The MAPL program, offered on the Philadelphia campus, comprises:

- **A customizable 51-credit program**, over 2 years when taken full time.
- **12 credits** at the Temple School of Social Work or the Fox School of Business.
- **Field Experience** in social ministry, social services, advocacy, and more.
- Thorough theological training for effective leadership in faith-based nonprofit organizations.
- Residential, day, evening, online, Saturday, and intensive courses offered for your convenience, with need- and merit-based financial aid available.
