

Checklist for International Clients

The following documents and information are required by Health Canada during Segra's application process and will need to be submitted to Segra no later than 60 days prior to any shipment. Every shipment from Segra will require an individual export permit.

| Valid | Import | Permit |
|-------|---------------|---------------|
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- Clients from some jurisdictions like Germany will also need to provide an import license.
 It's important to also check the requirements with the regulatory authority prior to application process.
- The provided documents (import permit and/or license) need to be in English or translated into English by a certified translator.
- Please note that Canadian LPs are only allowed to import or export cannabis for medical or scientific purposes. An import permit issued for the recreational use cannot be considered at this time.
- It is preferrable if the import permit indicates "Cannabis Plants" as the imported product.
- Some import permits are for the single use only while others are limited only by the expiry date.
