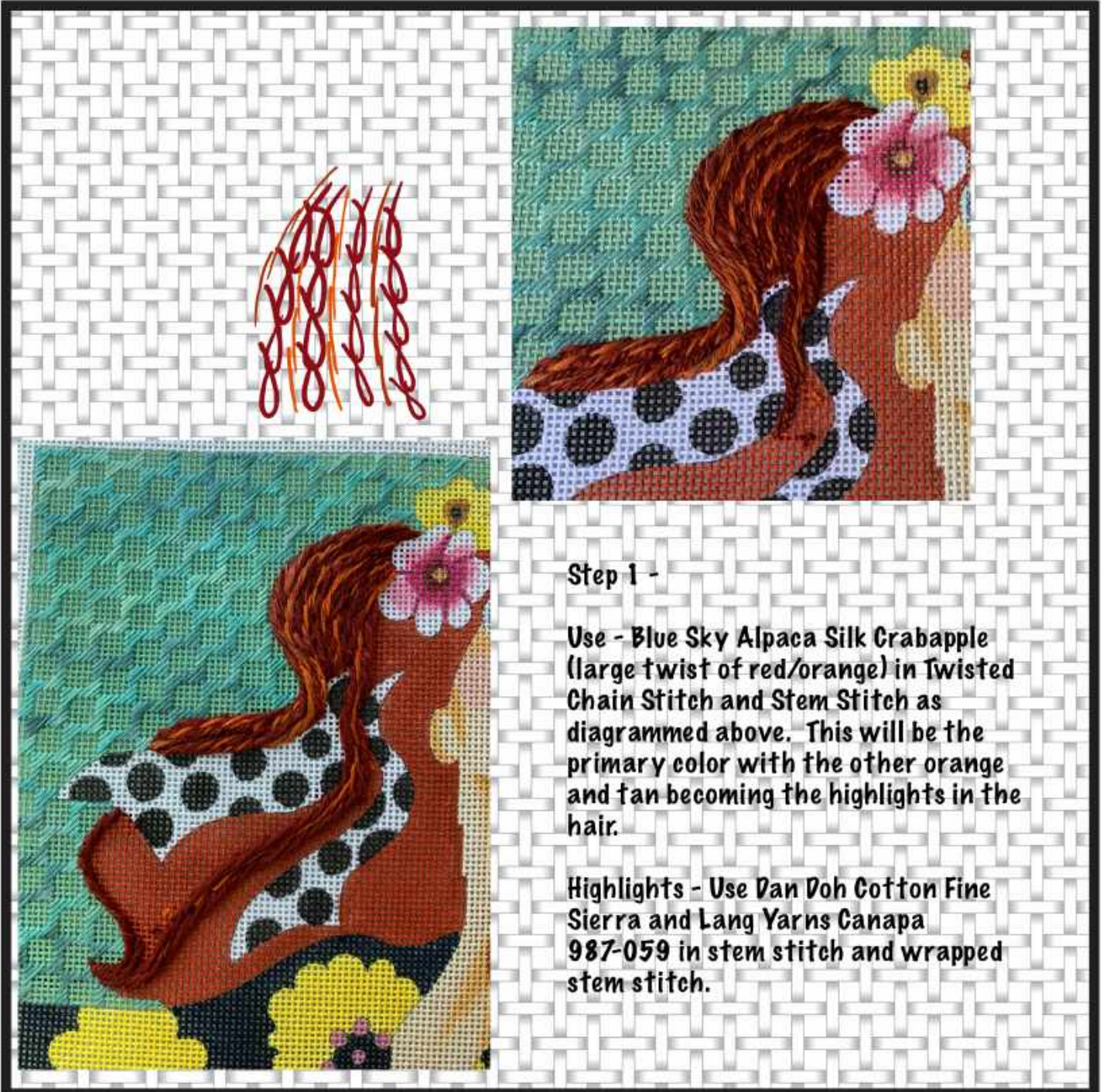
**Background**



**Use - Ollagua #02 Aquamarina. Strand the fiber down to 2 ply. Apply Thread Magic before stitching as this is a knitting fiber that needs "conditioning" in order to have your stitches lay flat.**

**Hair**



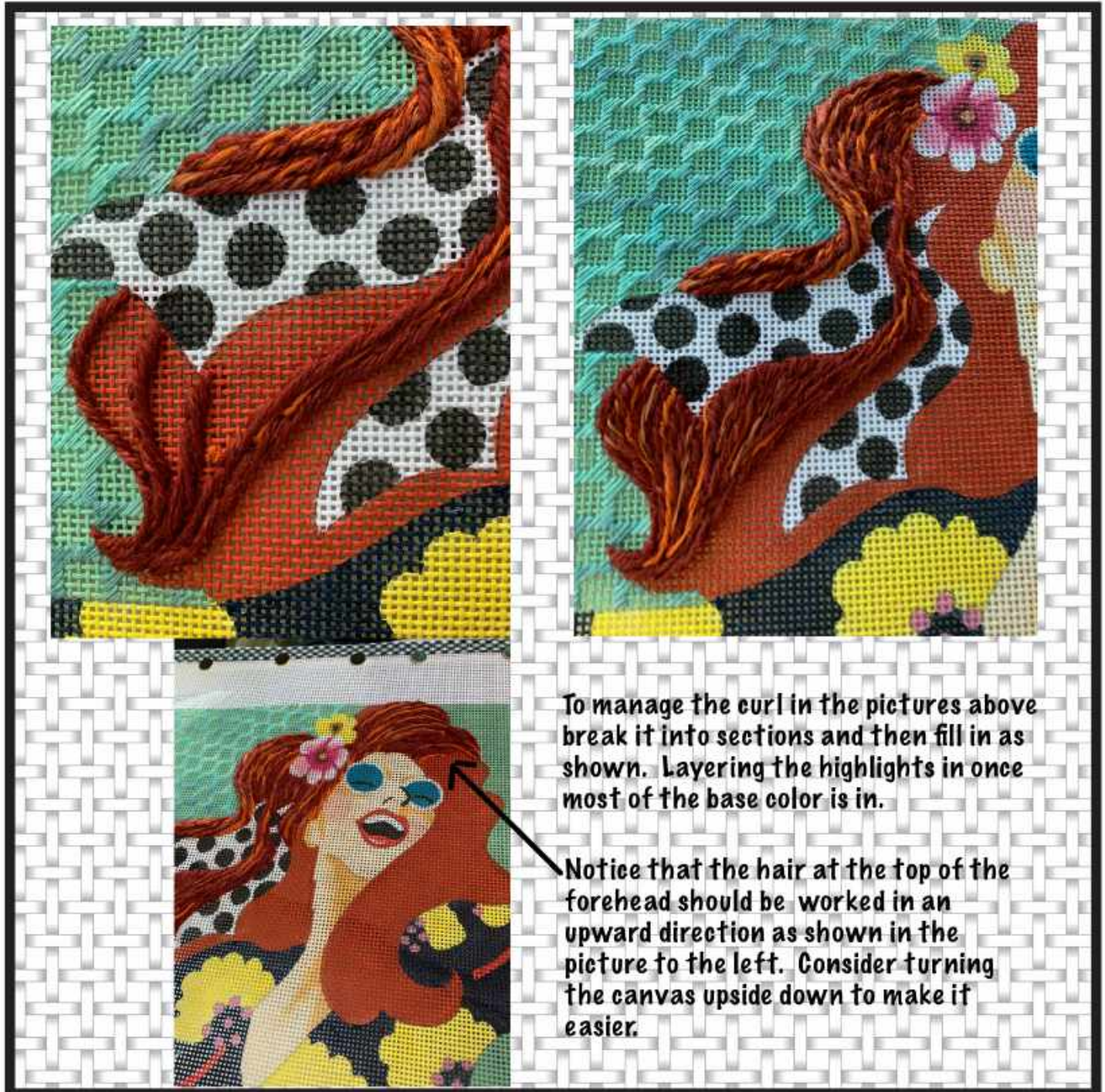
**Step 1 -**

**Use - Blue Sky Alpaca Silk Crabapple (large twist of red/orange) in Twisted Chain Stitch and Stem Stitch as diagrammed above. This will be the primary color with the other orange and tan becoming the highlights in the hair.**

**Highlights - Use Dan Doh Cotton Fine Sierra and Lang Yarns Canapa 987-059 in stem stitch and wrapped stem stitch.**

**Hair (continued)**



To manage the curl in the pictures above break it into sections and then fill in as shown. Layering the highlights in once most of the base color is in.

Notice that the hair at the top of the forehead should be worked in an upward direction as shown in the picture to the left. Consider turning the canvas upside down to make it easier.

**Glasses**



**Glasses - Use 3mm Swarovski Bicones Crystal to tent stitch the glasses. Not every intersection needs to be covered as the beads are a bit bigger.**

**Bridge of the Nose - Use Size 15 Miyuki Seed Beads Color 250 in string beading. Two strings of 6-8 beads should cover the area.**

**Skin - Use Splendor S815 (2 ply) and S818 (2 ply) to basketweave the skin. Go over the pink of the cheeks as we will be enhancing her cheeks in the next class. Go over the black lines as well.**
