


What are characteristics of a challenged reader?

- Limited life experiences
- Lack of access to material
- Lack of modeling at home, with peers, or at school
- View reading as chore
- Often ESL speakers
- Some biological differences
 - Eye problems
 - Perceptual impairments
 - Dyslexia



Best Practice: Before Reading

- Define purpose. Set goals.
- Access prior knowledge
 - Draw a mind map
 - Consider a real life problem
 - Plus-Minus-Intriguing
 - Kinesthetic Tic-Tac-Toe
 - Questionnaire



Best Practice: After Reading

- Graphic organizers
 - Appropriate time
 - Visual-learner appeal
- Question alternatives
 - Open-ended questions
 - Reflective paragraph
 - Question the author
- Reciprocal teaching method
 - Student-led experience
 - Shared responsibility
