

## **THE CHEAT SHEET – F.A.Q**

### **What is the Cheat Sheet?**

The Cheat Sheet is a composition of all things punters should use to select horses. A computer program collates all of the key trends, breeding, trainer stats etc and provides me with a list of 100 – 150 horses per day. I then narrow down the field manually by assessing their form, market vibes and various other factors.

### **What do the stars mean?**

To put it simply, the more stars next to a horse, the more confident I am that the horse will win its respective race. If a race has a 1★ or 2★ rating, then they should be treated with caution and should rarely be included in any multiples.

### **What does a 💣 mean?**

If you see a bomb next to a horse's name on the Cheat Sheet, then it is an indication from me that the particular horse could be utilised as part of a multiple bet. You will find out more about that in the answer to the next question below.

### **How should I use the Cheat Sheets?**

Everyone that looks at the Cheat Sheet will have a different approach when it comes to utilising them for betting purposes. The best way to use them is as a study/betting aid. Take the high rated horses (3★ to 5★) undertake your own assessment and if my idea of the winner ties in with your own then you can play them accordingly in singles, doubles, Trixies, Lucky 15's, Place Accas etc with a little extra confidence. Alternatively, if you're not capable of assessing form yourself, then the best advice I can give is to follow the money. If you see high star rated horses being well supported, it's usually a big indication that the Cheat Sheet is spot on. DO NOT go searching for the life changing win by putting 5 to 10 horses in accumulators, ultimately this approach will fail. I personally never play more than 3 in one bet and on a rare occasion I will play a lucky 15 but even then, I do so in the knowledge that 3 out of 4 will result in profit.

### **Are the Cheat Sheets Official Tips?**

The simple answer to this question is ABSOLUTELY NOT. If I believe that a horse on the Cheat Sheet is particularly strong then I will always advise an Official Bet on it. So, with that in mind, anyone looking to use them for betting should do so using a separate betting bank and should keep their stakes to a minimum.
