Draft appeal document (document to formally request reconsideration of initial appeal decision, with new arguments and new evidence).

Timeline is very short here. Engagement will formally begin on 8/6, and formal request for reconsideration must be filed by Friday, 8/10. I will need a memo on the research points and at least an outline for an initial appeal document on Wednesday morning, with additional time required on Wednesday and Thursday to finalize the document based on my guidance and comments. Overall guidance on positions to be taken will be provided when assignment is made, along with numerous supporting materials.

BLOG POST ABOUT NEW 2019 ILLINOIS LAWS SHORT TIMELINE

We need a contract attorney to draft a blog post for release to our clients this weekend. The post outlines new Illinois legislation taking effect on January 1. We already created a list of items, but they need to be summarized so as to be understandable to lay readers.

PROJECT DETAILS

I have a list of approximately 50 new Illinois laws which take effect on January 1.

I would like a short summary of each law, telling the reader who it impacts and what it means for them. Some of them will be very short. For example, HB5745 allows nursing mothers to be excused from jury duty upon request. This would be of interest to physicians (especially ob-gyns) who may be asked to provide a doctor's note to excuse their nursing patient from jury duty. They can now educate their patients about this right.

For others -- such as the slew of firearms-related laws allowing businesses to seek restraining orders against threatening individuals or increasing the scope of people ineligible to hold a firearm owner's ID card -- they may be described together. Something like: Illinois legislators also made a strong statement with the new firearms-related laws taking effect. Businesses can now take out a restraining order against someone who blah blah blah (HB1234), workers can raise red flags with blah blah (HB5678), and employers are required to blah blah (HB9012).

Finally, for others, they'll require a more in-depth look at the legislative history and purpose -- especially those pertaining to telehealth and telemedicine.

In some way or another, all of the laws on this list have the potential to impact our healthcare provider clients.

I'd estimate this blog post will be over 2,000 words in length, especially with the extensive summaries and/or legislation titles to be included. However, I've already pulled all of the bill short summaries and numbers, so it should go pretty quickly when reviewing them on the IL legislature site. I'd estimate that some will take 2 minutes to review while others may take 20-30 minutes, so on the balance, I think the project should take <5 hours.

Provide you with written guidance regarding: (a) the legal and ethical parameters within which you are permitted to proffer telehealth services, and (b) the limitations, restrictions, or responsibilities such a relationship imposes upon you. Please note: As we discussed, each state is different, so this guidance will relate to services rendered in Illinois to patients in Illinois.

PROJECT DETAILS

Please draft a research memo which outlines: (a) the legal and ethical parameters within which an Illinois-licensed physical therapist is permitted to offer telehealth services, and (b) the limitations, restrictions, or responsibilities that such a patient-provider relationship imposes upon the physical therapist. This should evaluate two potential scenarios: (1) the IL-licensed physical therapist is offering telehealth PT to an IL patient, and (2) the IL-licensed physical therapist is offering telehealth PT to a "snowbird" patient who is temporarily residing in FL. Please address: scope of practice, in-person visit requirements (if any), limitations on the location of the patient during the course of treatment (i.e., some states require that a patient receiving telehealth be physically located in a medical clinic during the "visit" itself), privacy concerns, ethical and legal limitations.

The memo will serve as the basis for a letter to my clients about whether they can offer telehealth PT to their patients who are either in IL or are temporarily in FL (likely for 1-3 months at a time). I would estimate the letter would be approximately 3-4 pages, single-spaced, and that it will provide practical guidance supported by legal authorities upon which my clients will rely.

I'm just looking for a brief memorandum, as long as it needs to be to address the issue. More info about it:

Client's practice is that when people call and make an appointment for "family or marriage" counseling, the appointment is scheduled under whoever's name called, and that person's insurance is usually used. That person is the "primary client" and receives an appropriate diagnosis, as well as goals and objectives that are appropriate for their situation.

They ask for anyone else who is attending the session to fill out an informed consent, which they keep electronically with the other person's documents.

They do not, however, keep separate notes or typically even a separate chart for those other people. They say they cannot bill insurance for multiple people at the same time, so the only reason to keep any records under the other person's name would be for "legal reasons". (Is this true?)

Client's first question is - what are they required to keep for a person who attends an appointment as part of family counseling who is not the primary client?

Second question - what information should they have in the informed consent to make sure they are covered for anyone requesting records as part of a family counseling session? (An example they gave: Sometimes they come across people who are getting divorced or children who attended a session with another family member, and there is an expectation that extensive records exist that they simply don't have.)

PROJECT DETAILS

Issue #1 Please thoroughly address each of the following questions for each of the following states: NC, CO, OH, MI, AZ, FL, TX:

Our client would like to start offering compression pumps and breast pumps nationwide. When it comes to this type of equipment, what do they need to know or do in each state? Are there particular requirements that differ from those that govern their current products?

- Do they need to have a brick and mortar location in each state?
- If yes, can they utilize sales representative in each state, instead of an actual brick and mortar location?

If our client manufactures the actual pumps in Illinois and ships them to each state, is there any requirement that they maintain a brick and mortar presence in each state?

Issue #2 Our client would like to hire part-time or full-time W-2 employees (not 1099 "contractors") in the below states to perform sales representative functions on its behalf.

For each of the following states: NC, CO, OH, MI, AZ, FL, TX, please thoroughly address:

1. Any employment laws/taxes generally, and anything specific to the DME context, which would govern this situation. My guess is that each state requires at a minimum registration/payment of that state's employment tax registration, unemployment insurance, and/or worker's compensation.
2. Any requirement that they have a physical location in each state to hire such employees (either as a basic labor law question or in the DME context). If a physical location is required, does hiring a 1099 contractor change the physical location requirement?
