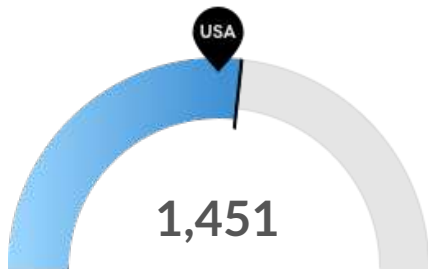
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in McDonald County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 6,680 people 55 or older, while there are 6,660 here.



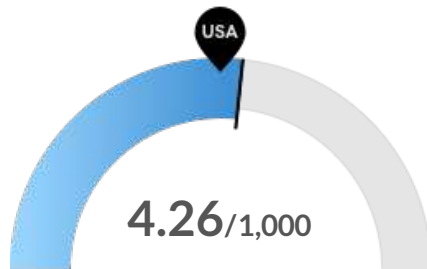
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in McDonald County, MO. The national average for an area this size is 9,143 racially diverse people, while there are 5,311 here.



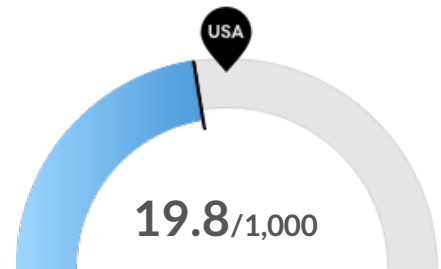
Veterans

McDonald County, MO has 4.26 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.87 per 1,000 people.

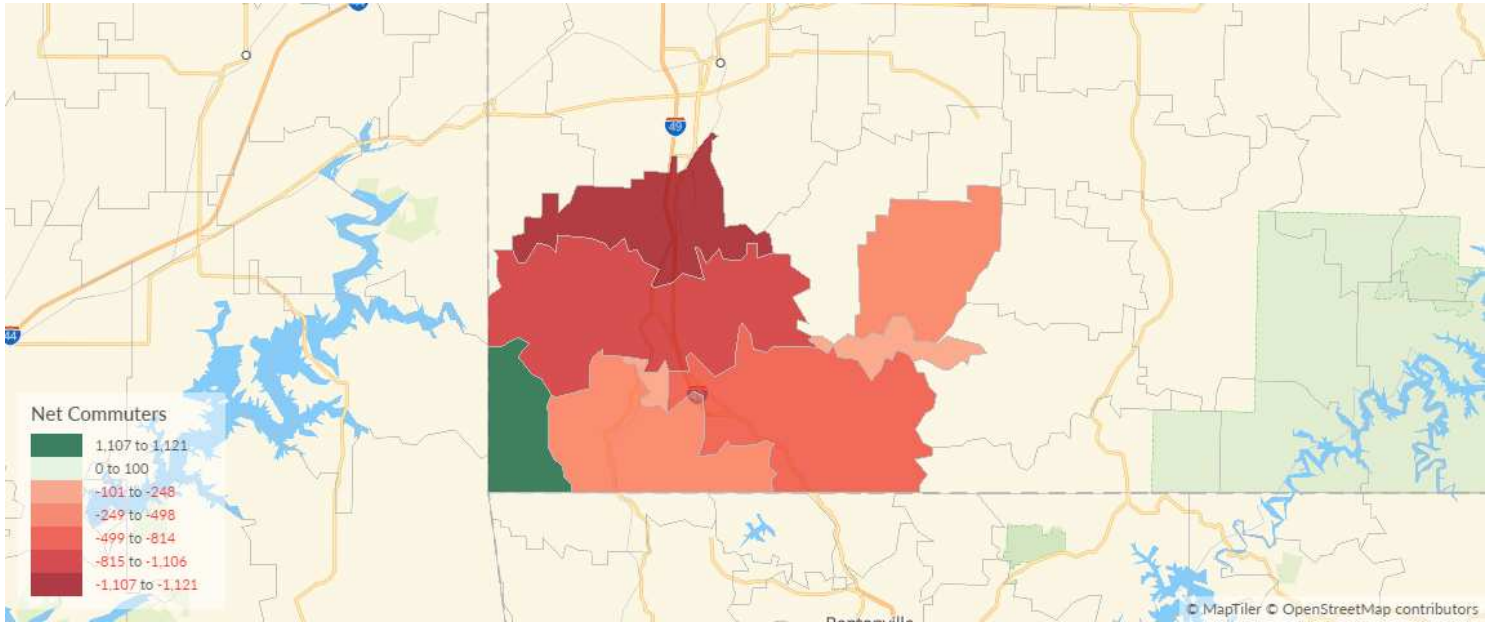


Property Crime

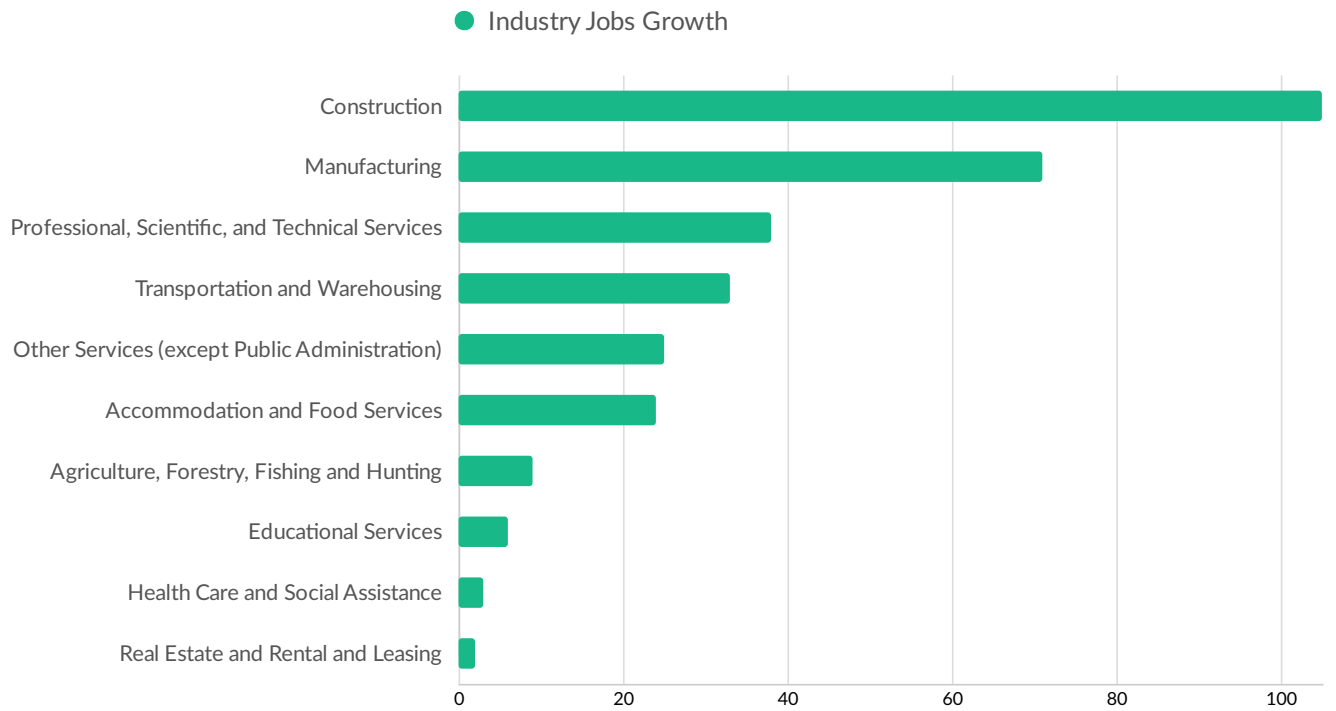

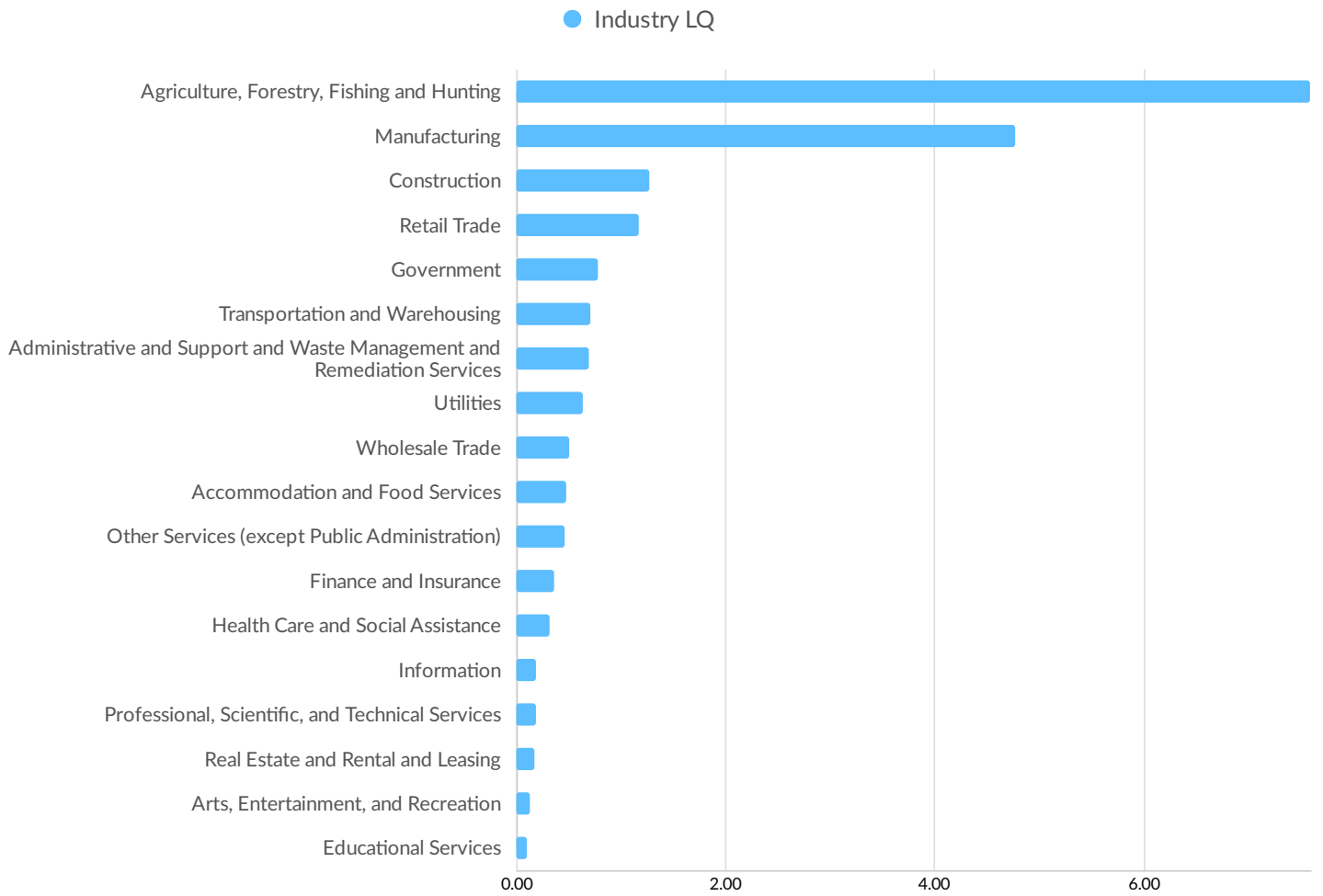

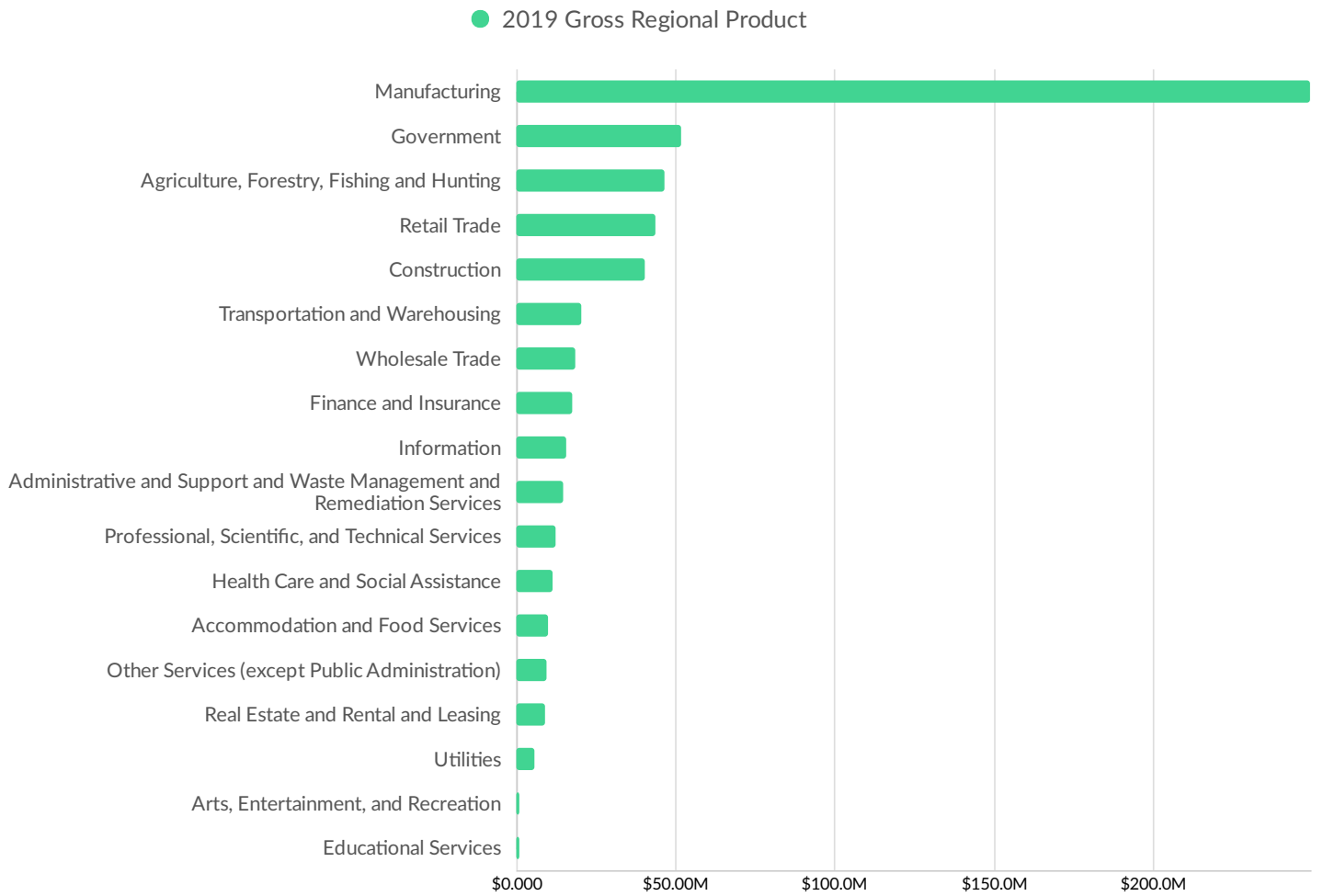

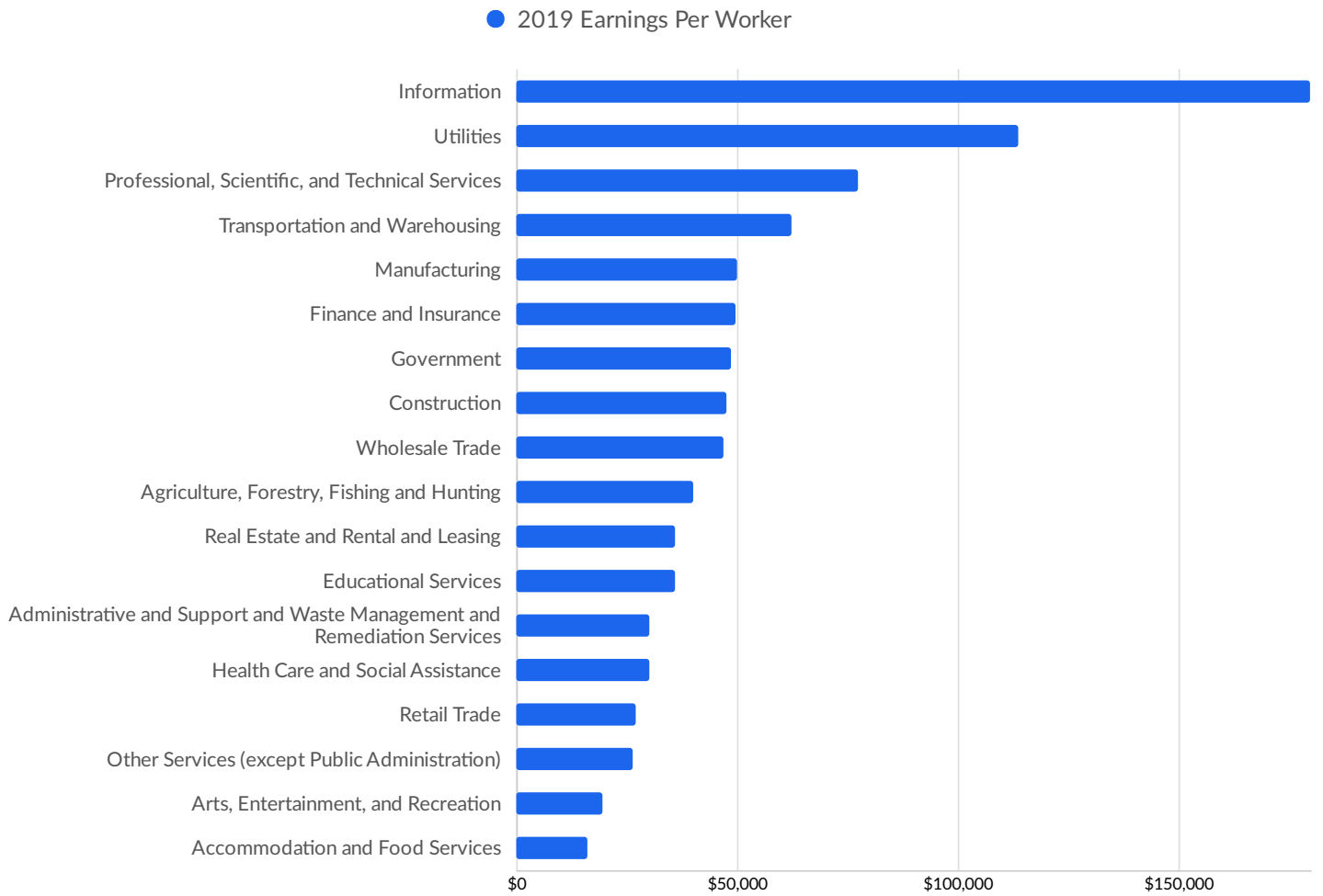
Top Industry LQ



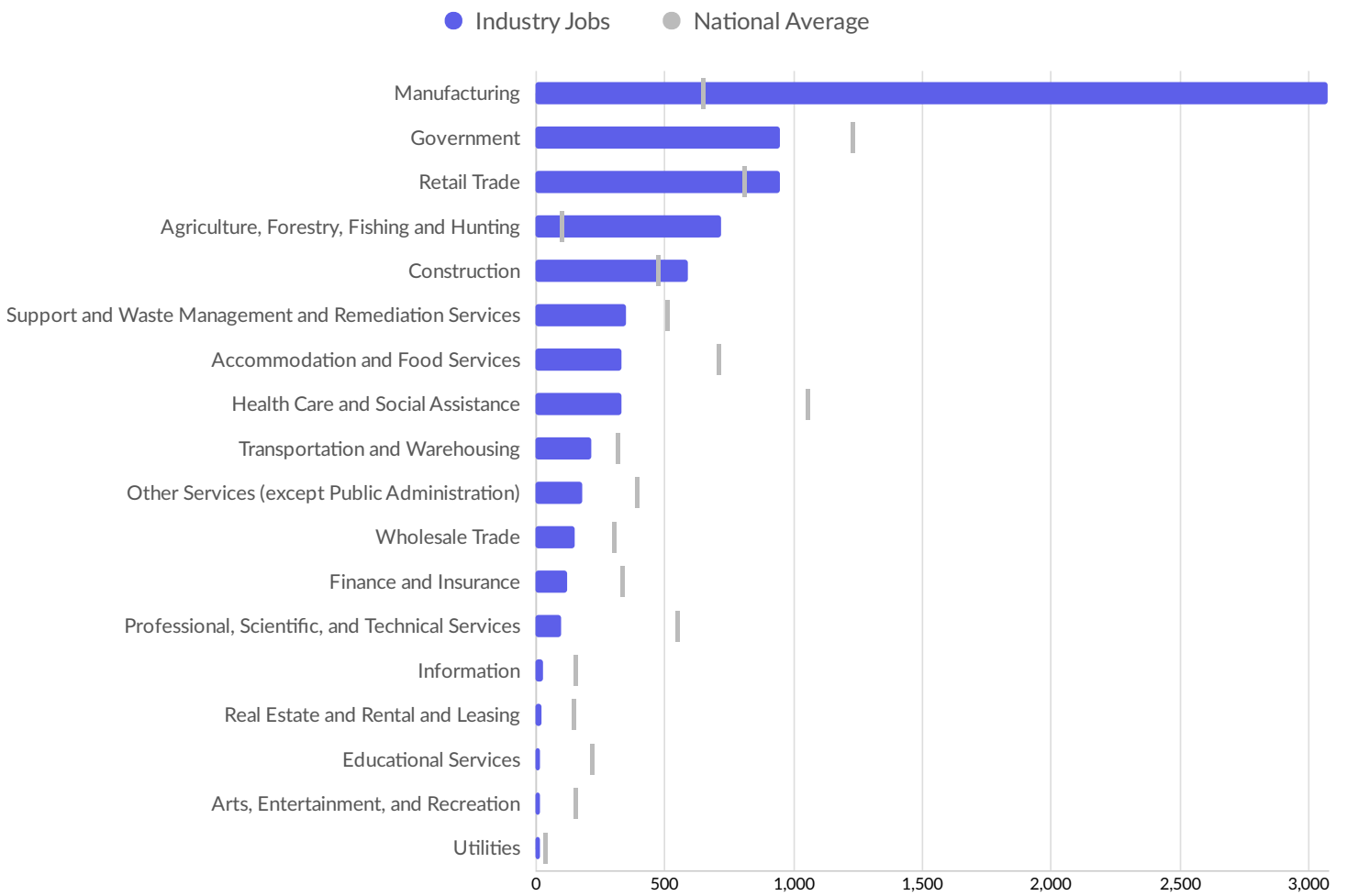

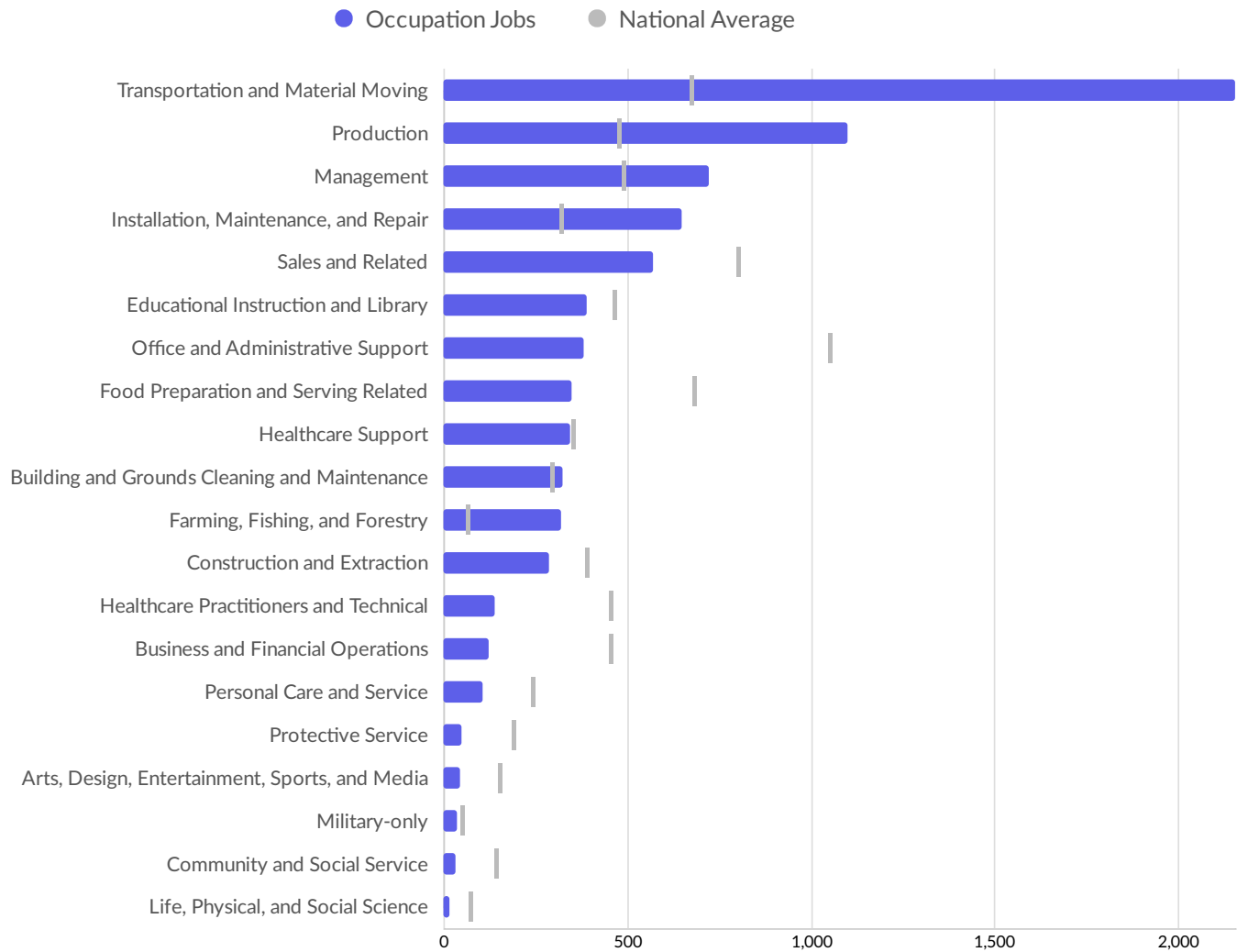

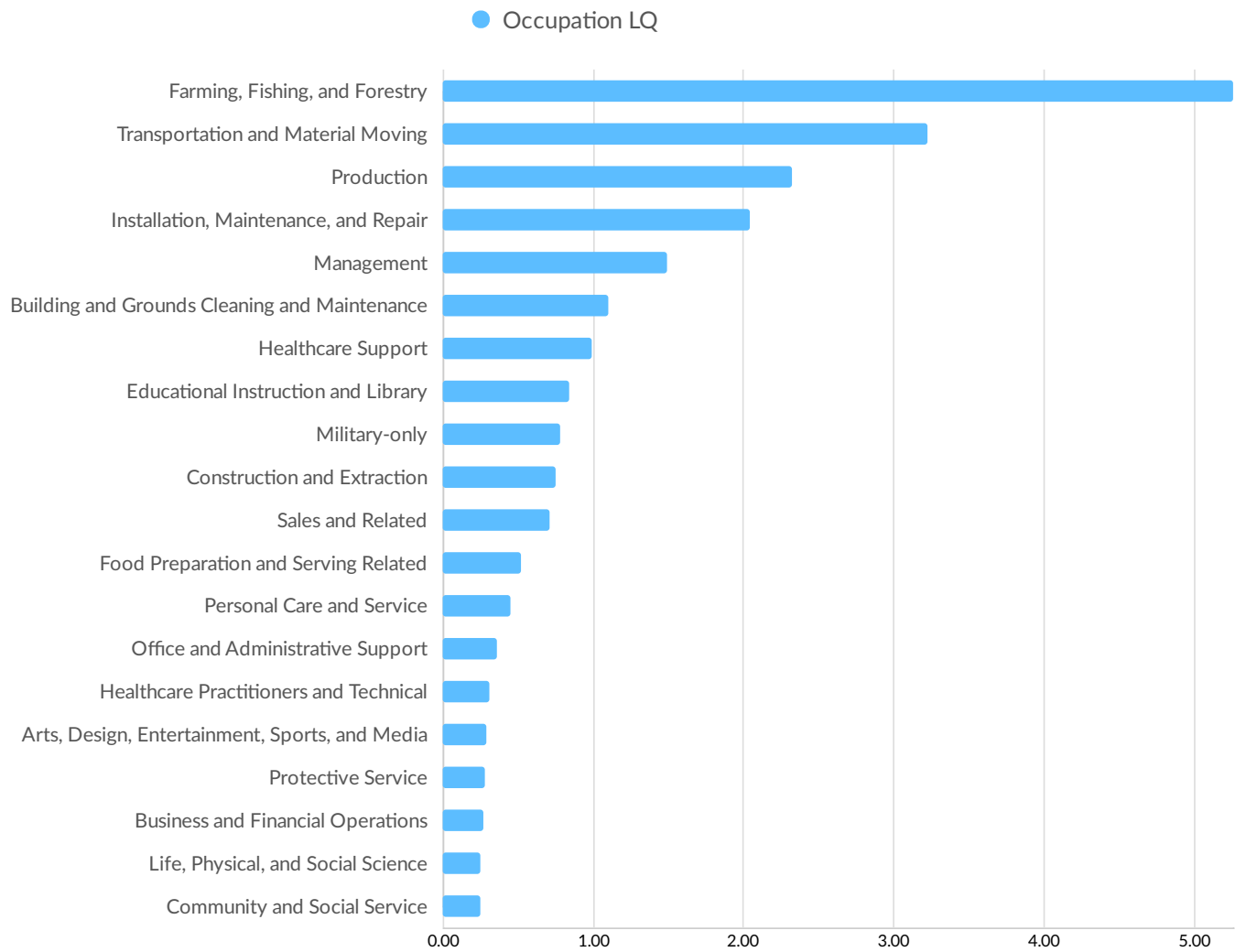

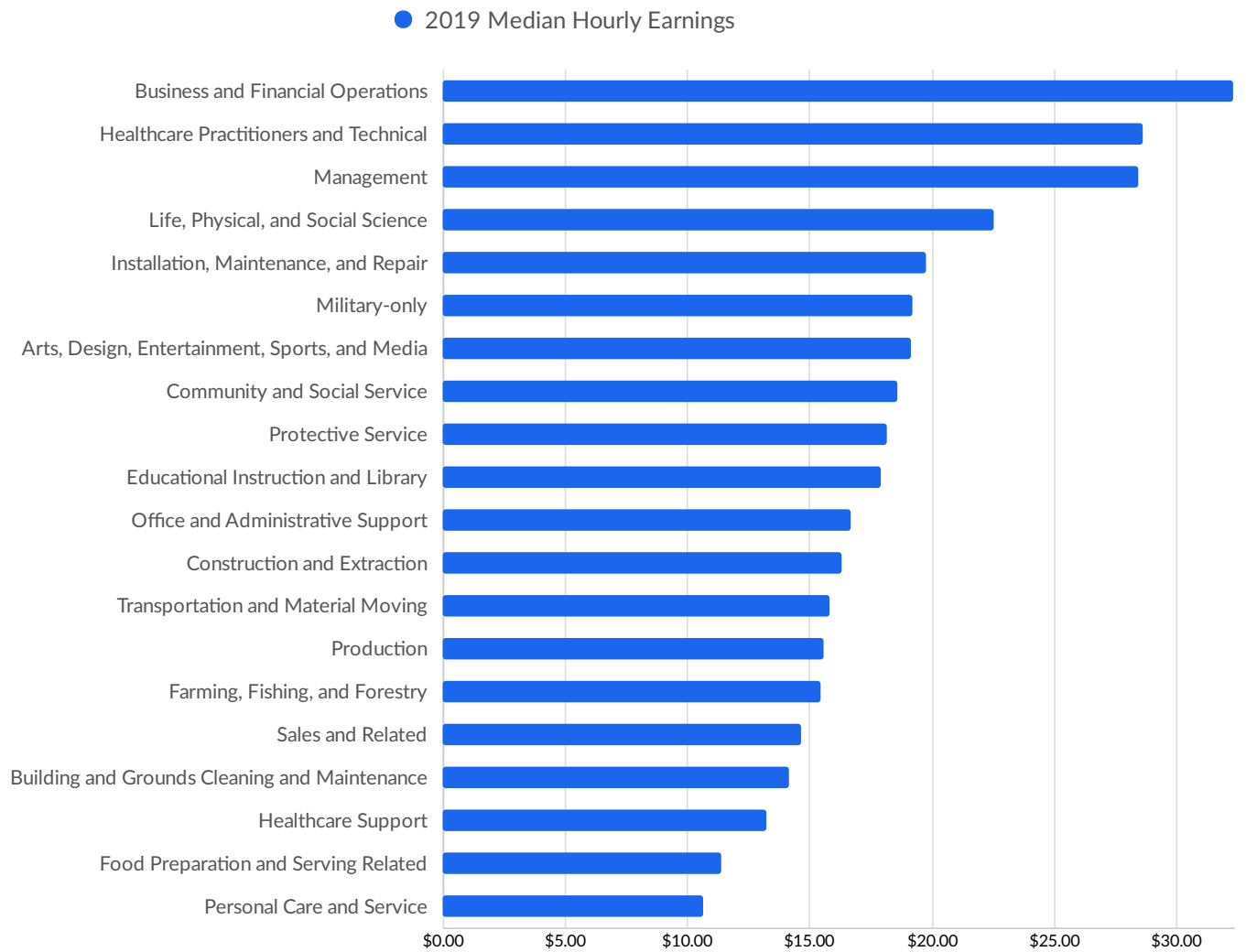
Top Growing Occupations



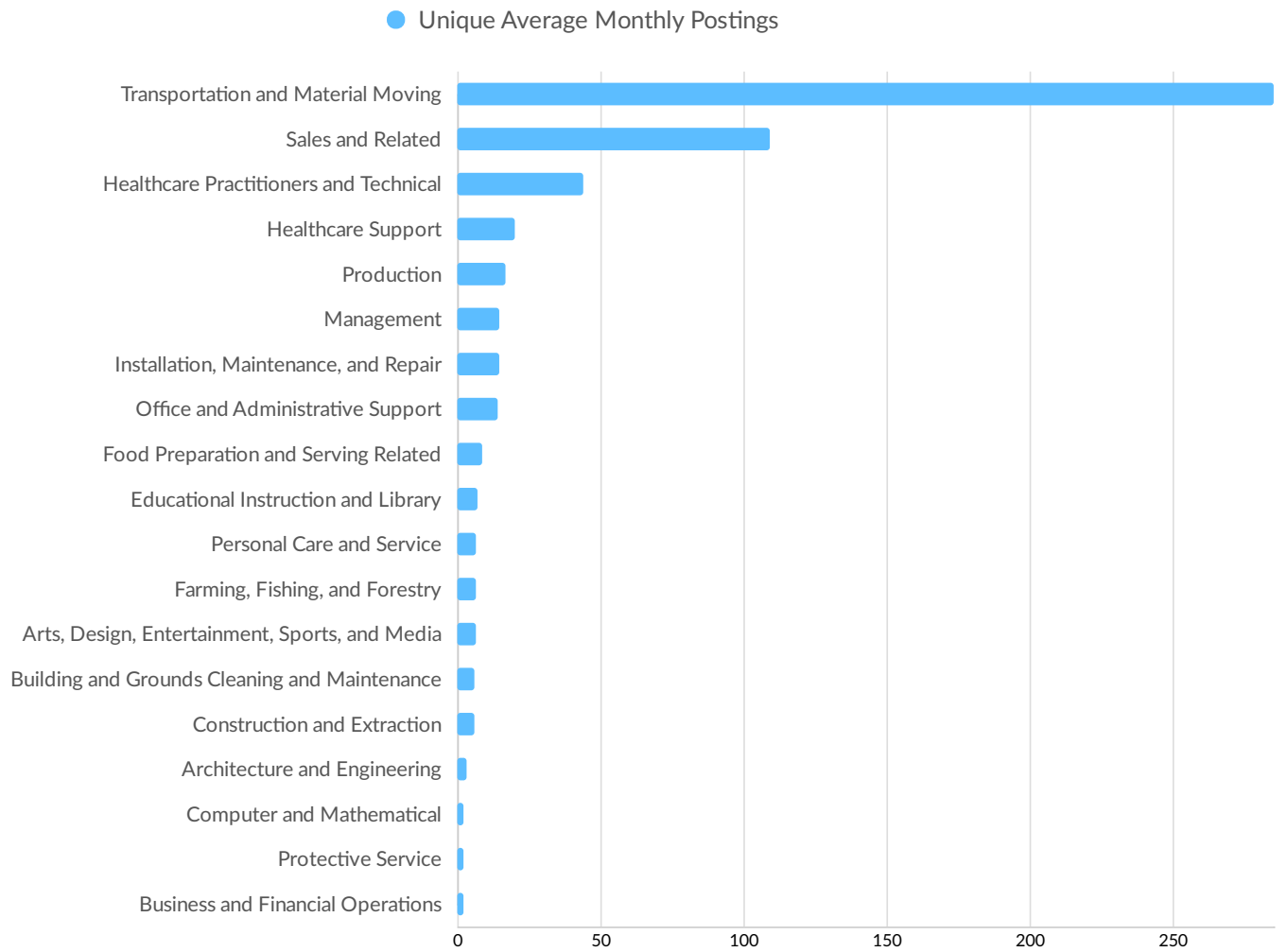

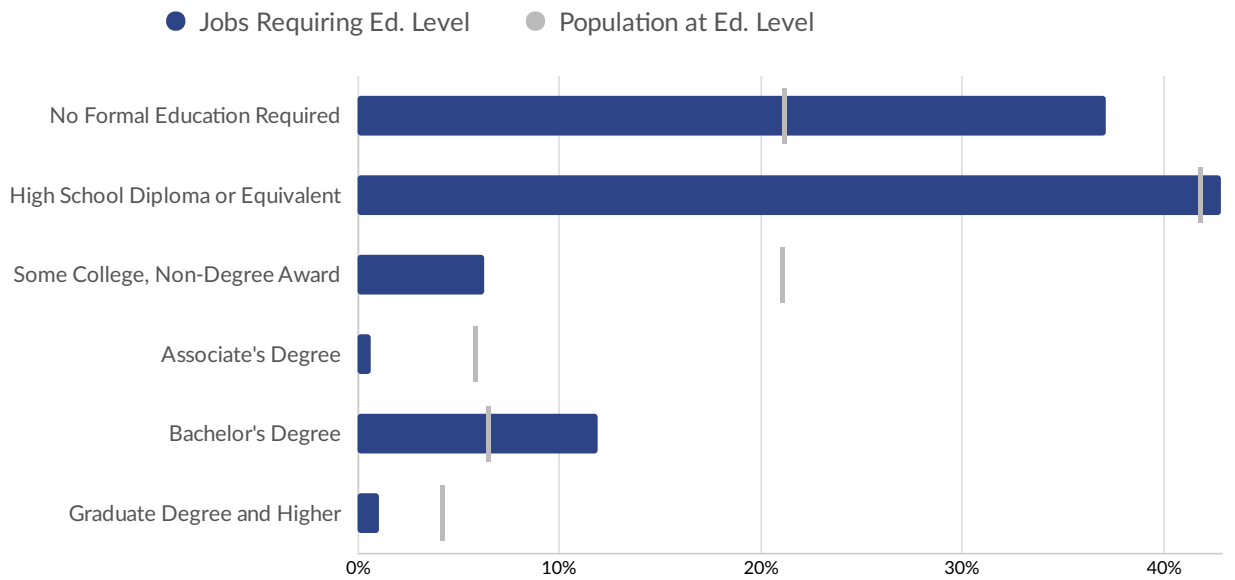

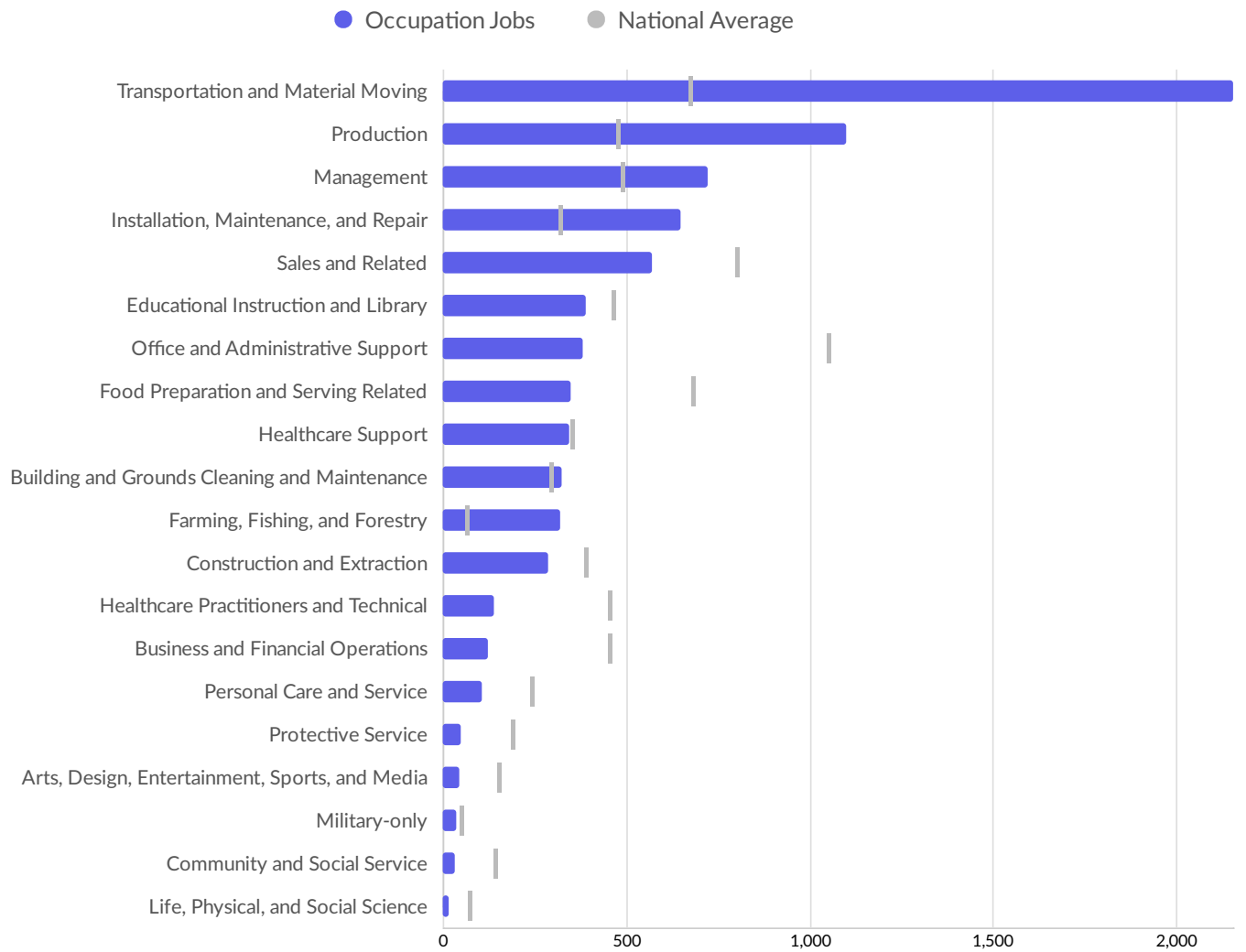
