SAMPLE SCHEDULE

5-15 minutes: Mini Lesson

- Can include conferencing, small group work, mid-workshop teaching point

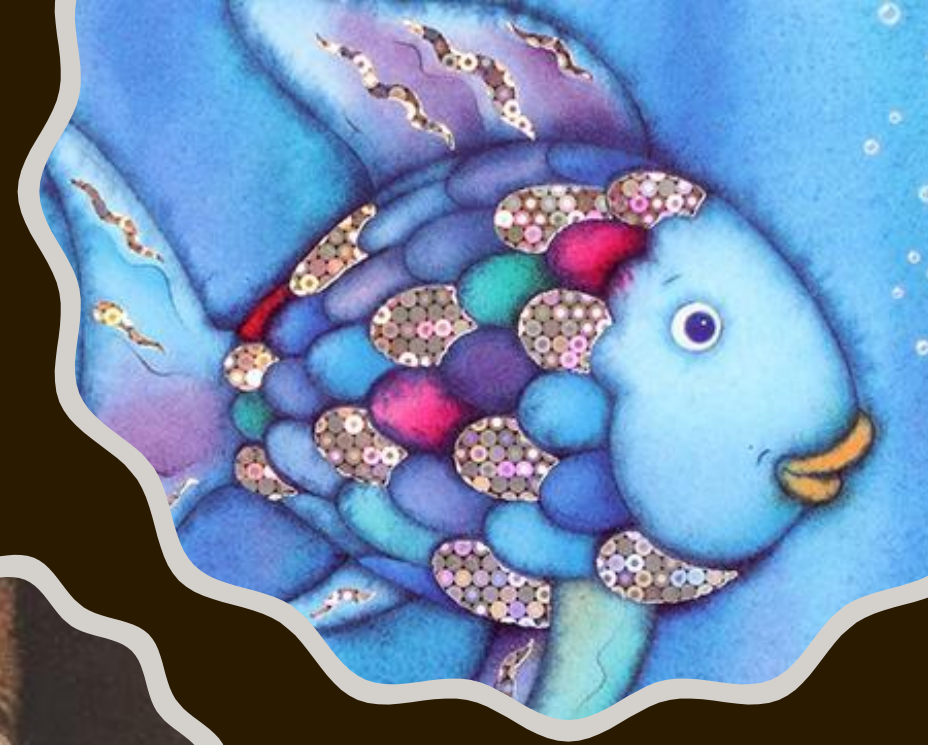
5-10 minutes: Sharing

- Other components: read aloud, status of the class, assessment
