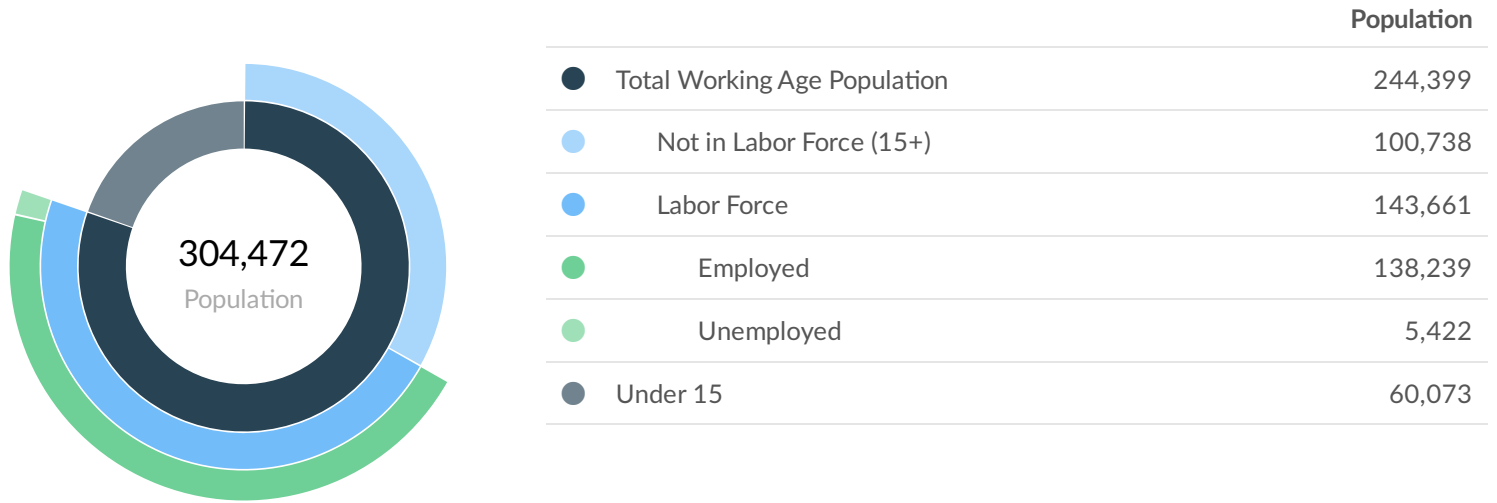
Regional average earnings per job are **\$22.4K below** the national average earnings of \$69.6K per job.

## Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 0.6%** since 2015, growing by 1,744. Population is expected to **increase by 0.6%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 1,889.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **increased by 0.9%** in 7 Counties from 138,011 to **139,265**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 5.3%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 60.6% to 58.8% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.5% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.5% below the national average), and **7.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

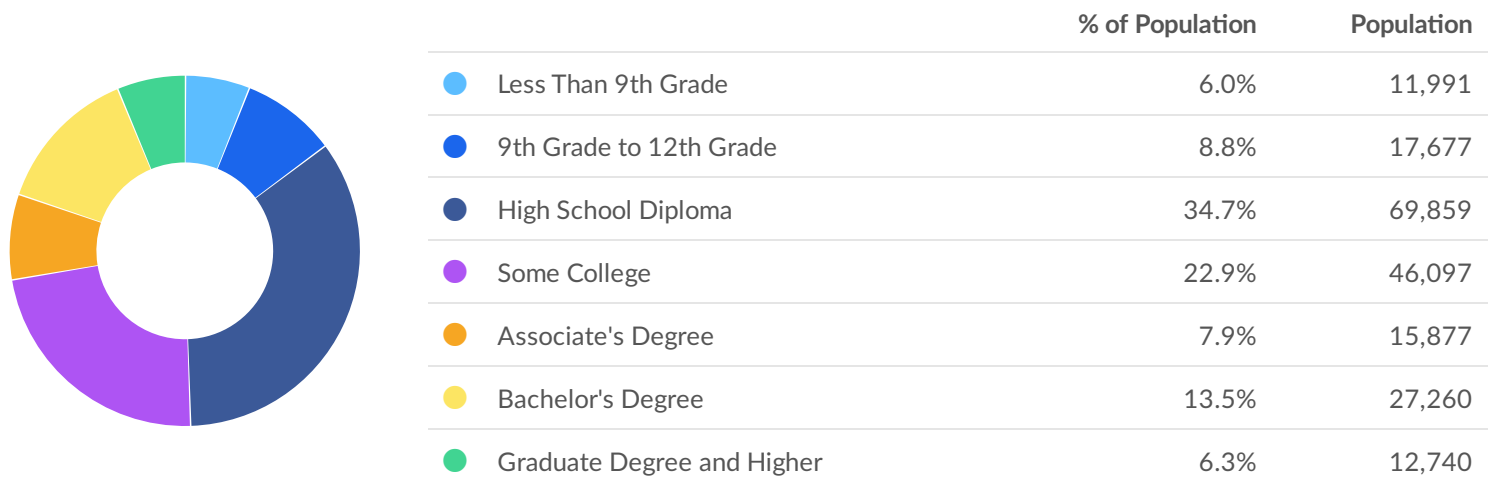

## Educational Attainment

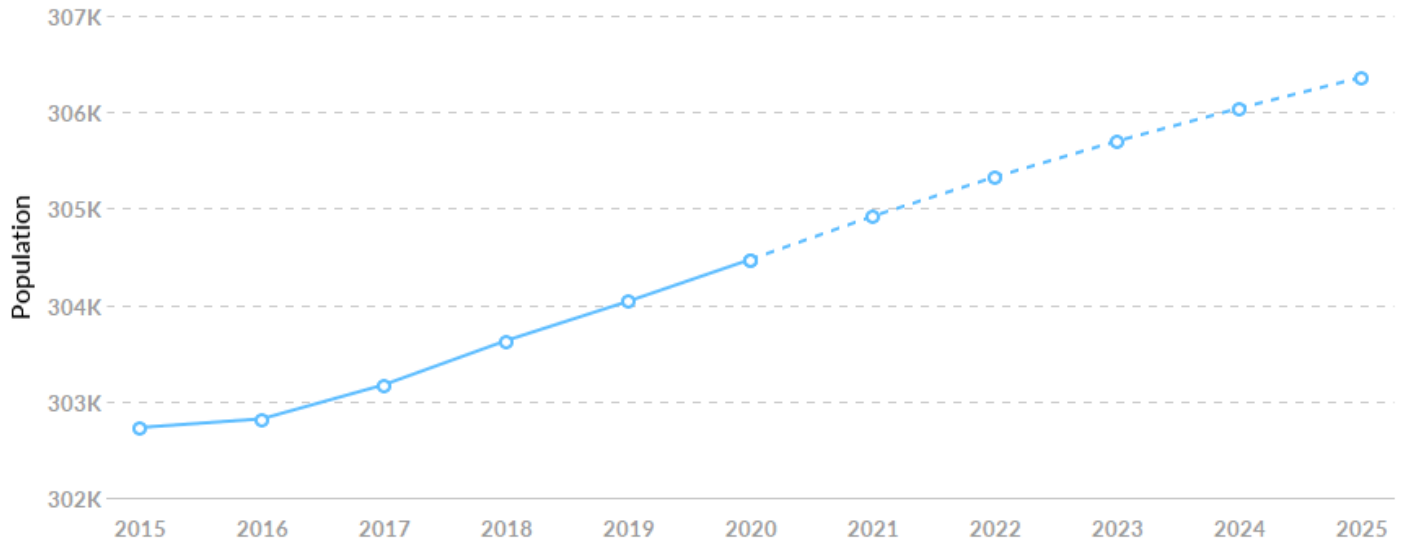

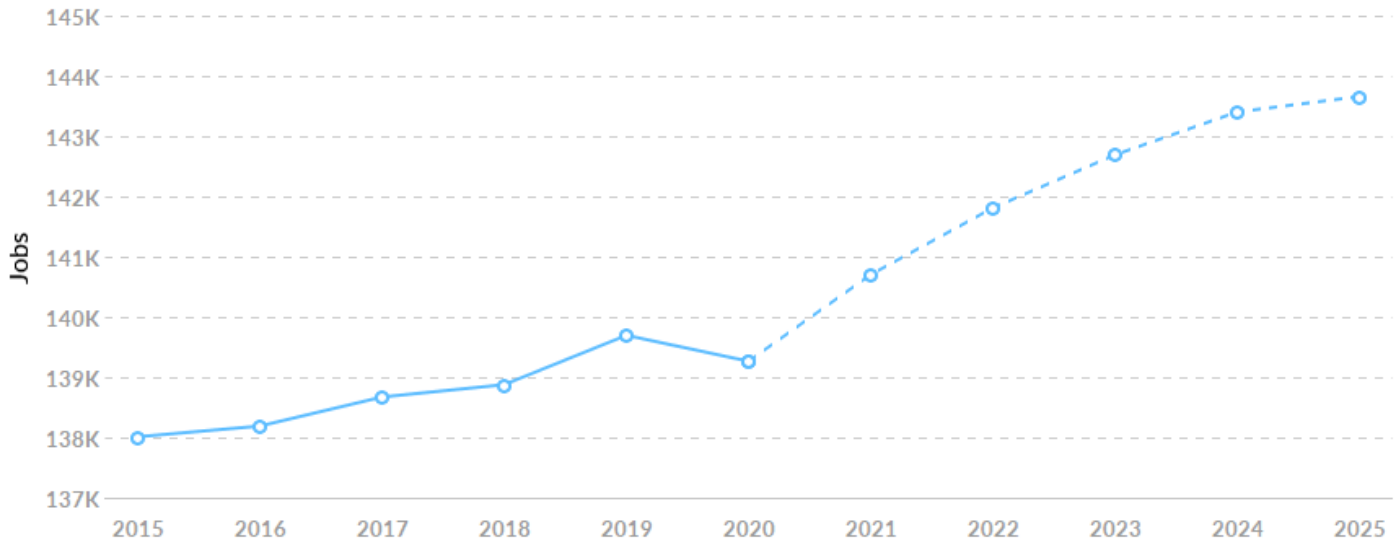

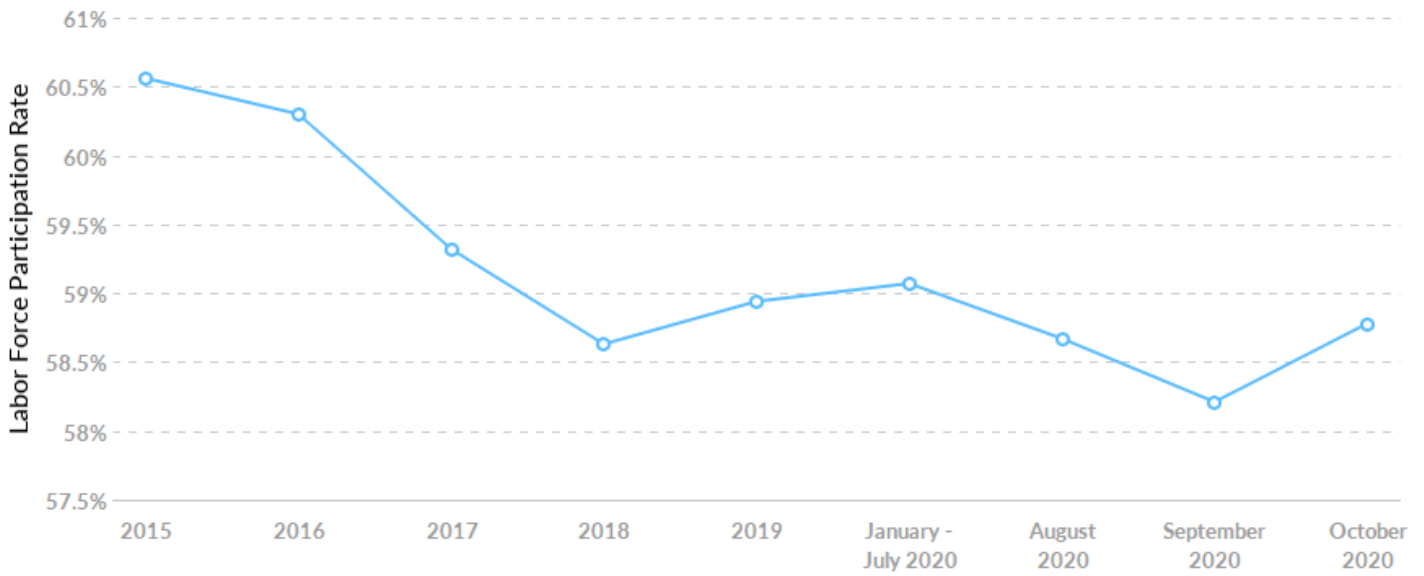
## Job Trends

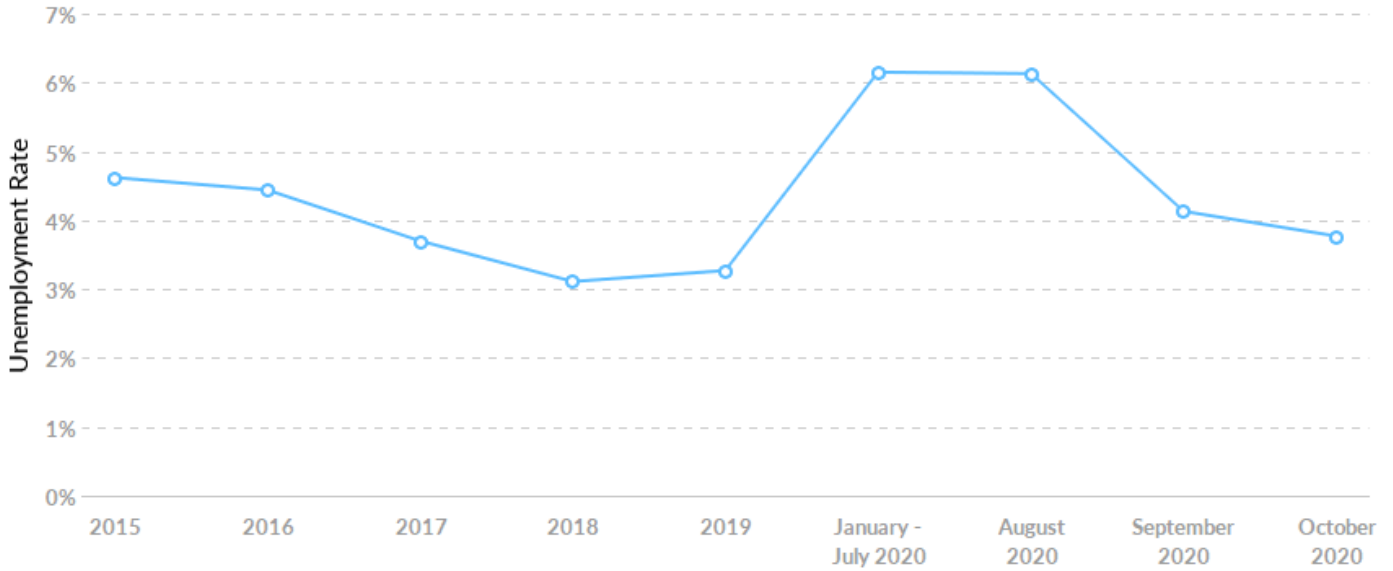

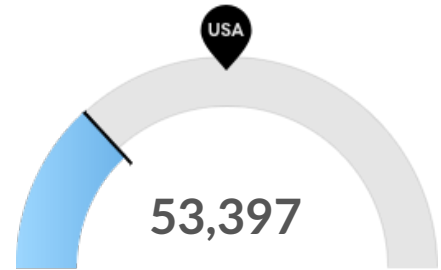
**Millennials**

Your area has 57,054 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 62,688.



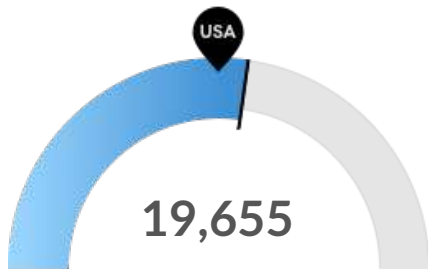
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in your area. The national average for an area this size is 89,391 people 55 or older, while there are 91,050 here.



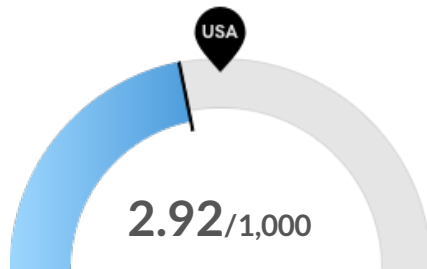
**Racial Diversity**

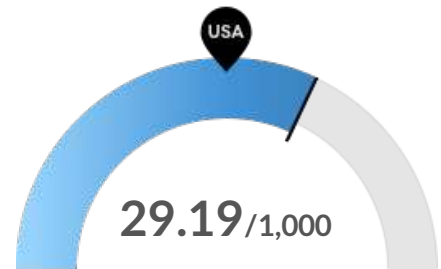

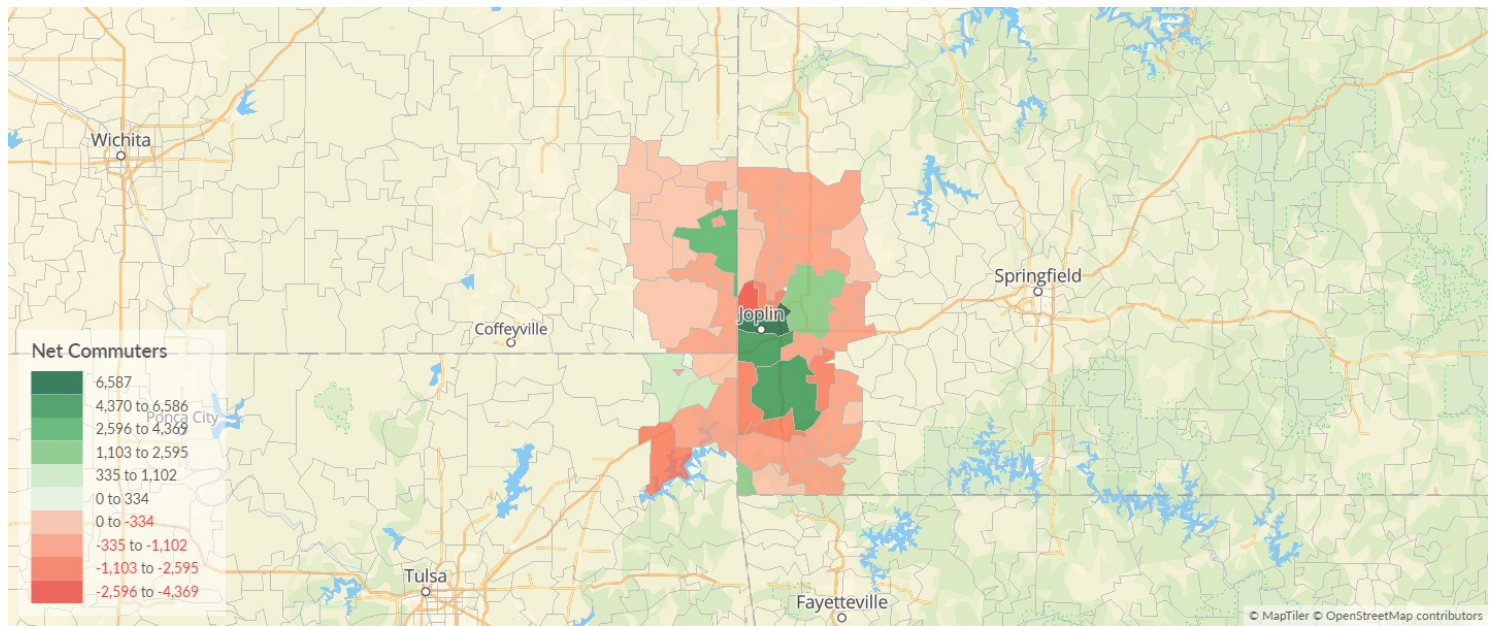

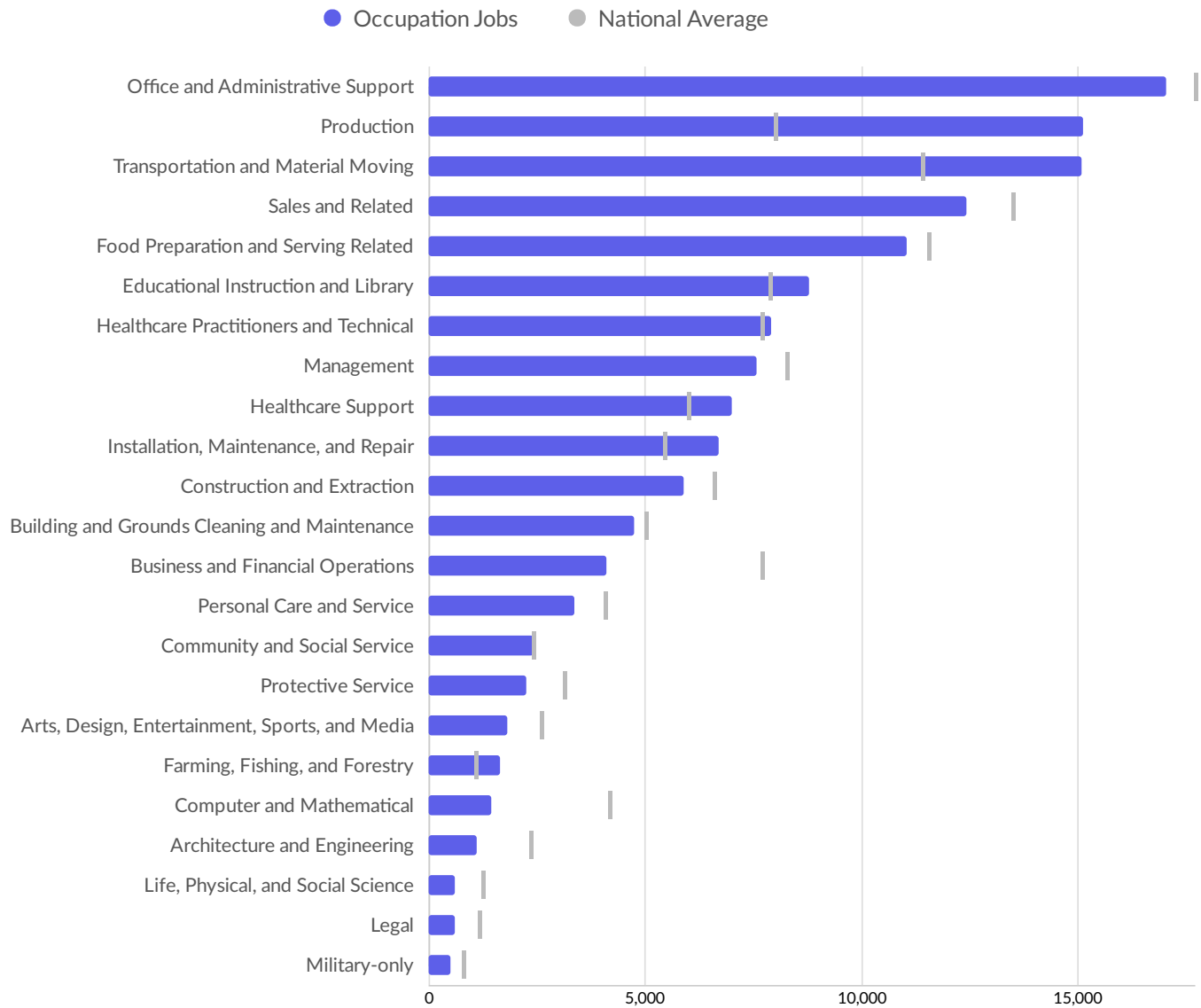

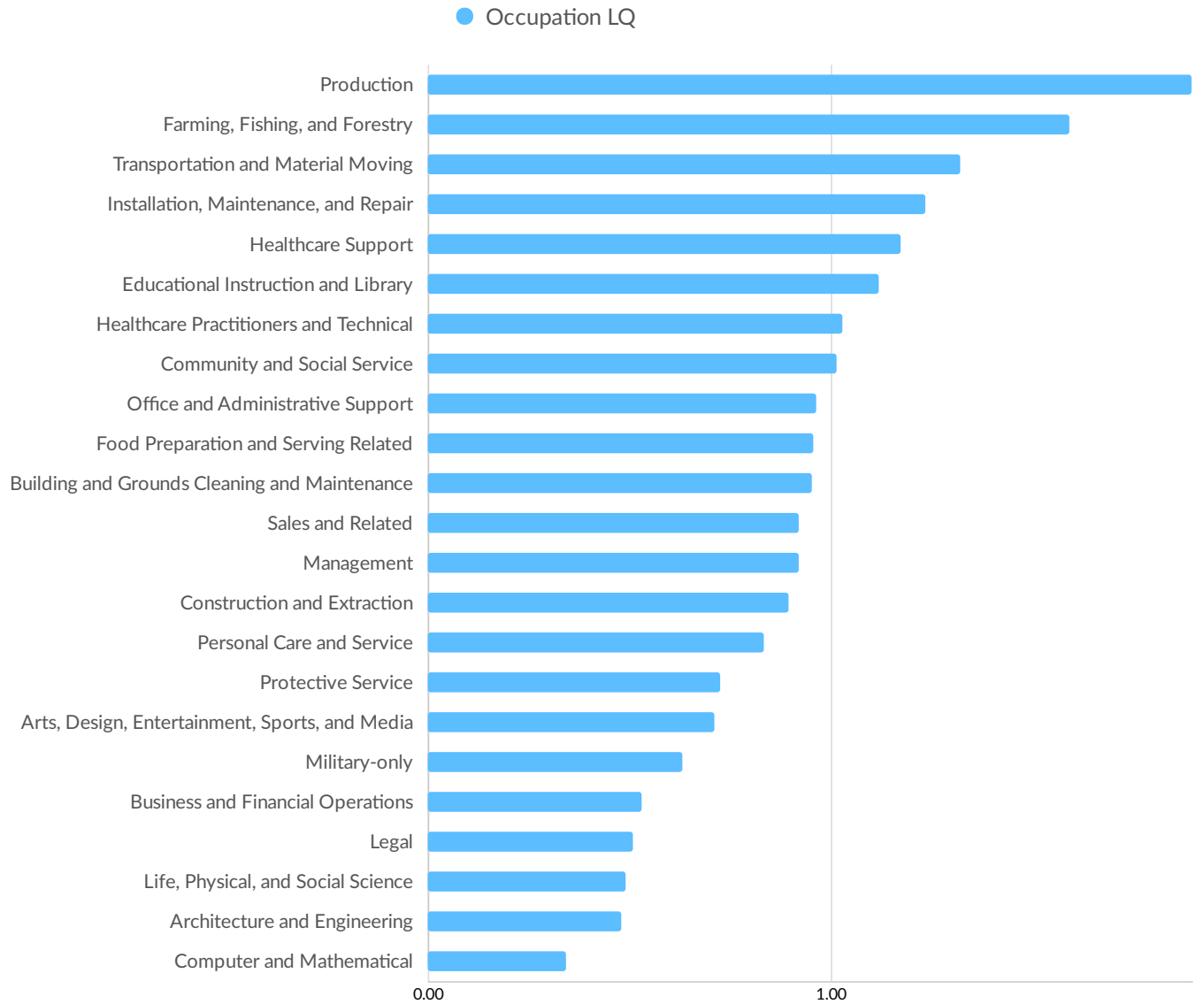

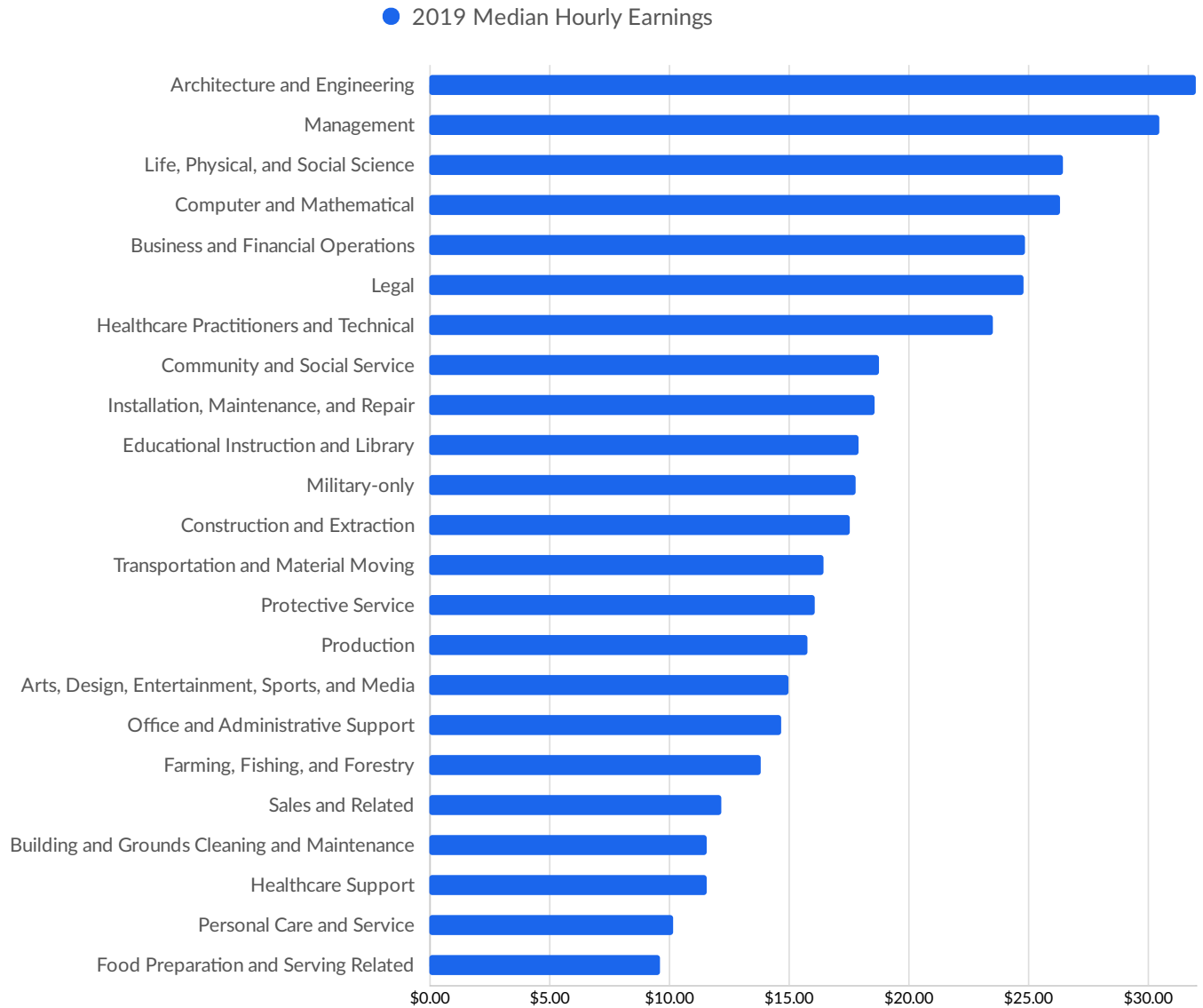

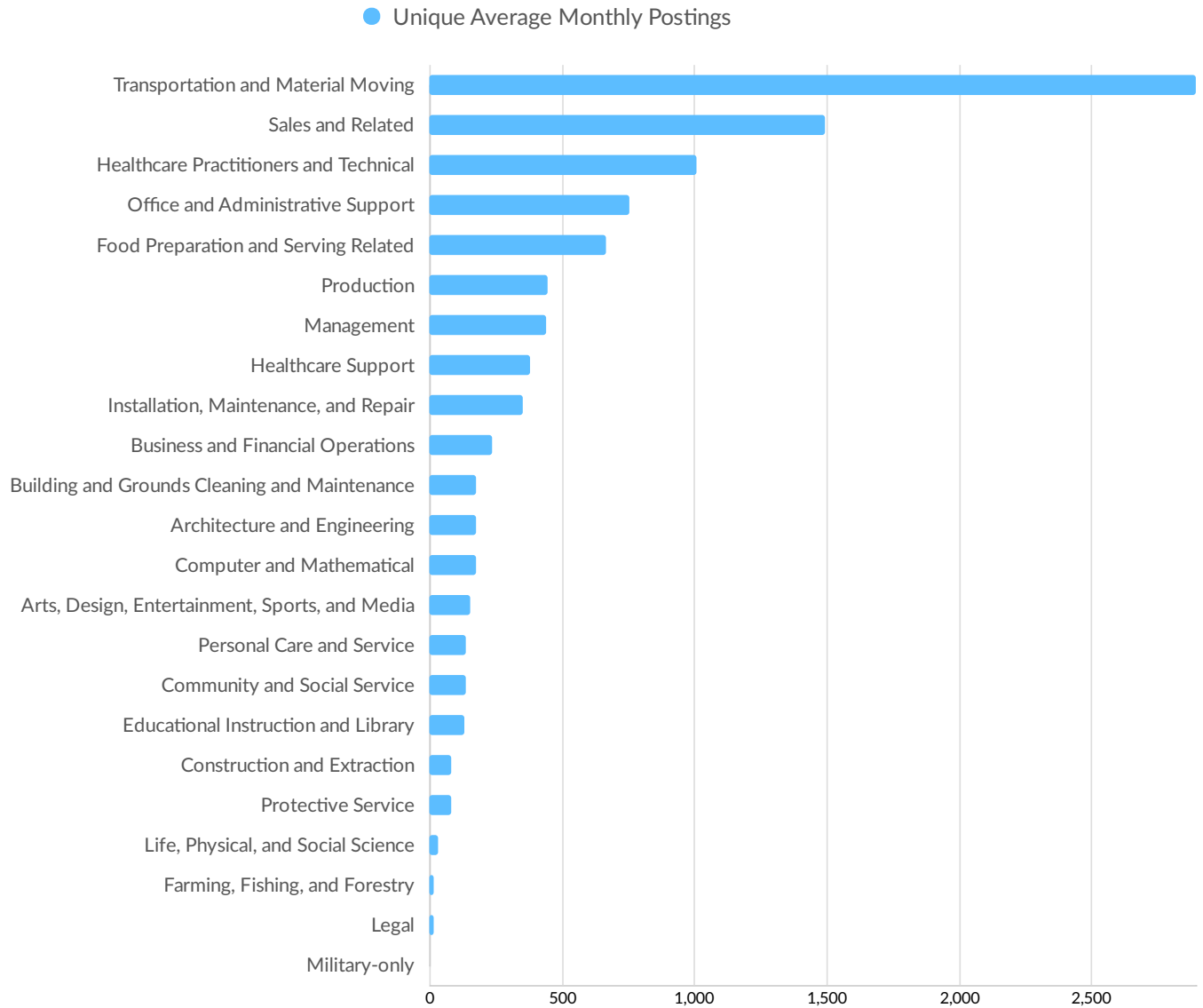
