A	Front garden – any size, including paved areas, driveways	
B*	Rear garden – any size, including paved areas, driveways (Needs to be independently accessible by a judge, by prior arrangement – i.e. not through house or requiring gates unlocking please)	
C	Best front garden single tub/container/hanging basket. Must be clearly identified for judging.	
D*	Best garden water feature	
E	Best innovative front garden design to include consideration of grassed/paved areas/ornamental features.

F	Best external floral display – including hanging baskets, planters, tubs.	
G	Best shop window display using flowers/plants (artificial or real)

H	Best decorated site to include consideration of any tubs/containers/hanging baskets

The Melksham Sunflowers Competition (to be judged separately, in late August) Grown from your own choice of seed
