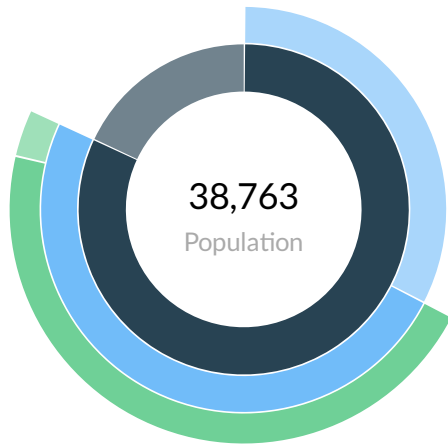
Median household income is **\$20.1K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **declined by 0.9%** since 2015, falling by 370. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.6%** between 2020 and 2025, losing 251.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **increased by 0.8%** in Crawford County, KS from 19,609 to **19,773**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 5.4%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 58.6% to 60.3% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.2% of Crawford County, KS residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (0.8% below the national average), and **8.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

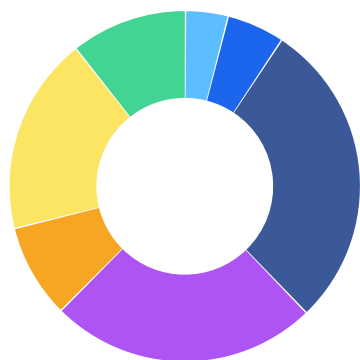

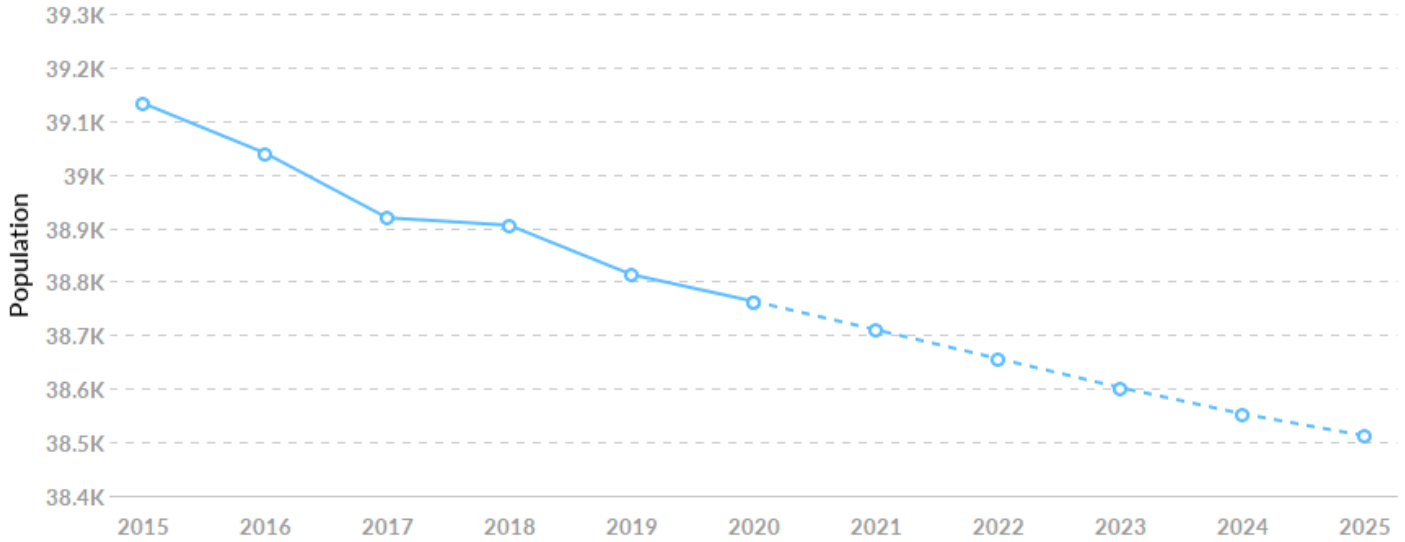

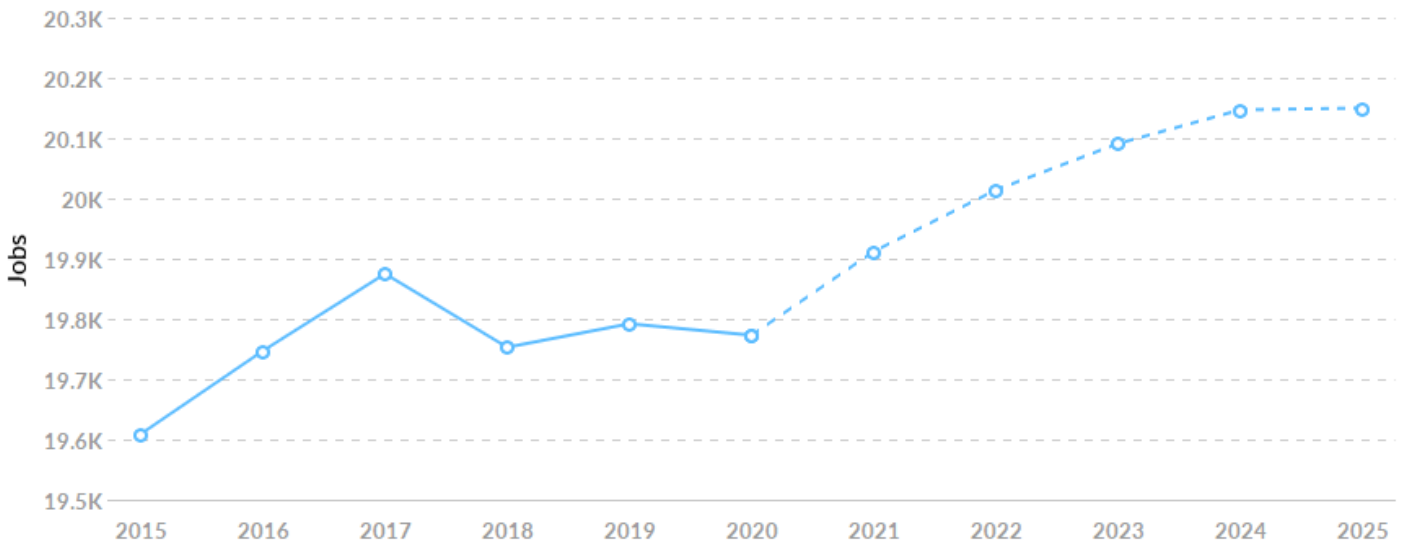

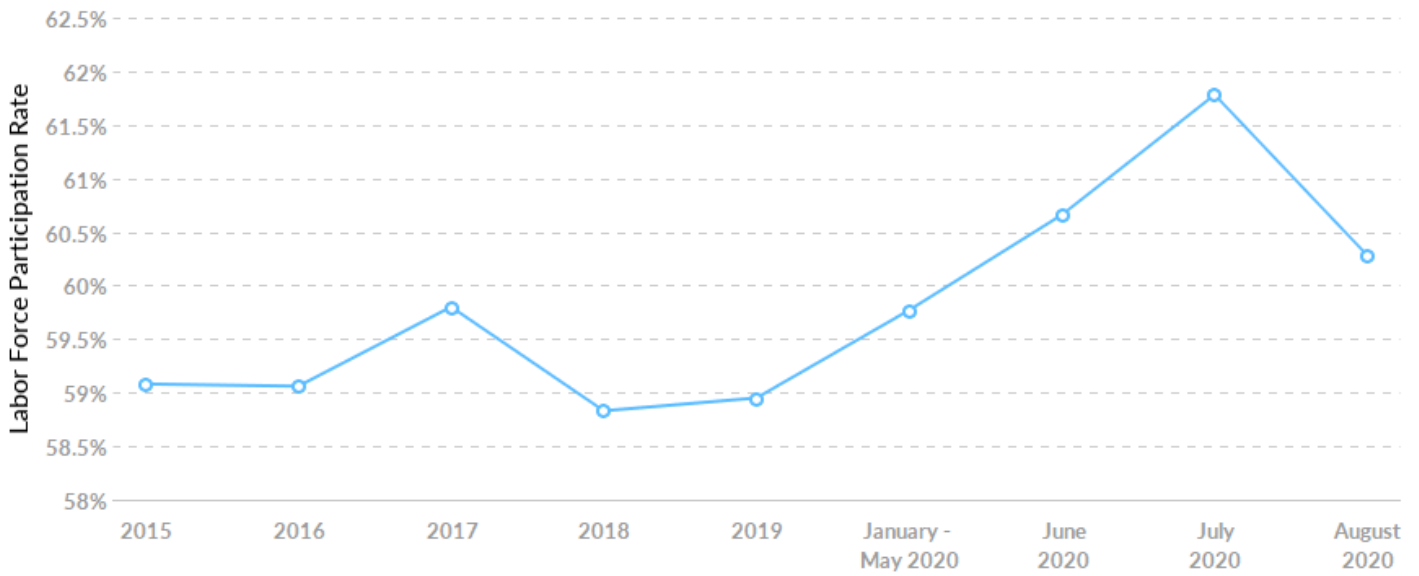
Job Trends

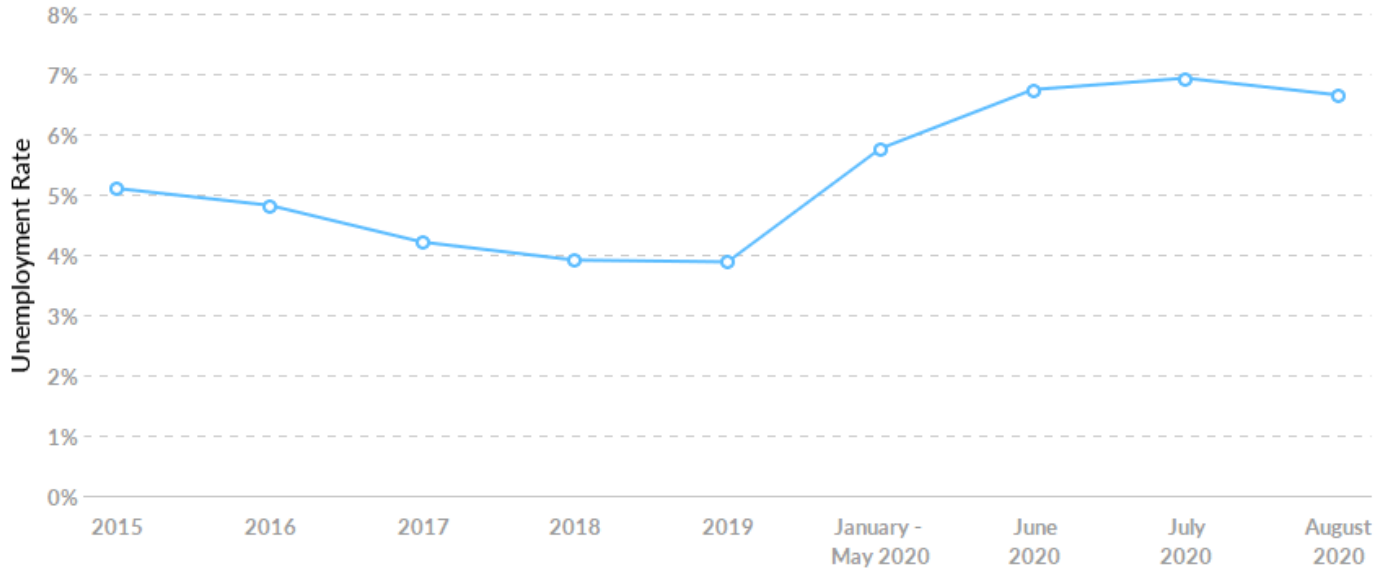

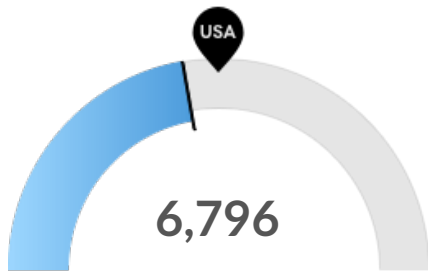
Unemployment Rate Trends

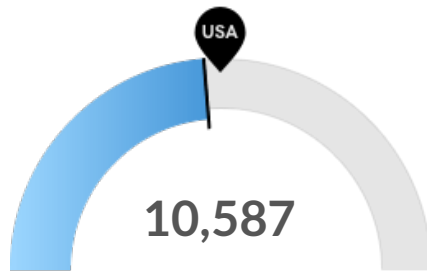

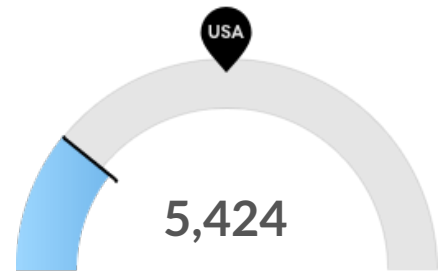
Crawford County, KS has 6,796 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 8,003.

Retiring Soon

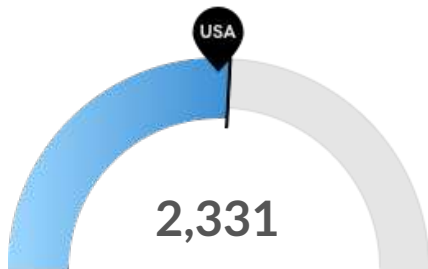
Retirement risk is about average in Crawford County, KS. The national average for an area this size is 11,412 people 55 or older, while there are 10,587 here.

Racial Diversity

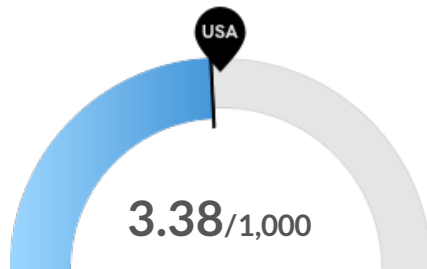
Racial diversity is low in Crawford County, KS. The national average for an area this size is 15,482 racially diverse people, while there are 5,424 here.

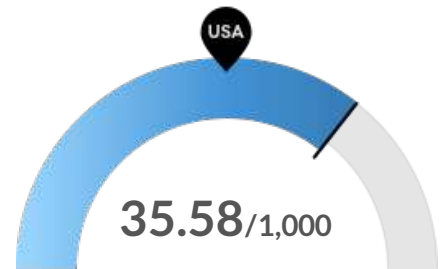
Crawford County, KS has 2,331 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2,216.

Crawford County, KS has 3.38 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.



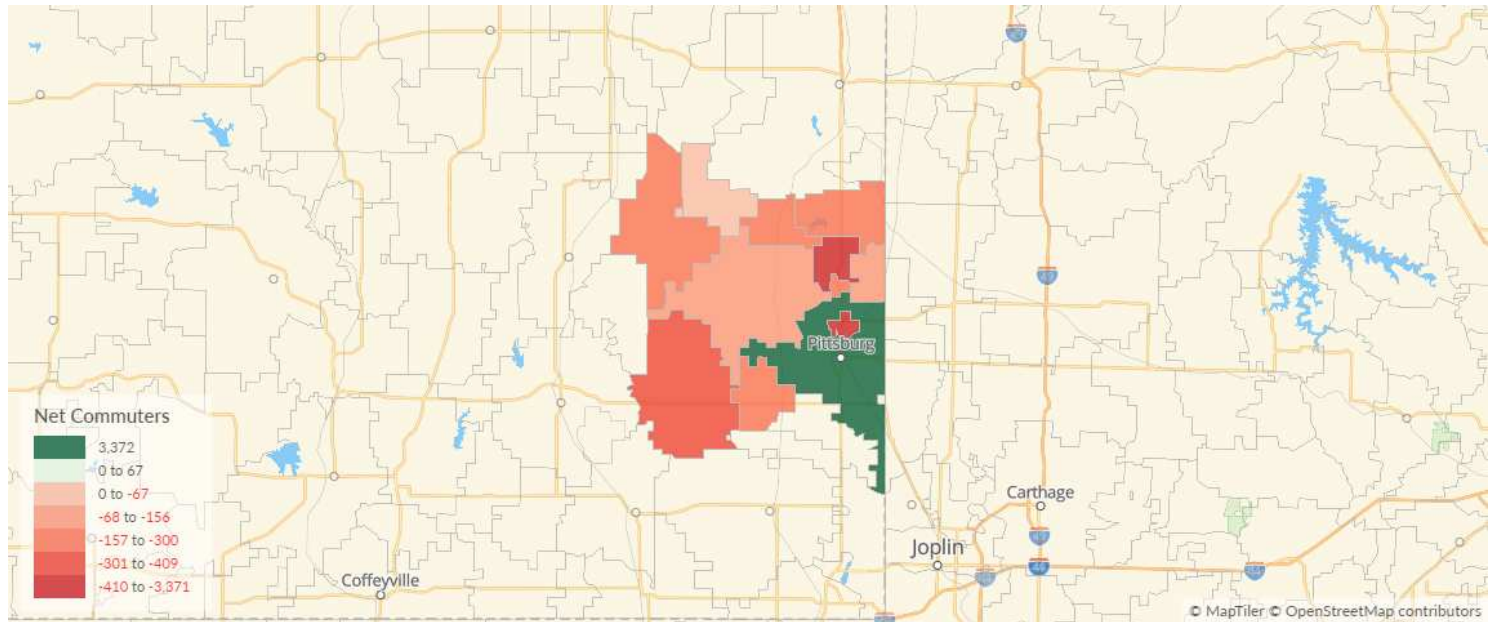

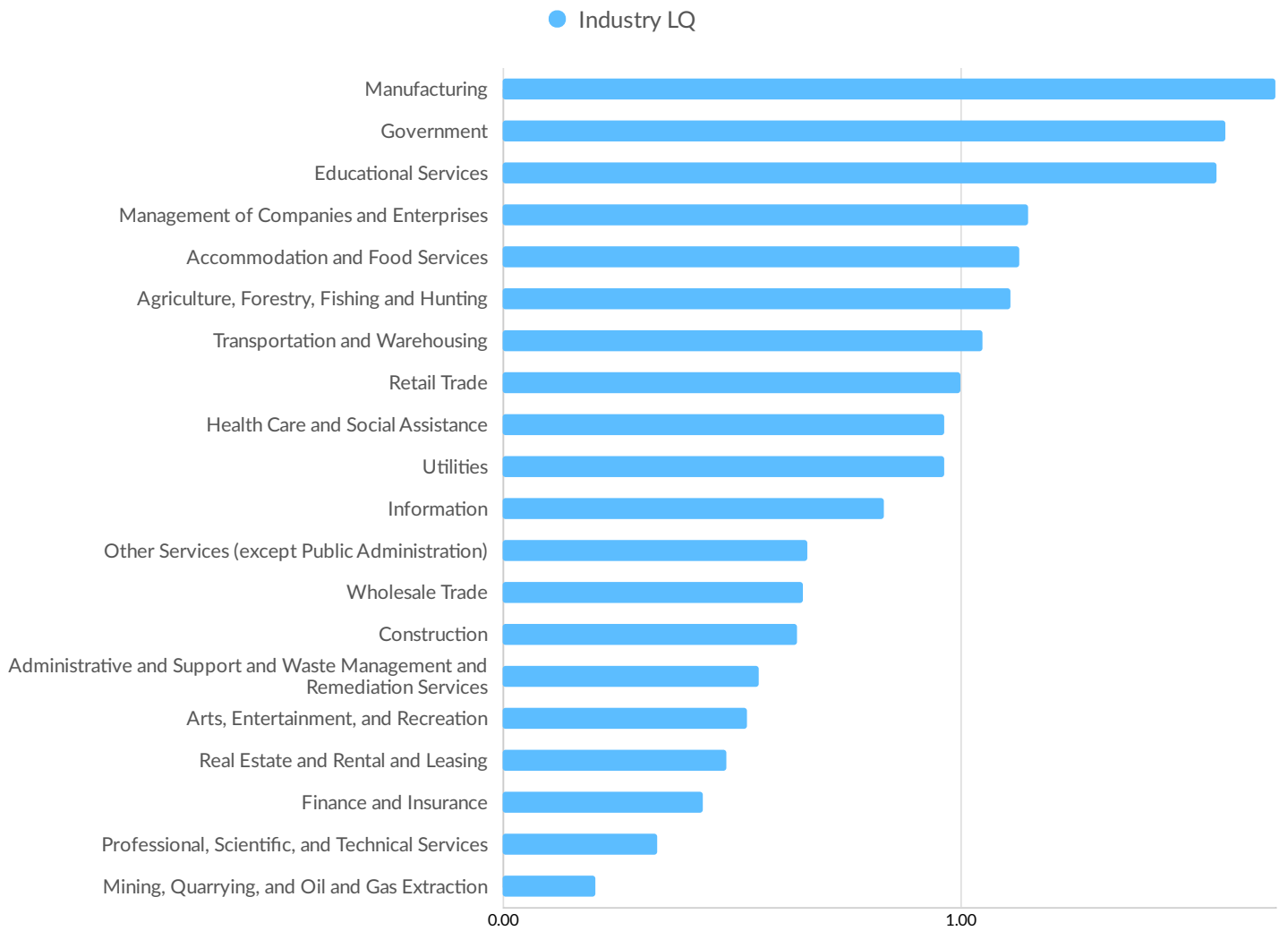

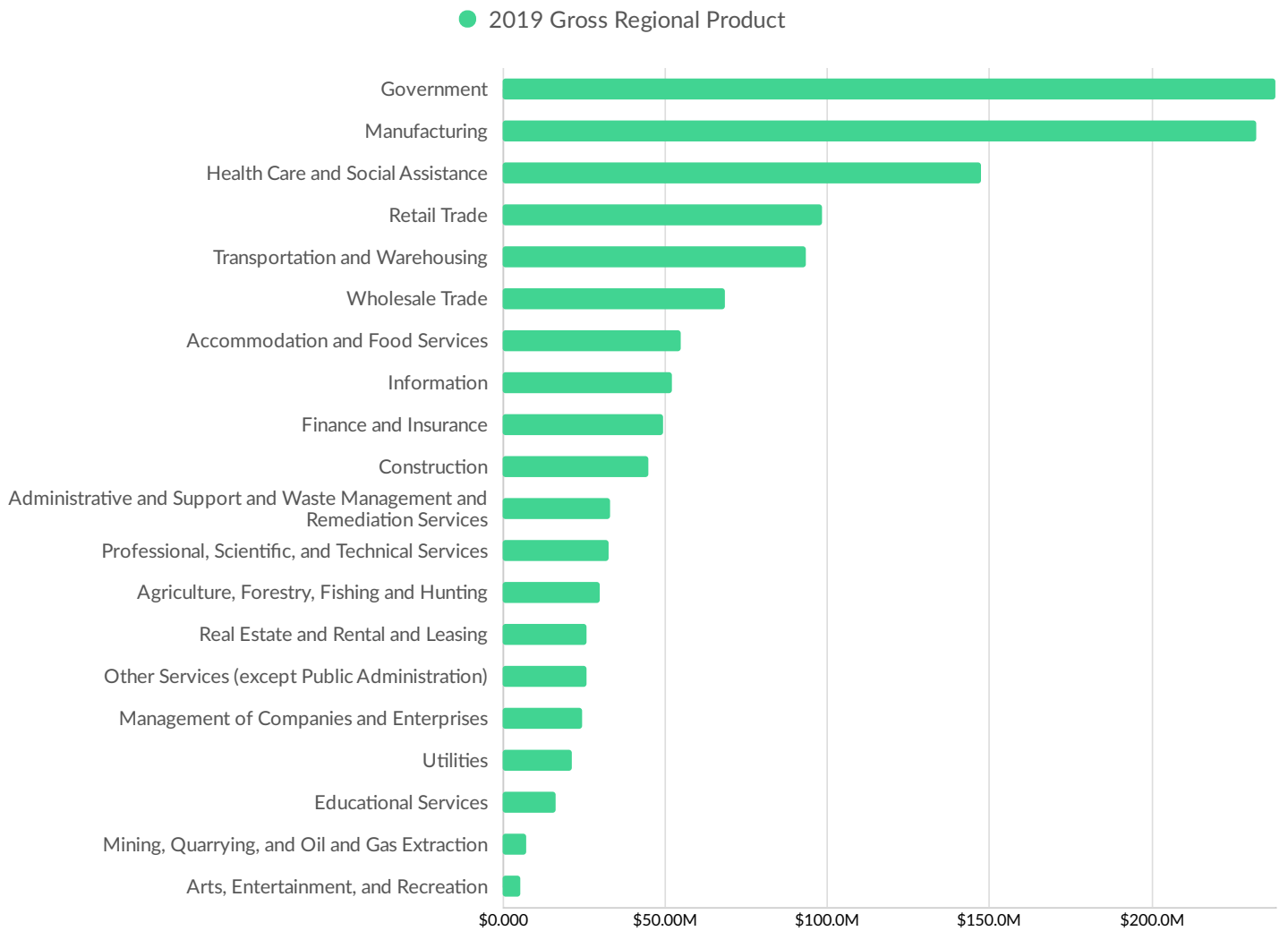
Top Growing Industries



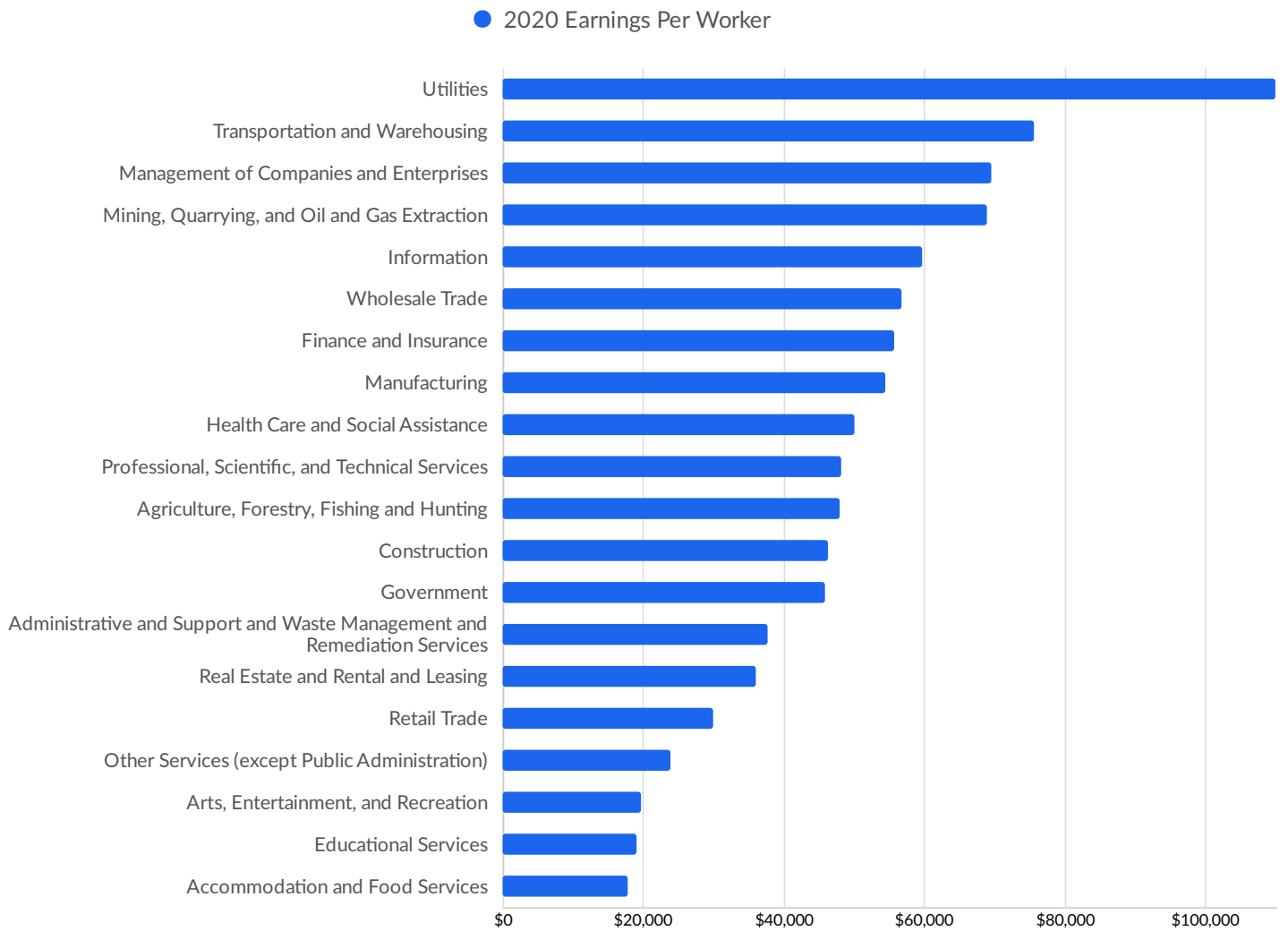
Top Industry LQ



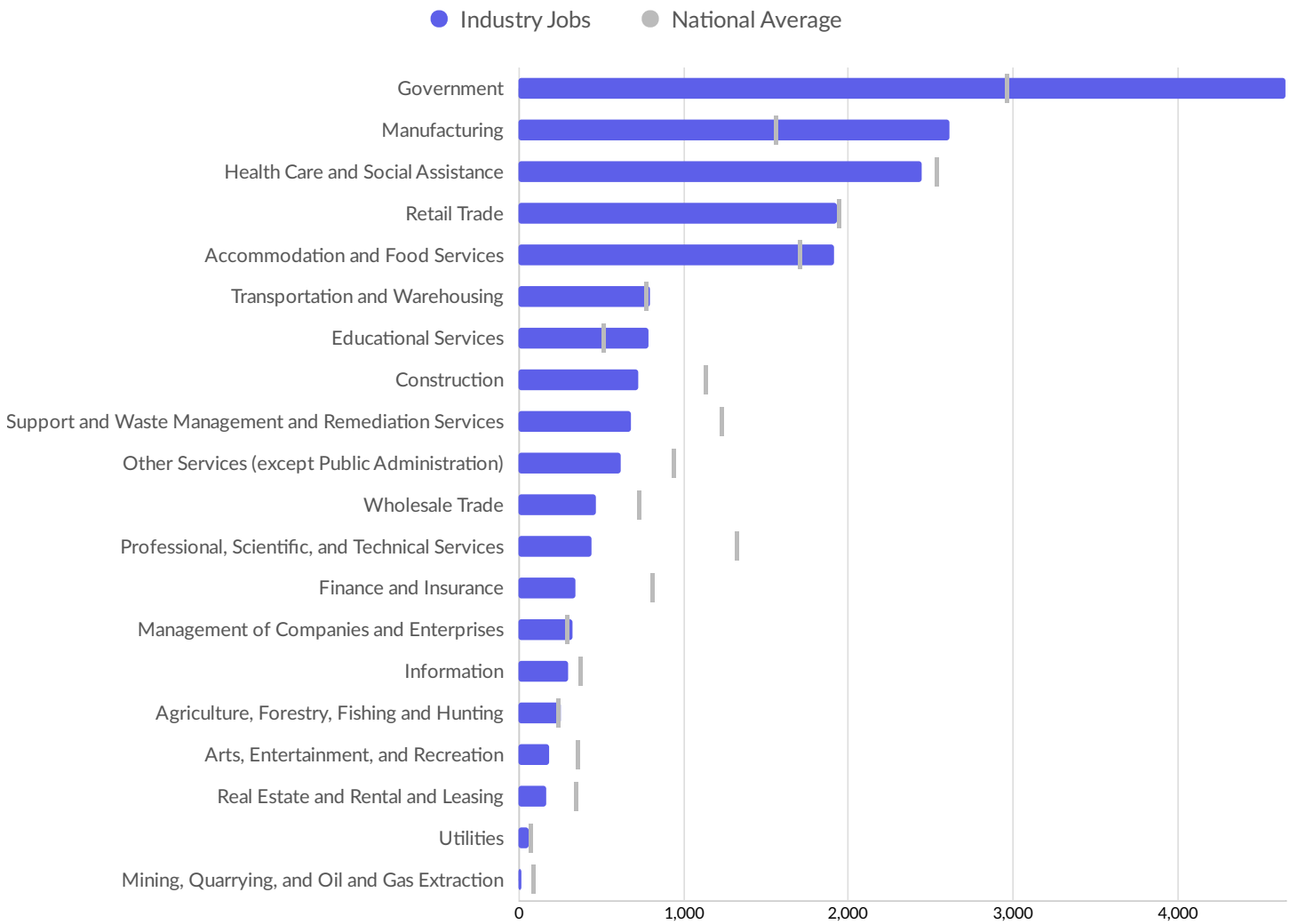
Top Industry GRP

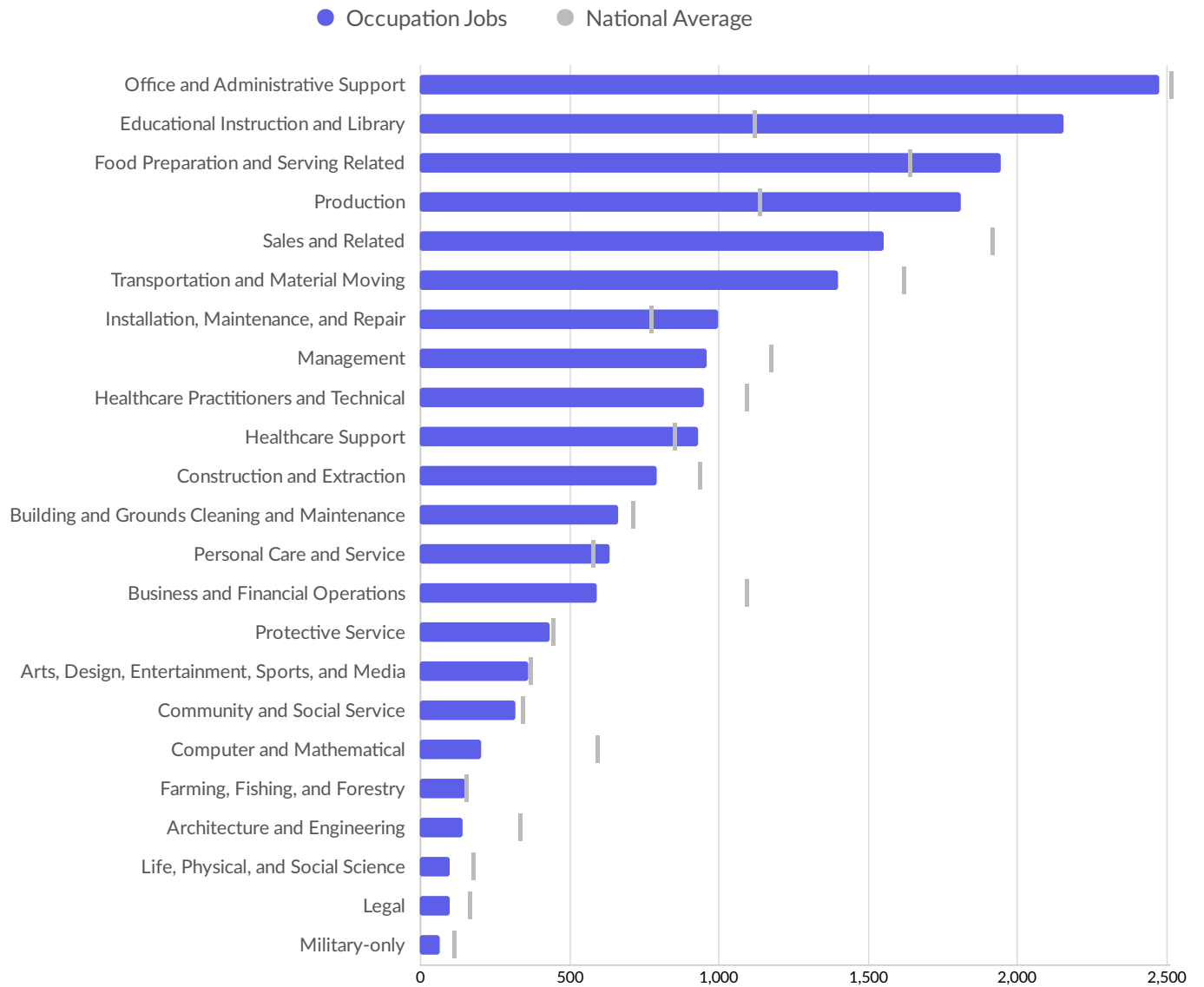

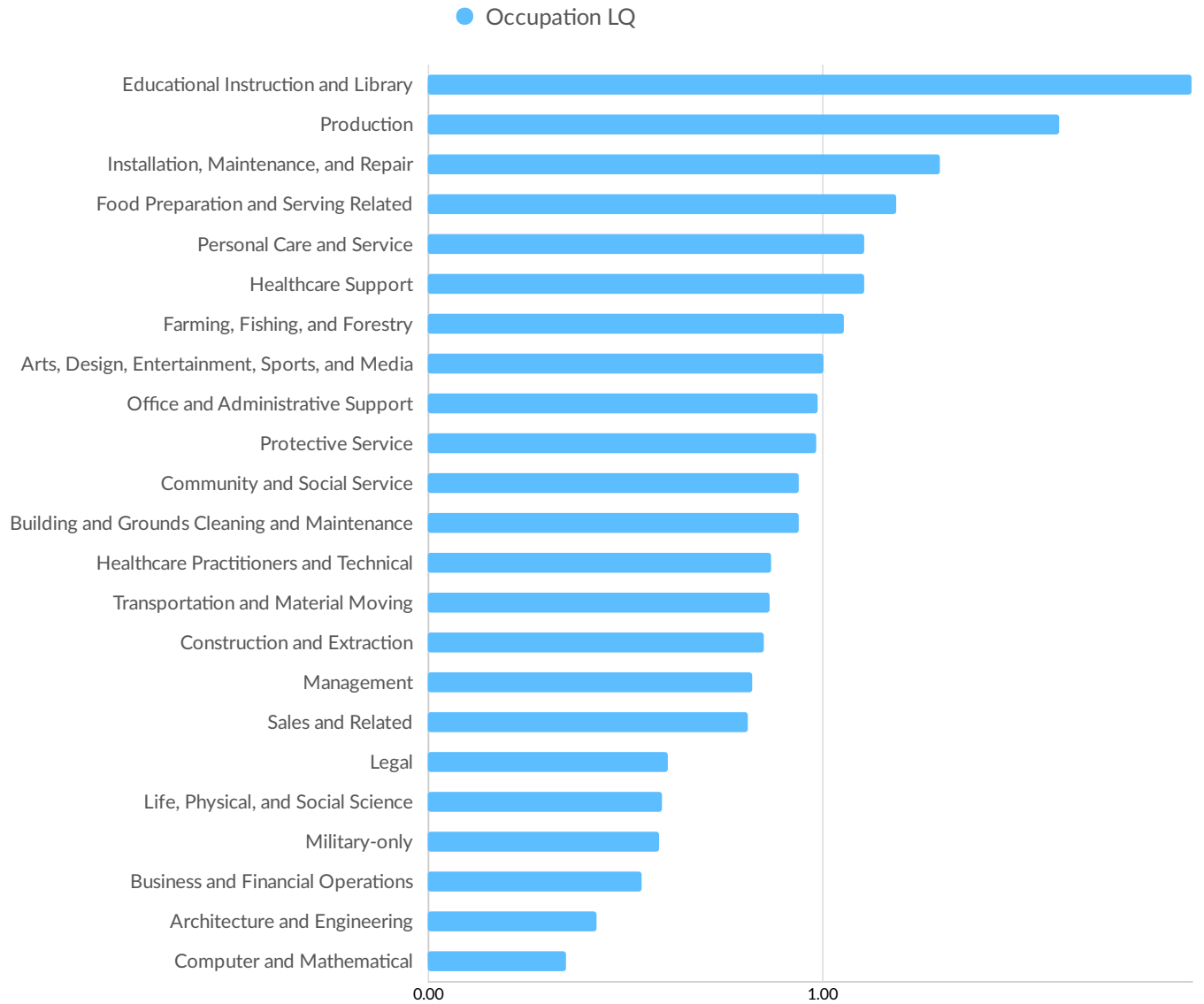

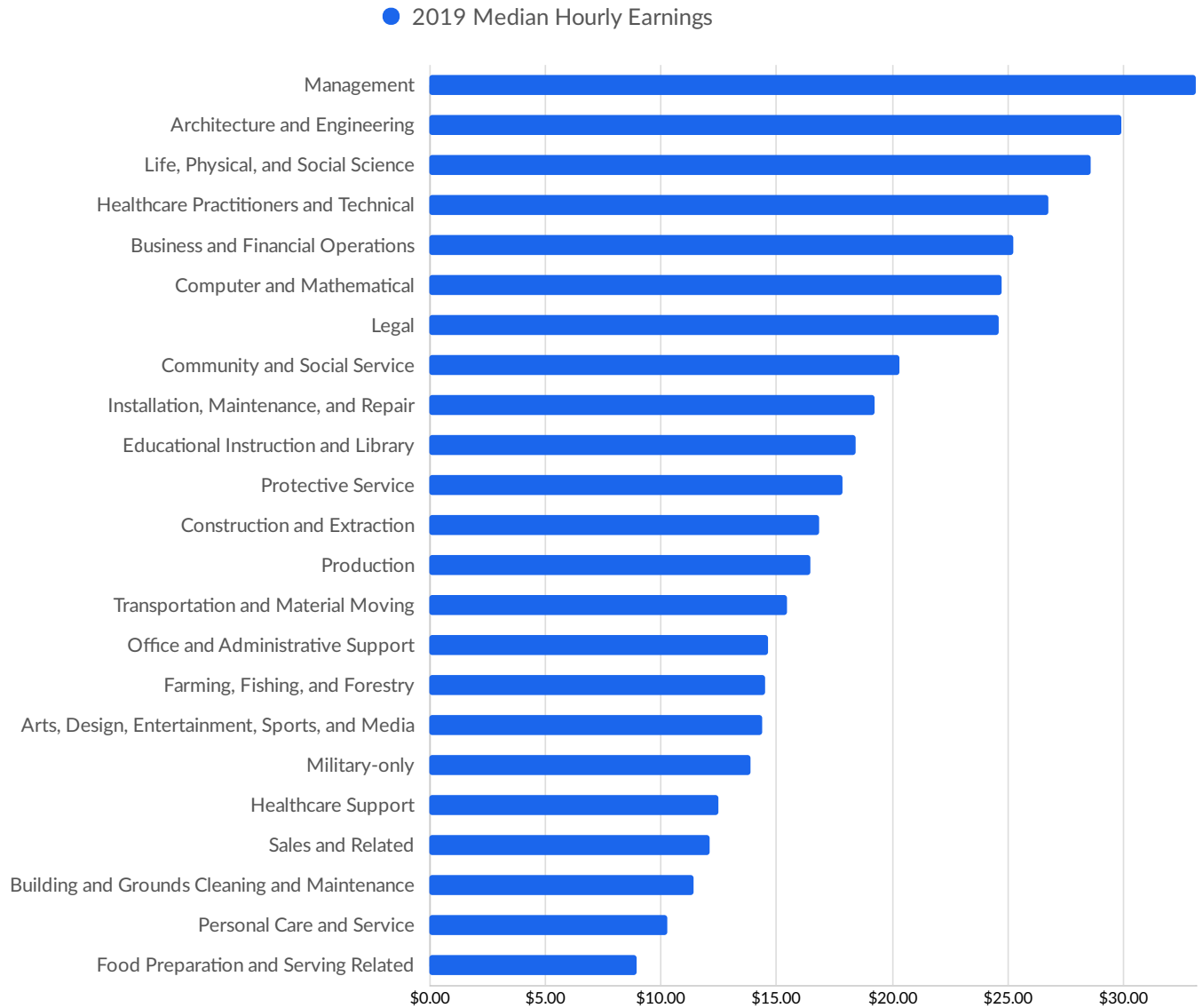
Top Growing Occupations



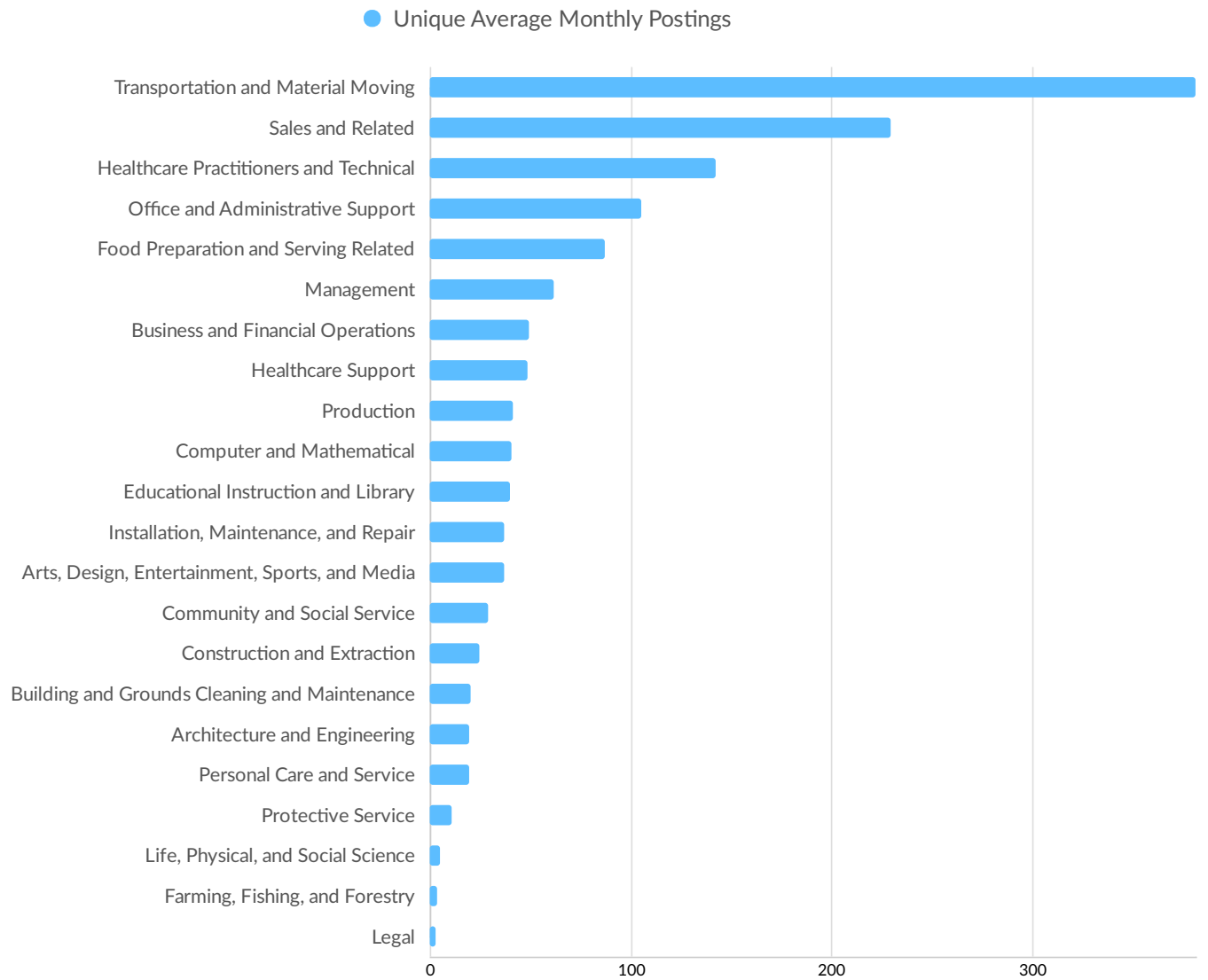
Top Occupation LQ



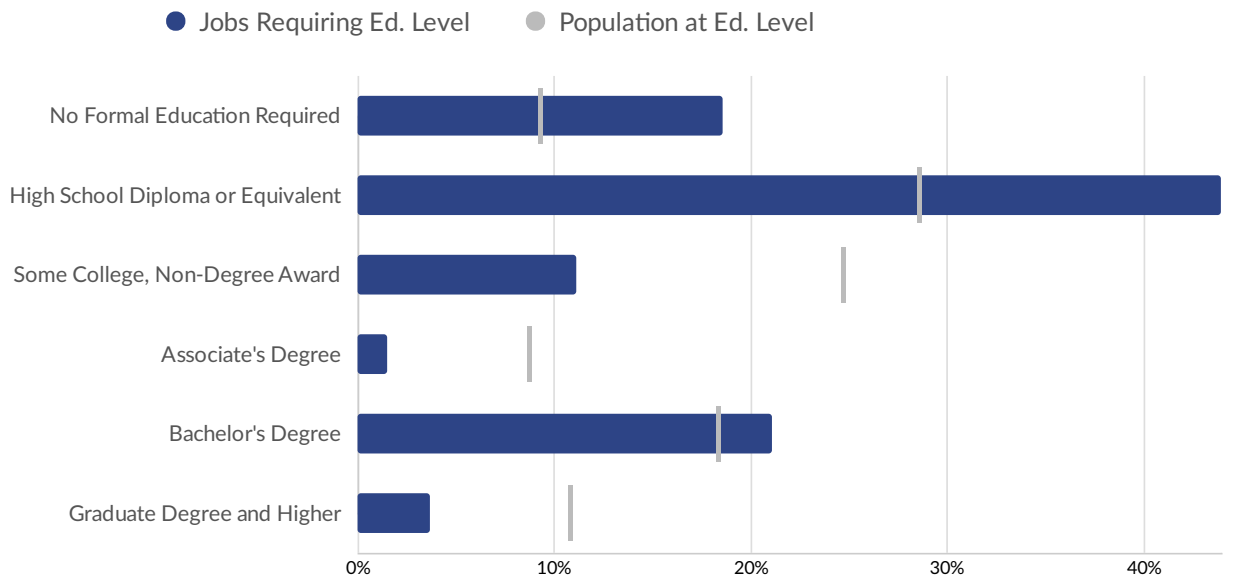
Top Occupation Earnings



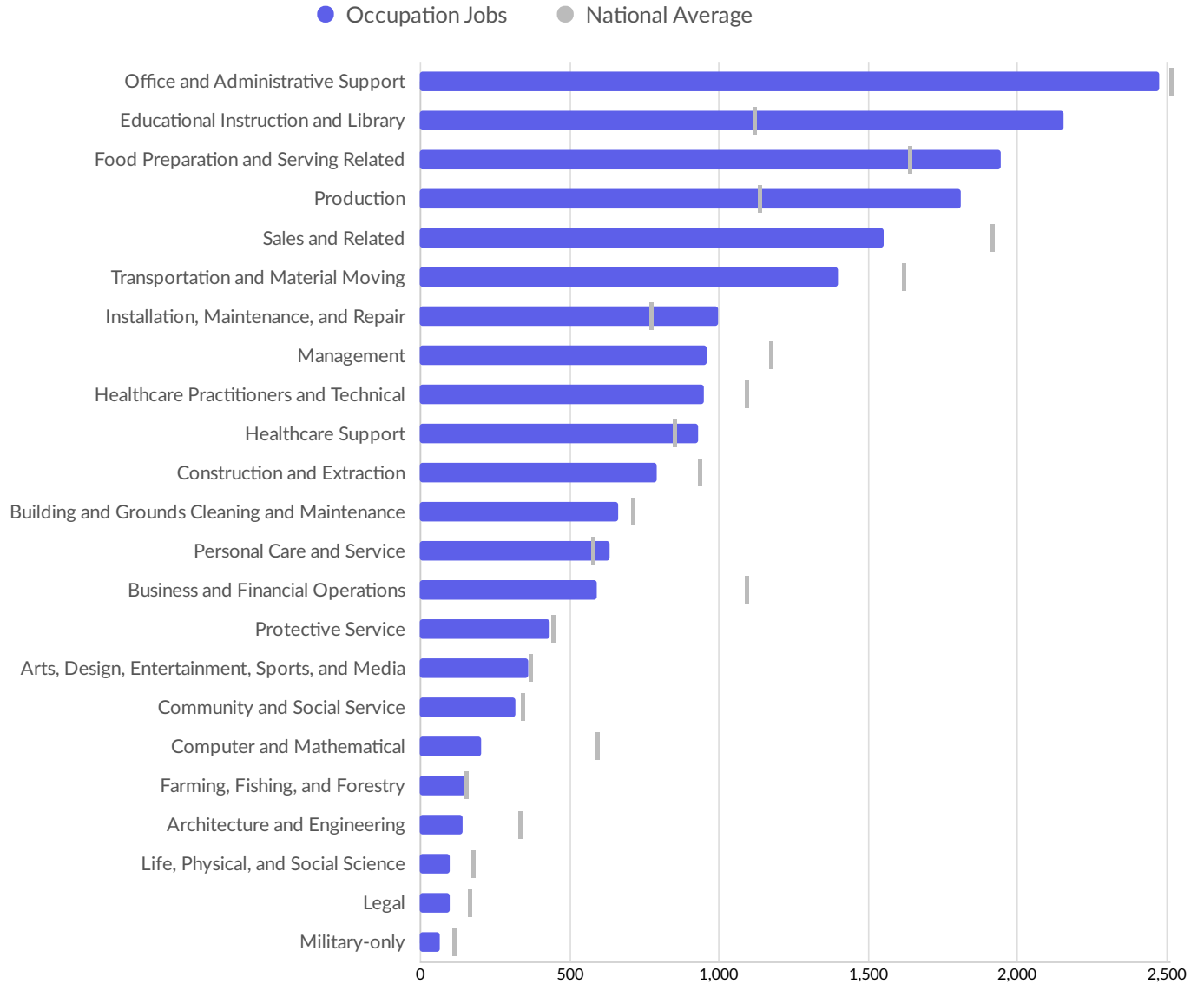

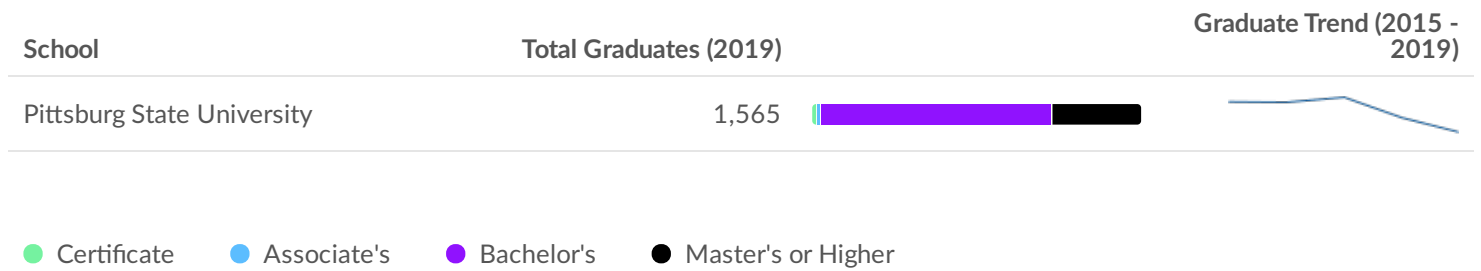
