



NYSPEC MIS / MIO Policy

The New York State Public Employee Conference policy with respect to the issuance of memoranda in support/opposition for any legislation which is not outlined in our current Legislative Agenda:

- **The legislation must have passed both houses**
- **There must be a request for a NYSPEC memo from one or more member units in good standing**
- **A request is sent from the NYSPEC Chairman, electronically, to all directors notifying them of the request, and the fact that they must respond within a certain number of business days only if they are opposed to the request**
- **If any member unit expresses opposition, NYSPEC does not issue the requested memo**
