This event is being held to help Clinton County residents properly dispose of old used tires. Scrap tires can degrade, causing chemicals to leach into the soil and waterways and old tire dumps can provide fertile breeding grounds for mosquitos. This Program is open to all Clinton County residents

Date: Friday October 8th, 2021

Time: 1:00 pm until 3:30 pm or until the truck is full

Place: Town of Black Brook Highway Garage, 208 Silver Lake Road, AuSable Forks, NY

Cost: No Charge!

Space is Limited- Collection will end when max. # of tires have been reached.

- Collection is on Friday, October 8th from 1 pm-3:30 pm,
- Maximum of 10 tires per vehicle (if you have additional tires, we will create a call list)
- Tires must be:
 - o Whole tires, No Rims, No excessive dirt, mud or water
 - o ONLY Passenger car or Passenger Truck (no semi, tractor truck, ATV, etc.)
 - o Must be less than 19.5"

***Due to the Covid-19 situation, please remain in your vehicle and staff will remove the tires

***Please wear face coverings and maintain social distancing when interacting with staff

The District reserves the right to reject non-passenger and non-pickup truck tires.
