The Master of Divinity Distributed Learning Pathway (DL) at United Lutheran Seminary allows students to pursue their calling from anywhere in the world.

- **A 72-credit program**, flexible to your schedule and choice of course load. Complete in as few as 3 years, or as many as 10.
- Coursework includes online learning, contextual experience, and week-long intensives on both Gettysburg and Philadelphia campuses, in addition to optional participation in the Washington Theological Consortium.
- Students are placed into a **peer cohort** for the extent of their studies, creating a unique and supportive community of learning.
- **Maintain your local ministry and support** while growing through engaging coursework and a broader community.
