Please note that all gardens need to be independently accessible by a judge, not through the house or requiring gates unlocking please		
<b>A</b>	<b>Large Front Garden</b> - over 80 square yds (73 m <sup>2</sup> ) - to include paved areas/driveways	
<b>B</b>	<b>Small Front Garden</b> - not more than 80 square yds (73 m <sup>2</sup> ) to include paved areas/driveways	
<b>C</b>	<b>Large Rear garden</b> - over 80 square yds (73 m <sup>2</sup> ) – to include patios	
<b>D</b>	<b>Small Rear garden</b> - not more than 80 square yds (73 m <sup>2</sup> ) – to include patios	
<b>E</b>	<b>Courtyard – front or back,</b> - utilizing pots, graveled or paved areas	
<b>F</b>	<b>External display with no garden</b> - windowsills, house fronts etc	
<b>G</b>	<b>Best single tub/container.</b> Must be clearly identified for judging.	
<b>H</b>	<b>Best single hanging basket.</b> Must be clearly identified for judging.	
<b>I</b>	<b>Best garden feature involving water</b> – pond, fountain etc	
<b>J</b>	<b>Best innovative garden design</b> to include consideration of grassed/paved areas/ornamental features.	
<b>K</b>	<b>Most environmentally friendly</b> – using recycled/upcycled materials, wildlife friendly, sustainable	
<b>Commercial/ Club Premises</b>		
<b>L</b>	<b>Best external floral display</b> - including hanging baskets, planters, tubs.	
<b>M</b>	<b>Best shop window display</b> - using flowers/plants (artificial or real)	
<b>Other categories</b>		
<b>N</b>	<b>Best Residential Home</b> to include consideration of any tubs/containers/hanging baskets	
<b>O</b>	<b>Best School / pre-school</b>	
<b>P</b>	<b>Best street</b>	
<b>Q</b>	<b>Best Allotment</b> (Please make sure allotment is labelled clearly)	
<b>Sunflowers</b>		
to be judged separately, in late August. Grown from your own choice of seed		
<b>R</b>	<b>Tallest sunflower (from the surface of the growing medium to the top of the tallest petal at the time of judging).</b>	
<b>S</b>	<b>Biggest diameter flower/seed head (excluding petals).</b>
